Город готовится принять Петербургский культурный форум



Город готовится принять крупное международное событие: петербургский культурный форум. Он пройдет со 2 по 4 декабря. Планы у организаторов амбициозные. Мероприятие проводится при поддержке Правительства Санкт-Петербурга и Президентской библиотеки имени Ельцина. Главная тема предстоящего события станет Год культуры в России в 2014 году. По словам Голодца, форум должен создать стратегические предпосылки для развития культурной жизни в стране на последующие время, привлечь внимание общества к проблемам развития и сохранения наследия. По мнению министра культуры Владимира Мединского, предстоящий форум должен — ни много ни мало — заявить о Петербурге, как о культурной столице мира! Также в обсуждении будущего мероприятия примут участие ведущие представители всех направлений искусства и культуры, а также на форуме будут работать 11 секций: это театр, музыка, цирк, музей, кино. Уже о своем участии присоединился к Петербургскому международному культурному форуму заявили научные музеи. В отдельную секцию их выделят в следующем году, сообщила Ольга Голодец. Форум будет ежегодным.

The most important goal of the Presidential Library has been the creation of a national digital collection of documents based on advanced information technologies covering the history, the theory, and practice of the Russian statehood.

Today, such diverse categories of users as schoolchildren, students, scientists, teachers, bloggers, journalists, lawyers, and state officials are able to access its data base.

With the help of information technologies the Presidential Library is developing both as the national depository of the most significant documents and as a multimedia, multifunctional (cultural and educational, scientific and informational analytic) center. The results of its activities are widely known; they are reflected in annual public reports, and widely covered by the major and regional mass media.

I believe that this endeavor of the institution is an indicator of the effectiveness of the creation of electronic libraries, providing remote access to information resources via telecommunication networks.

In 2013, the Department of Affairs of the President of the Russian Federation celebrated its 20th anniversary, and the Presidential Library has been under its jurisdiction for a quarter of this period. In accordance with its subordinate status, priorities of the Library lie not only within the realms of culture, science and education, but also within that of the government and the administration. The Presidential Library regularly provides informational, analytical,

technological, and organizational assistance in the conducting of sociopolitical and official government events.

I hope that the personnel of the Presidential Library will continue to remain at the cutting edge of the information domain!

Dear colleagues and friends,

The Presidential Library has been focused mainly on the formation and organizing of an easy access to the national collection of information resources in electronic form about the history, the theory, and accomplishments of the Russian statehood, as well as the issue of the Russian language as the official language of the Russian Federation.

Thus, several basic digital thematic collections have been formed, namely “The Territory of Russia”, “The Russian People”, “The Russian Language”, “The State Authority”, as well as more than 100 digital collections that are united by the general themes of the institution. The collection includes 300 thousand electronic editions of publications, archival and audiovisual materials, and official documents from different libraries, archives, museums, and other institutions.

Exposure of these resources is performed with the assistance of our regular events and projects (public discussions, conferences, publications, lectures, competitions, etc.). A huge number of these projects gained wide recognition, and beyond doubt, the online format has contributed to this. Moreover, each year there are a lot of high-profile events and important historical dates, which we cannot exclude. As, for instance, in the year marking the 20th anniversary of the Russian Constitution, a multifaceted project dedicated to the constitutional history of Russia was completed (from digitization of rare documents to participation in the creation of a virtual museum). Furthermore, during

the first 6 months of this year, several times a week we have continued to conduct a multimedia lesson about the Constitution for schoolchildren of Saint Petersburg.

We are developing the range of our events and projects by means of IT-equipment, and information and telecommunication networks. Thanks to having attracted highly qualified experts (in particular, the interdepartmental working groups within the framework of the Academic Board), we have reached new horizons in bringing informational practice to the levels of methodological and procedural techniques. In 2014, we will have to summarize and systematize the results of five-years of working experience. This conscious experience is the key to what we will have to face over the next five-year period, in order to be able to determine the main directions for our future development.

Our experience is, in many respects, the result of our partnership with colleagues from other institutions, with whom we are always happy to maintain a professional relationship.

Introduction

In 2013, the Presidential Library continued moving along the road of innovational development as a modern informational, cultural, educational and scientific center. The Library's primary areas of activities are connected with the creation of information resources in electronic form, dedicated to the subjects of the history, the theory and praxis of the state of Russia, the issues of the Russian language as the official language of the country, and issues of its proper usage. Much effort has been made to involve the Presidential Library in the country's social life, and to establish an open policy aimed at arranging extensive access to the materials of the Library.

The holdings of the Presidential Library have increased and are now comprised of 300 thousand digital copies of various publications, archived and audiovisual materials, and official documents provided by libraries, archives, museums, studios, editors of mass media, as well as those received from private collections. These have formed basic digital thematic collections of "The Territory of Russia", "The Russian People", "The Russian Language", and "The State Authority", as well as 100 other digital collections.

The website provides access to one hundred thousand electronic documents. In 2013, one million two hundred thousand users visited the website. Every day, nearly five thousand people utilize the resources offered by the website, and more than thirty five thousand people have already registered and have their own personal cabinet. Accessibility to the holdings is achieved with the aid of seventy electronic reading rooms that have been opened in federal and regional cultural organizations and educational institutions, and at Russian centers of science and culture abroad.

In 2013, the Presidential Library participated in providing assistance for the holding of a number of major events of social importance: for example, the G20 summit in Saint Petersburg, meetings of intergovernmental panels, and the high-profile conference of the International Atomic Energy Agency "Atomic Energy in the XXI Century". The Library's representatives co-chaired the "Culture and Art" group of the 3rd "Russia – Republic of Korea Dialogue" forum. The Library is also one of the co-founders of the Russian Historical Society department in Saint Petersburg, providing cooperation in the running of the International Legal Forum's plenary session in Saint Petersburg, and also, the final meeting of the 2nd Saint Petersburg Cultural Forum's Organizing Committee, which was successfully conducted in the Northern Capital, having been held in the Presidential Library's building.

The most important events of 2013 are reflected in the electronic holdings of the Library, in its excursions and exhibitions, as well as in its educational, publishing, polygraphic and scientific work. Sophisticated information technologies, along with complex scientific and informative preparations, have helped to fully develop such subject matters as the 400th anniversary of the establishment of the House of Romanov, the 150th anniversary of the friendly visit of the Russian warships to New York and San Francisco, and the 20th anniversary of the Russian Constitution. Virtual Museum of the Constitution of Russian Federation was created, becoming the first virtual museum in the country. The Presidential Library developed a technique of teaching schoolchildren the constitutional history using multimedia lessons.

The progressive development of the Presidential Library continues. This development is predetermined by the creation of new technological solutions, active work in choosing documents for the holdings, and growth of interest to the first national electronic library in Russia. Information resources that are included here have become accessible to a great number of people, no matter where they live, what they do, or how old they are.

Forming of the Electronic Library's Holdings

In 2013, more than 70 thousand electronic documents from various sources, including those documents intentionally chosen for the purposes of scanning, were received and downloaded into the information system of the Library. These documents included books, periodicals, archived materials, author's abstracts and theses, official documents, postcards, prints, and photographs, as well as objects from museums: badges, stamps, banknotes and coins. Along with that, the holdings have been supplemented with multimedia resources, among which are virtual exhibitions, excursions, lectures, and scientific documentaries.

The scanning of the documents received from the holdings of federal departments, universities, and regional scientific and national libraries of the Russian Federation was carried out under a state order for the transferring of documentation into digitalized form. The number of archived materials was increased owing to the addition of digital copies of original materials that were received from the federal and regional state archives, particularly those from personal collections, and documents reflecting activities of both the highest and mid-level agencies of the government of the Russian Empire.

In the reporting year, the Library continued work at acquiring ready-made digitalized content from partners, organizations, as well as individuals.

Selection of the resources was carried out under the principal of collection in accordance with the established plan for the development of the electronic holdings. The key collection of the year was that of "The Russian Language", which is dedicated to the official language of the Russian Federation. The initial size of the collection was more than one thousand units. Over the course of 2013, the accumulation of other basic digitalized thematic collections, such as "The Territory of Russia", "The Russian People", and "The State Authority", also continued.

Furthermore, the increase in size of the holdings was possible thanks to the selection of resources dedicated to other themes, such as: the history of revolutionary movements in Russia, the formation of the administrative-territorial divisions of the Russian Empire, the establishment of the Russian legislative system throughout the county's different historical periods, and the founding of Russia's scientific and educational institutions.

Materials about the following distinguished activists of revolutionary movement have been digitalized in order to create individual compilations dedicated to them: M. I. Kybalchych, G. V. Plekhanov, S. Perovskaya, V. Zasluch, V. Figner, L. Volkenstein, and others. Collections covering information about the following leaders of the state from the beginning of the Soviet period have also been included: V. I. Lenin, N. I. Bukharin, L. V. Kamenev, F. E. Dzerzhinsky, L. D. Trotsky, A. I. Rykov, G. Y. Zinoviev, K. B. Radek, and others. Private holdings, stored in the Russian State Historical Archive and The State Archive of the Russian Federation, were digitalized in succession, in order to make these documents accessible to public. Examples of these compilations are the anthologies of K. P. Pobyedonostsyev, N. M. Karamzin, N. I. Kostomarov, A. F. Kony, F. N. Plevako, S. A. Muromtsev, and B. V. Nikolsky, as well as other Russian statesmen, military commanders, lawyers, and historians.

Under 2014 priority-driven project dedicated to the First World War, special attention was paid to the selection and digitization of scientific research, document collections, maps and charts, reviews, diaries and memoirs. Materials that described the political relationships between the leading European countries on the eve of the war, the beginning of the war, and the moment of Russia's entry into the war were included in the electronic holdings, as well as were documents containing information about major land and sea battles: the East Prus-

sian Offensive, the Battle of Łódź, the Battle of Galicia, the Battle of Warsaw, the Brusilov Offensive, sea battles on the Black Sea, on the Baltic Sea, etc. Documents describing activities of non-governmental organizations in support of the Russian Army and population during the war were also added to the holdings. In 2013, the selection of materials reflecting the history of the discovery and development of the regions and territories of Russia continued. These materials consist mostly of statistics and ethnographical data, along with descriptions of memorable places and the personalities connected with them. Among these digitized materials are documents of the zemstvo (a system of elected local assemblies), governmental and the eparchial authorities of the Arkhangelsk, the Olonets, the Perm, and the Yaroslavl Governorates from the period of the Russian Empire, as well as documents of the Communist Party and the administrative bodies of Soviet Russia.

During this reporting year, the holdings of the Presidential Library expanded to include

pre-revolutionary and soviet magazines and newspapers, such as “The Journal of the Ministry of National Education”, “The Russian Messenger Gazette”, “The Russian Affluence”, “The Russian Word”, the scientific, literary and political magazine “The Russian Mind”, the periodicals of the Russian Geographical Society, and the Russian Academy of Sciences, as well as others.

Documents about the history of the constitutional movement in Russia were added to the holdings; among them are documents about the M. T. Loris-Melikov Constitution, constitutional projects authored by the meeting of the Commission of All Zemstvos, “The Union of Liberation”, and others, as well as the constitutional acts of the Soviet period (1918, 1924, 1937).

In 2013, within the framework of cooperation of the development of the digital collections, 19 regional partners provided the Presidential Library’s depository with 8,159 digital copies of documents, and 337 items of already digitized content were received from foreign partners.

The Library also received donations of scientific monographs, periodicals, albums, photographs and audiovisual materials, part of which was converted into electronic form and added to the holdings of the Library in accordance with the relevant licensing agreements.

Audiovisual Documents

The audiovisual content of the Presidential Library's electronic holdings continued to increase in size in 2013.

Materials, regularly posted on the multimedia website, have been prepared under the video lecture program of the Presidential Library. The materials are dedicated to individual historic figures, memorable dates, and topics that are of high priority in the creation of this national digital resource. A special place in the collection of audiovisual documents has been occupied by public lectures of distinguished Russian scholars on the Russian language, the history of state power, science and education, as well as those of political and social leaders, who delivered speeches on the 20th anniversary of the Russian Constitution: V. D. Zorkin, Chairman of the Constitutional Court of Russia, S. E. Narishkin, Chairman of the State Duma, S. V. Stepashin, Chairman of the Russian Law Society, and others. The holdings were also supplemented with the videos of speeches given by prominent special matter experts at forums and conferences, which were held in the Library, with videos of these and other events, with the promotional films advertising digital collections, exhibitions and educational projects. Educational and scientific documentaries created by the Library itself are presented as a separate type of audiovisual documents.

Digitized video content, given to the Library by third parties free of charge, was also added to the electronic holdings of the Library in the reporting year. "The Russian History Channel" provided the Presidential Library with 47 scientific documentaries, which were divided into groups by theme: "Uprisings in Russia", "The 300th Anniversary of the Battle of Poltava", "From the History of Crimea", "Individuality in History", "The Patrons of Russia", "Monastery Walls", "The Russian Military at the Beginning of the 20th Century", "Battle with Napoleon", "Events in History", and others. "Russian Railways" contributed 10 episodes from the films series "Russia from the Train Window".

These films combine reporting and artistic cinematography, and tell the viewers about the history of several geographic locations: "The Sothern Primorye", "The Caucasus", "The Eastern Baikal-Amur Mainline (BAM), from Vanino to Tynda", "The Sverdlovsk Road. Oil Fields of the Middle Ob", "The Dead Road", "The Volga and Caspian Sea Region", "The Trip to the "Murmanka"", "The Western Baikal-Amur Mainline (BAM)", "On the Border of a Wild Realm. Meshchera", "The Krasnoyarsk Road. In the Footsteps of Russian Pathfinders".

All of the above mentioned documents are listed in the "Virtual Exhibitions, Tours and Video Materials" section of the Presidential Library's multimedia website; moreover, users may familiarize themselves with all the new audiovisual documents in the electronic reading room.

Bibliographic Processing and Indexing of Digital Resources

In 2013, in order to provide users access to the Presidential Library’s holdings, all available digital resources were processed in accordance with the national standards and rules of classification, methodology of indexing, as well as by the thematic focus of a particular collection. Particular attention was paid to the formation and indexing

of the bibliographic records of resources included in the core collection about the Russian language, the thematic collections “The House of Romanov. 400th Anniversary of the Zemsky Sobor of 1613”, “Russia in the Foreign Trade: the Past and the Present”, “The Constitution of the Russian Federation. Year 1993”, and the collections about Russian regions and public figures.

The formation of digital collections dedicated to reflecting the history of a region in graphic form was made possible due to the development of a special technique for the indexing and classification of postcards and their sets. This methodology was used for the presentation of the collection of the Children’s Postcard Museum (St. Petersburg): pre-revolutionary postcards with the views of Sochi and its suburbs, the region of the Caucasian Mineral Waters, the sets of stamps with the views of the cities of the European part of Russia, as well as postcards dedicated to the First World War of 1914–1918 and others.

For the thematic grouping of “The National Periodicals in the Presidential

Library's Holdings", editions from 65 different magazines were annotated. The cataloging of the content of the "Journal of the Ministry of Justice", "The European Herald", "The Russian Antiquities", "The Collection of the Imperial Russian Historical Society", the historical magazine "The Red Archive", and others. "The Memory of the Great Victory" collection was complimented by descriptions from the handwritten military magazine, "The Dawn", and by 1,240 issues of the newspaper "Defending the Motherland", dating back to 1941–1945.

With the goal of wider dissemination of information about the activities and projects of the library, in 2013 the cataloging of video excursions of the exhibitions, photo albums, informational videos, and recordings of the lectures and other audiovisual documents was carried out.

Methodological recommendations for the cataloging and indexing of various types of information resources: digital copies of legal acts and graphic materials, and electronic news publications, – were drawn up for publication. The Library developed new approaches to the indexing of resources in the context of the formation of the Presidential Library's digital collections, to techniques for the indexing of historical information resources, serialized and other ongoing resources, and to the method of reflecting the time period for the purposes of indexing the resources.

The Library continued its joint project with the National Information Library Center LIBNET on the project of putting together the Digital Resources Central Catalogue: templates and examples of bibliographic records for digital copies of various types of documents (books, printed music, maps, graphic materials, audio and video resources, films) were prepared.

The Library's staff regularly performed consultations on the issues of cataloging for the specialists of collaborating organizations, which participated in the preparation of the content for the Presidential Library's holdings.

In 2013, editing of the authority bibliographic content and metadata, provided by external sources was conducted. Furthermore, 25 thousand original entries were made. Specialists continued to formulate the authority file of the Presidential Library's subject headings, and started to formulate the authority name file. During the reporting period, over 1,500 authority records were made of names of individuals and of organizations.

- » The number of electronic documents in the information system of the Presidential Library reached 300 thousand.
- » In 2013, 26 digital collections were prepared, including 1 basic ("The Russian Language") and 25 thematic collections.
- » More than 49 thousand bibliographic records were edited and cataloged over the course of the reporting year.
- » The total volume of the Presidential Library's authority file increased to 13 thousand authority records.
- » Within the framework of collaboration in the sphere of creating the digital collections, 19 regions of the Russian Federation and 5 foreign partners provided the Library with previously digitized content.

Information Technology Basis of Activities

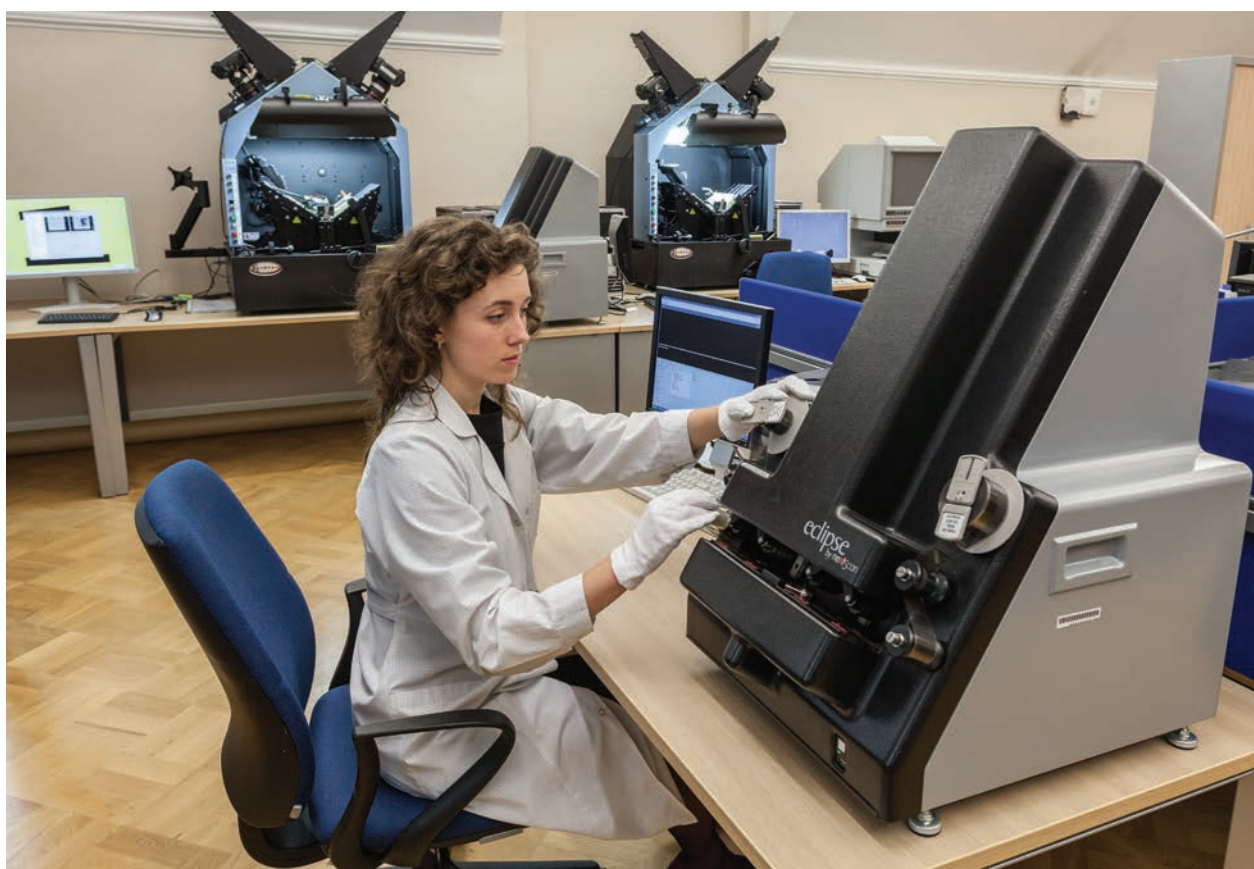
Thanks to the application of modern information technology, the Presidential Library is able to realize the full cycle of electronic holdings formation and to provide optimal conditions for the storage of mass digital data and allow operative access to such information.

The system for preparing digital content is equipped with special scanners, which make it possible to conduct digitization of different types of the materials (including A1+ and A2+ paper sizes) from various data mediums, and micro-forms. The production system for audiovisual materials provides the preparation of multimedia content, moreover, a large number of various

printed products is produced at the premises of digital printing complex.

The Library centers of data processing develop in accordance with up-to-date technological achievements in the sphere of digital information storage.

The operative access to the information from different types of mobile gadgets was realized under the functioning of the Library multimedia website. Furthermore, the net infrastructure of the remote access to the electronic holdings of the Library also provides public access to the information from remote electronic reading rooms, including the access

made possible thanks to the technology of the digital signature.

Different technology is used for the equipment in the conference halls, exhibition halls, and in a convertible multifunctional multimedia complex, which has the systems of original and stereo projection, an interactive conference system with fitted televoting function, which would allow high-profile sociopolitical, scientific, educational, and cultural events to be held.

The videoconferencing complex is able to conduct up to 48 simultaneous connec-

tions for remote interlocutors. Moreover, a sophisticated television complex ensure live transmission with the application of high-definition television standards (HD TV).

This organization of information support technology for events in different regions of Russia, in which chief executives of the country take part, would not be possible without active usage of unique technological resources and competence of the Library's technical employees.

Optimization and Upgrade of Information Systems

Sufficient upgrade of the information systems, used for forming the electronic holdings, and optimization of hardware and software resources for long-term storage of the data was carried out in order to improve the effectiveness of the production processes and complete new tasks set before the Presidential Library in the reporting year.

The Library expanded particularized zones, which were needed for the development and testing of programming solutions for the Presidential Library's information system in the spheres of "virtual" machines and "cloud" technologies.

The reporting year was marked by the development and implementation of a new technology of a separate data storage on tape and disk drives. The capacity of long-term storage system based on tape drives was sufficiently increased to provide the storage of high-quality digital content.

Complexes of video editing, post processing of the digital content, and sound broadcasting of conference halls were modernized, moreover, Wi-Fi network capacity in the main building of the Presidential Library was increased. The functionality of multimedia halls software and hardware was improved, including the modernization of workstations.

For the purpose of introducing a new format for archived documents description in 2013, which was developed by the Presidential Library, an enhancement project on information systems used for formation of bibliographic records on the archived documents according to the principal of hierarchy was developed (Holdings-Finding aid-Work-Document). In the frameworks of the abovementioned project, the functional possibilities of the digital content preparation system was improved.

Due to the active development of the Presidential Library's remote electronic reading rooms network the electronic reading

rooms hardware and software functioning was improved, apart from that, the Library make it possible to provide protected access to the electronic reading rooms digital content for the users in different regions of Russia, and to create manageable access to the statistics. Now there are more than 70 connected sites, and it is technologically possible to increase their number.

Several additional software improvements of the Digital Resources Central Catalogue (DRCC) were made to ensure more effective interaction coordination of the Library with national educational and cultural institutions in the field of preservation of Russia's national cultural legacy.

Under the Library's activities aimed at the creation of perspective information technology new methodological, information, algorithmic software and software needed for development systems of the process controlled systems was developed. A new prototype of the software for the computer-aided design (CAD) for the interface of the site "President of Russia – to Russian Citizens of School Age" was made. It conducts computer-aided design of the database and software of flash- and html-versions of the new site section the "Executive Branch".

» Information resources of the Presidential Library increased in 2013 by more than 8,1 million scanned images, which were received via the usage of united scanning complexes of the Department of Affairs of the President of the Russian Federation lower organizations.

» Additionally, 102 units of computers and other equipment were put into service.

» The system of audiovisual content production was used to make 92 multimedia projects, namely 3 films, 3 picture shots, 7 virtual excursions of thematic exhibitions, 20 video lectures, 8 video addresses, 4 video records of governmental officials speeches, 2 video reports, 1 video lesson.

Electronic Reading Room

In 2013, the electronic reading room of the Library continued to provide services for users on the basis of the Library's holdings. It was also possible to have access to additional 14 external databases, including the resources with scientific periodical publications, legal reference retrieval systems from different producers, as well as electronic librarian systems on humanitarian sciences.

Electronic reading room also became the place for holding different types of presentations, allowing the users to familiarize themselves with the technological and functional possibilities of integrated digital resources and various thematic collections. In 2013, 5,978 attendees visited 460 presentations held at the Presidential Library. The premises of the Library branch, situated in the Tyumen region, were used to demonstrate 6,379 users represented by 233 groups the possibilities of the electronic reading room.

Prominent politicians and public figures became the owners of Library cards in 2013.

The possibilities of the electronic reading room were used for holding the "Russia in the Electronic World" student Olympiad. In

the reporting year, the electronic reading room was also used to hold thematic webinars with readers and employees of regional and foreign remote reading rooms.

Remote Access to Information Resources

During the whole reporting period, the Presidential Library was continuing the development of remote reading rooms on the premises of regional libraries, federal and regional universities, scientific and cultural institutions both in Russia and abroad. It became possible to get remote access to the electronic holdings of the Library in 46 Russian regions. In addition to 12 remote electronic reading rooms abroad that had already existed, three more new ones opened in Russian Centers of Science and Culture under the Rossotrudnichestvo, namely centers in Astana (Kazakhstan), Vientiane (Laos), and Budapest (Hungary). At the premises of the National Library of Ukraine named after V. I. Vernadsky in Kiev a new electronic reading room with an access to the Presidential Library's resources was opened.

In 2013, the activities of the Presidential Library were also directed to the improvement of providing protected access to the electronic holdings of regional institutions. Thus, the measures taken allowed the Library to register readers, who could have an access to any electronic reading room and a reliable protection of transmitted files and data. The Library provided the possibilities for the reception of

printed and digital copies of the documents, the formation of statistic reports on different aspects.

Apart from that, it became possible to carry out remote administration with the help of programs from all regional electronic reading rooms and to determine group and individual access policies for the Presidential Library resources.

Multimedia Website

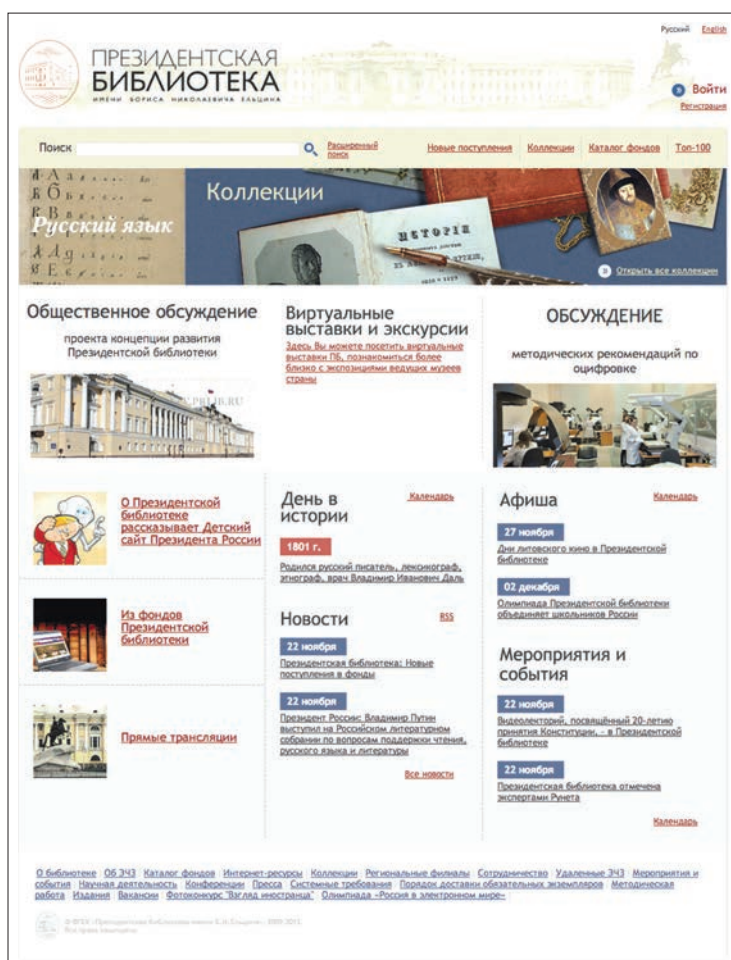
In 2013, more than 100,000 electronic documents became accessible on the Presidential Library website, a whole range of new digital collections was released. The remote users attendance of the website increased two times from last year's attendance.

During the Year of the Russian Language, a basic digital thematic collection “The Russian Language” was presented on the website along with other profile thematic collections, and the assistance in holding major international events was provided by the multimedia website. For the G20 summit that took place in

Saint Petersburg the website released “Russia in the Foreign Trade: the Past and the Present” and “Saint Petersburg and Russian Avant-Garde Art” collections.

Approximately 100 documents and collections have been published in the “Up-to-date Document” section, these documents are relevant to events, historical and memorable dates, governmental holidays, etc. About 50 historical sketches about the most important facts in Russian and world history with references to full texts of these documents were prepared for the calendar “A Day in History”.

The ever increasing multimedia content of the Library holdings is presented in the “Virtual Exhibitions, Tours, Video Materials” section, where users may familiarize themselves with information videos, documentaries, newsreels, and other materials. The educational part of the resources is represented with multimedia presentations for children and pupils, as well as the recordings of lectures and speeches, which were held particularly in the frameworks of the events held for the specialists by the Presidential Library. In addition to live transmissions of these events, video materials from the holdings of the Library are now presented in the section “Live Transmissions”. The section “Conferences” provides information about the announcements of the upcoming events and the reports of past events. The electronic registration form makes the participation in the events easier for both speakers and audience. The section for specialists, “Methodological Work”, is used for providing assistance in scientific work, namely in holding training seminars on cataloging; there users may find textbooks and recommendations for



the specialists. The publishing activities for the institution are reflected in the “Issues” section, it contains more than 30 documents prepared by the specialists of the institution, and among these documents are the collections of scientific researches, recommendations and standards, along with other types of products.

The figures of the Presidential Library resources indexing conducted by the major Russian and world research engines also significantly improved in the reporting year. It is connected with the regular measures on optimization of collections and sections reference structure, the adding of full bibliographical records to each document and the volume increase of the information material publications.

The increase of the interactive part of the multimedia website is achieved by the projects and events held with the use of the Internet. Elimination rounds of the “Russia in the Electronic World” student Olympiad are carried out on-line, as well as the reception of photographs under the contest “Foreign View”, the registration of the conference participants, and, for the first time, different public discussions. In order to make the discussions possible the Library created a special section fit with an electronic form for placing comments. More than 150 thousand users visited the section during the first month of its implementation only.

The news section of the website contains news pieces united in accordance with a certain topic: culture, librarianship, information technology, – moreover, it is also used to highlight the events and occasions conducted with the participation of the Presidential Library. Because of the fact that one of the tasks of the institution is the spread of the knowledge on the topic of Russian statehood not only among Russian users, but also among the foreign ones, the full version of the multimedia website is done in two languages – in Russian and English. Multimedia website continues to develop, providing access to all the categories of users, increasing the functional base, and improving the reference retrieving system. It combines the representative function of the official website of the Library and the function of a unified point of access to the integrated digital resource.

Information and Research Activities

One of the key tasks of the Presidential Library in the sphere of government and management is providing information and research activities: collection, analysis and systematization of citizens' opinions and suggestions, summarization of this material for governmental bodies.

The Internet resources of the Economy modernization and innovational development Council under the President of the Russian Federation continued to ameliorate. Revealing the analysis on Russia's entry into the WTO,

forming the mechanisms of the "Open Government" in the Russian Federation, organization of the electronic government and providing citizens with access to the public services, etc. helped to preserve users' interest in all the resources of the site on the level of 2011–2012. These years were marked by most important governmental events, particularly the election of deputies of the State Duma of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation and the Presidential election.

In the framework of the work with socially oriented Internet resources, much attention was paid to the Prime minister’s blog and profiles on social networks, which serve as the sites of active public discussions, where the citizens of Russia and foreign countries discuss topical issues of social life, political events, social and economic problems.

In the reporting year, the Library conducted moderation of comments that were left in the official blog of the Prime minister (<http://blog.da-medvedev.ru/>), in his Live Journal (<http://blog-medvedev.livejournal.com/>), in his profiles on the social network websites of Facebook (<https://www.facebook.com/Dmitry.Medvedev>), Vkontakte (<http://vk.com/dm>) and Instagram (<http://instagram.com/damedvedev>).

In 2013, more than 3,000 text materials and approximately 350 videos were posted on the official website of the President of the Russian Federation (www.kremlin.ru). Approximately 2,000 publications were translated into English.

A new section “Executive Branch” for the site “President of Russia – to Russian Citizens of School Age” is on the test stage. Several relevant articles of the current Constitution were used for the creation of a text adapted for children, which describes aims, tasks, and functions of the executive branch of the government.

In 2013, the Presidential Library for the first time became the site for public discussions, which were conducted with the use of the Internet space. It helped to make the discussions as open and accessible as possible.

In the period from September 23 to October 23, 2013, the multimedia website held discussions about architectural concept of a complex of buildings needed for moving the Supreme Court and the Justice Department of the Russian Federation to Saint Petersburg. The discussion was preceded by a working meeting of the Tender Committee presided by V. I. Kozhin, the Head of the Department of Affairs of the President of the Russian Federation. The participants of the internet discussion supported architectural and town-planning project of “Architectural Workshop of M. Atayants” by a majority vote. This project was announced as the winner during a concluding meeting of the tender committee and on a press conference.

In the period from November 1 to 30, 2013, the project of the Presidential Library development concept for the period up to 2020

was publicly discussed. The document reflecting the perspectives of the main developmental directions and strategic activities of the first national library provoked broad popular response, chiefly from the press representatives, multifunctional information and public center, which provides access to digital resources. The received suggestions were summarized and would be taken into the account during the preparation of a final version of the concept.

For the sake of the support of new librarian technologies in Russia, the Presidential Library provided assistance in holding public discussions on the subject of methodological recommendations for digitalizing during the period from November 15 to December 15, 2013. These recommendations had been prepared in accordance with the Ministry of Culture of the Russian Federation for the project of the national electronic library. The received comments were sent to the developer for summarization and study.

Scientific Activities

Scientific activities of the Presidential Library have to provide functioning of the institution as the modern center of formation and studying of information resources, united by the topic of the Russian statehood and the Russian language as the official language of the country. In 2013, scientific activities of the Library were conducted in two areas: the theory and the practice of the electronic libraries development, and the history, the theory, and the practice of the Russian statehood and the Russian language.

Scientific and methodological aspects of formation, storage, processing, and revelation of the whole electronic database of the institution remained the issues of current importance. The Library studied the practice of usage of different types of the Presidential Library digital resources. The researches of the legal regulations in the sphere of information, intellectual property relations, in forming of the governmental information resources and systems. The study of the theory, the practice, and the history of the Russian statehood and the Russian language was conducted mostly in the frameworks of expert support in information resources selection and scientific assistance in project activities.

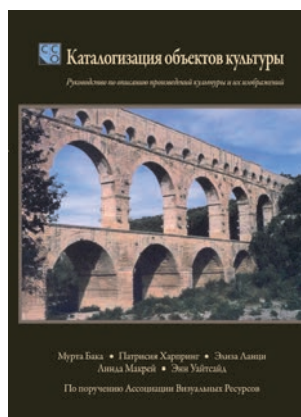
Some areas of scientific activities were connected with the fulfilment of governmental tasks. In accordance with the “Program of National Standardization 2012–2013” the Presidential Library served as the co-contractor in the development of a new edition of a consolidated project for the national standardization project “SIBID Standards. Bibliographic Statistics. Indexes and Measurement Units”. This will allow the Library to add several conditions to the standard, that will consider specific features of the work in digital sphere. The ideas of the specialists concerning the development of publishing and book distribution were reflected in the decisions

made during the round-table conference of the Federation Council Committee on Science, Education, Culture, and Information Policy called the “Book in Spiritual Usage of Contemporaries”.

The meeting of the Committee on Culture and Art under the President of the Russian Federation presented developments in the sphere of the national libraries and cooperation. The questions and suggestions on the topic of the legal deposit system upgrading were discussed by the Committee on Culture of the State Duma, by the Ministry of Telecommunication and Mass Communications, and the Ministry of Culture.

The reporting year resulted in the increase of the scientific and methodological activities of the Library. The Library prepared and published a collection of scientific and methodological materials of the interdepartmental group aimed at the distinction of principles and approaches with the combination of representing and providing access to bibliographic, archived, and museum resources in accordance with modern international standards. The Library employees translated into Russian the rules of museum objects description – “Cataloguing Cultural Objects: a Guide to Describing Cultural Works and Their Images (CCO)”. 9 research and practice seminars were held during the reporting year. These seminars were dedicated

to the methodology and the practice of the Presidential Library's formation and cataloging digital content from different types of resources. They took place in Astana, Volgograd, Zvenigorod, Petrozavodsk, Saint Petersburg, Tambov, Khabarovsk,

and Cheboksary. The video conference was used to hold two methodological meetings on the use of the Library resources in the educational process. 65 specialists from 17 regions of Russia took part in these meetings.

The program of practical lessons teaching students and professors of the Tyumen region educational institutions how to work with the Presidential Library resources was developed and released. 5769 people became participants of this program.

Presidential Library employees participate in a range of international, national, and regional scientific and research-to-practice conferences, as well as the publications of the research results that contribute to the exchange of scientific information. The specialists of the Library prepared a lot of scientific issues, among them were periodic issues of “Digital Library” and “Electronic Legislation” collections and the materials of the round-table meeting “1612 and 1812 as the Key Stages of Forming the National Historical Consciousness”. These issues, accompanied by the review and the videos of the conference participants’ speeches (the conference was held in April, and was dedicated to the information legislation) are accessible on the multimedia website of the Library.

In 2013, the Presidential Library held and participated in international, national, and regional research-to-practice and round-table conferences, in which a great number of scientists, government officials, corporate sector executives, non-governmental organizations representatives, specialists in the spheres of librarian, archival and museum activities participated. The International research-to-practice conference “Receiving, Storage and Use of Information in the Electronic Environment: Public and Private Legal Regulation” and the IV All-Russian research-to-practice

conference “Cultural Legacy: Integration of the Resources in the Digital Space” were among the most important events of 2013. Much attention was paid to scientific events, connected to the theory, the history, and the practice of Russian statehood and the Russian language. “The Senate Readings for Young Lawyers”, organized for the first time by the Presidential Library in cooperation with the Constitutional Court of the Russian Federation, became the event dedicated to the history of creation the current federal Constitution. Prominent scientists, specialists in law from 11 universities and scientific institutions of Moscow, Saint Petersburg, Yekaterinburg, Tver, and Tyumen discussed the historical and legal issues of the Russian constitution during the round-table conference with the help of video conference communication. The dialogue between Russian and western historians was conducted in the frameworks of the International scientific conference “Russian Statehood: Government and Society in the 20th Century”, which was held in association with the Saint Petersburg State University.

Educational Activities

The Presidential Library educational activities are a complex of separate events and multiplestage projects. Their aim is the electronic spread of knowledge about Russian statehood for different groups of users, primarily for the youth.

“Russia in the Electronic World” student Olympiad is an annual educational project of the Library. The reporting year was marked by the end of the third and the beginning of the fourth student contest. The project continues to develop. The final tour of the third Olympiad was for the first time conducted not only in Saint Petersburg, but also at the premises of the Library branch in the Tyumen region. As a result, a number of visitors from the eastern part of Russia significantly increased. A distinctive feature of the fourth Olympiad was the fact that for the first time the pupils competed in three subjects: the History of Russia, the Social Science, and the Russian Language. A demo lesson of the Constitution coincided with the start of the student contest. The lesson was taught to the pupils of Saint Petersburg and Leningrad region classical schools, moreover, pupils from nine regions of Russia joined the others via video conference.

On the Constitution Day, December 12, the project for senior students “Multimedia

Lessons of the Constitution” commenced. The format of the lesson turn a usual excursion in the library into an educational event, which not only let the visitors learn about the history of the constitutional development of Russia, but also provide them with an opportunity to take a test to check their knowledge.

In 2013, the Library became a co-arranger of the National school project competition held by the Ministry of Education and Science and dedicated to the 20th anniversary of the Russian Constitution. The Library participated in the creation of the “Virtual Museum of the Constitution of the Russian Federation” portal in conjunction with the Russian Historical Society and the Academic RAS-MSU center, furthermore, the Library, together with the Tyumen regional State Institution of regional education development, organized and held a regional competition of professional skills “Teacher of the Year of the Tyumen Region – 2013”. Apart from that, the Library contributed to the work of the Center of National Fame at holding the “Service of the Country: Events and Names” competition, and helped the Federal Agency for Affairs of the Commonwealth of Independent States, Compatriots Residing Abroad and International Humanitarian Co-Operation (Rossotrudnichestvo) in holding the Belarus

competition coincided with the 1150th anniversary of the Slavonic writing.

The video lecture "Knowledge about Russia" continued to be delivered in the reporting year. The majority of the lectures were dedicated to the Russian history anniversaries: the 400th anniversary of the House of Romanov, the 150th anniversary of the University charter, the 20th anniversary of the Russian Constitution, etc. The Library multimedia website broadcasted live transmissions of the meetings. The events were conducted with the use of video conference technology for providing participation of other cities of Russia and the former Soviet republics. The video conference technology made the performance of lecturers from Moscow, Kostroma, Irkutsk, Tula, and other cities possible.

"The Arctic Day in the Presidential Library", a new scientific educational event for the student community, coincided with the Arctic Day, which is celebrated February 28. At the beginning of an academic year the library traditionally celebrated the Knowledge Day, in the frameworks of which the scientific and educational conference "Society, Government, and Official Language in Russia" and the Day of Naval Knowledge were held. In October, students of naval educational institutions visited the presentation of the Presidential Library projects, which were prepared together with the Russian State Archive of the Navy, the Central Navy Museum,

and the Kronstadt district administration to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the Russian's Navy goodwill visits to New York and San Francisco.

In 2013, the "Foreign View" photo contest was conducted for the fourth time. Its motto ("Language in a Changing World") corresponded to the thematic year of the Library – the Year of the Russian language. The photos of professional photographers were distinguished into a separate nomination for the first time. The opening of the contest was accompanied with a photo master class, and the closing ceremony was conducted together with a demonstration of a film made by one of the German partners of the Library – the Eastern Bavarian technical university of Amberg – Weiden. In order to promote the photo contest, the Library organized the exhibition of A. Lange's photos, "Russia from the Train Window", and conducted the "Photo Expedition. From Idea to Realization" master class.

The Film Club, which was opened at the end of 2012, continued its successful work. It became a permanent site for demonstration and discussion of documentaries, conducting meetings with filmmakers both prominent and amateur, fine art experts, critics, scientists, and public figures. The agenda of the meetings are composed in a close creative collaboration with such leading non-fictional film studios as Lennauchfilm, Saint Petersburg documentary studio "LenDoc", regional studios, as well as with major festivals of non-fiction films.

Most of the video and multimedia products prepared in 2013 were educational. These products include films, video collections, video excursions, video lessons, and a great share of the Library employees publications.

Publishing and Printing Activities

The diversity of the Presidential Library scientific and educational work and the cooperation with different partners are reflected in the publishing and printing activities of the institution. In 2013, reading audience was highly interested in traditional annual series “Digital Library” and “Electronic Legislation”, and in issues made from the materials of scientific and round-table conferences.

One of the publishing tasks is the preparation and release of methodological literature, covering some aspects of electronic librarianship. This tradition was preserved last year by the release of a collection of methodological materials “The Principles and Approaches to Combination of Representation and Providing Access to Bibliographic, Archived, and Museum Resources”. In order to provide assistance to users in learning the rules of working with the Library's digital resources, the Library issued new information brochures, which were to be distributed in regional centers of the Presidential Library. These brochures reflect the specific character of remote electronic reading rooms.

The experience of rare and valuable graphic materials publication from national archives, obtained in the previous years, contributed to the release of the “International Saint Petersburg” catalog. It was created in collaboration with the Russian State Historical Archive and coincided with the exhibition, dedicated to the 310th anniversary of the Northern Capital foundation. The unique musical legacy associated with the House of Romanov was released in a two-volume album-catalog “The House of Romanov. 400 Years”, created in conjunction with the National Library of Russia. Several other organizations and private authors are interested in collaborative projects and printing activities, conducted by the Presidential Library. In 2013, the premises of the Library was used for printing printed materials from the State museum-preserve “Pavlovsk”, the St. Petersburg Central City Public Library named after V. V. Mayakovski (St. Petersburg), the Central Public Children's Library named after A. S. Pushkin (St. Petersburg), the Consultative and Diagnostic Center and Polyclinic under the jurisdiction of the Department of Affairs of the President of the Russian Federation, the Central Scientific Computing Center of the Department of Affairs of the President of the Russian Federation,

the Regional Public Foundation of the Annual International festival of classical music “Palaces of Saint Petersburg”, the KIT Finance Investment bank, and others.

As in the previous year, much attention was paid to presentation materials of the Library's activities and projects. A distinctive feature of 2013 was the creation of information materials about the new collections, released issues and films of the Presidential Library. Part of the projects are accompanied with the release of a complete set of published and printed materials, designed in one visual style.

The Presidential Library's printed products are an integral part of major book exhibitions.

In 2013, the Library specialists represented the institution and consulted the visitors during the VIII Saint Petersburg International Book Salon and the 26th Moscow International Book Fair.

The Presidential Library production, as well as several issues released in the frameworks of joined projects with external companies, are published on the multimedia website. A range of books (particularly, methodological materials and a series of books “Collections of the Presidential Library”) are accessible for free downloading in PDF.

The year of 2013 was marked by a significant increase in the volume of production released on computer carriers.



Excursion Activities

In 2013, the excursion activities of the Library were carried out in accordance with an increased public interest to the development of the institution. The awareness of the public about the current excursions was improved, the excursion programs were renovated, so that they could both cover the specific features of different categories of visitors and more fully present technological, cultural, and educational possibilities of the Library. The main emphasis was made on the educational component of the excursions, which provided integration

elements for exhibition or cultural and educational projects.

A new excursion and educational program “The Lesson of the Constitution” was prepared for the celebration of the 20th anniversary of the Russian Constitution and was designed particularly for senior students. Apart from providing general knowledge about the history of the Presidential Library building (which used to be the building of the Synod), it offers the demonstration of presentations on “The Constitution” thematic collection in the electronic reading room, as well as the participation in the contest on knowing the Constitutions provisions, which is held with the use of modern information technologies,

and the study of the exhibition, dedicated to the history of Russian constitutional development.

Much attention was paid to the organization of familiarizing excursions for specialists, studying innovational forms of electronic libraries activities in general and work technologies of their branches: departments of scanning, multimedia complexes, electronic reading rooms. The practice of excursion services for disabled visitors expanded.

In 2013, the Library was involved in modernization of the quality of excursion services provided on the basis of the excursion and methodological materials development and the skills upgrading events for the employees.



Exhibition Activities

The topics of the 2013 exhibitions were chosen in accordance with the calendar of memorable dates and anniversaries in Russian history, as well as with federal and public national events.

The technological equipment of the Presidential Library made possible the organization of complex exhibitions, which included not only traditional exhibits, but also their digital copies. The number of multimedia exhibitions, based only on the digital content, grew significantly. This type of exhibition allowed the widening of the thematic range of exhibitions and made them more mobile. The “Russian Pavilions at the World Exhibitions”

multimedia project can serve as a successful example, having been demonstrated during the G20 summit in September, 2013.

Along with the fact that the Library prepared thematic exhibitions itself, it also organized exhibitions of showpieces, a significant part of which was offered by regional partners. For the first time in the history of its exhibition activities the Library participated in organization of an international exhibition (“The Circassians: from the Caucasus to the World” held in the Museum of Ethnography, Germany), representing one of its sections.

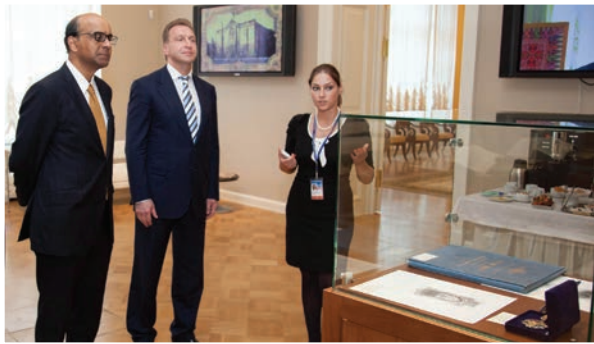

» In 2013, the Library conducted excursions for 6984 visitors divided into 475 groups.

» In the reporting period, the Library conducted 15 exhibitions of different type, which is 4 times greater than the 2012 index.

» Over 350 Russian and foreign organizations took part in scientific and educational events, held by the Presidential Library alone or in collaboration with partners.

» The Presidential Library employees became the participants of different conferences, round-table events, seminars, which took place in Arkhangelsk, Zvenigorod, Krasnoyarsk, Mozhaisk, Moscow, Penza, Ryazan, Samara, Saint Petersburg, Sochi, Tyumen, Ulyanovsk, Khabarovsk, as well as in Astana (Kazakhstan), Washington (the USA), Minsk (Belarus), Sudak (Crimea, Ukraine), Tashkent (Uzbekistan), and others.

State and Socio-Political Events

In the reporting year, the Presidential Library held a range of events, in which participated governmental officials and public figures of Russia and foreign countries. The III High Profile International conference “Atomic Energy in the XXI Century”, in which ministerial delegations and experts from 87 countries and 5 international organizations participated in, the 4th meeting of the High Level Russia-Singapore Inter-Governmental Commission, and the meeting of the 16th session of the Russian-Swedish Supervisory Committee on Trade and Economic Cooperation were among the most important ones.

Organizational and technological opportunities of the Library were used for providing support of the governmental officials’ activities. On April 25, 2013, the Presidential Library, in close collaboration with the All-Russian State Television and Radio Broadcasting Company and the Channel One, provided live broadcast from the new scene of the Mariinsky Theatre, where many prominent culture figures of Saint Petersburg gathered to hear the speech of V. V. Putin, the President of the Russian Federation. The Library specialists also worked at the preparation and running of the G20 summit.

In order to strengthen the relationships between the government and religious organizations, the Library provided assistance in holding the visit of His Holiness the Patriarch

Kirill of Moscow and All Russia and the Patriarch Theophilos III of Jerusalem in Saint Petersburg, and in organization of the Holy Synod of the Russian Orthodox Church meeting.

The following socio-political events should be distinguished as the most important ones in the reporting year: the plenary session of the National meeting with elections commissioners of the Russian Federation constituent territories, the All-Russian Forum of arbitral and business community “Modernization of Legislation on Arbitral Proceedings and International Arbitration: Modern Standards and Approaches of the Leading Arbitral Centers”, the V Russian-German conference of young leaders “Germany – Russia: New Generation”, and the meetings of the commission on the announcement of the architectural concepts competition results, held for the construction of a complex of buildings needed for moving the Supreme Court and the Justice Department of the Russian Federation to Saint Petersburg. Traditionally, a range of events addressed to the veterans of the Great Patriotic War, the citizens of the sieged Leningrad, the veterans of labor, the retired, the students, and the pupils were held to commemorate the following memorable dates – the Defender of the Fatherland Day, the 70th anniversary of the breaking of the siege, the 69th anniversary of the complete raising of the siege, the Victory Day, the Constitution Day.

Scientific and Educational Events

The Presidential Library supported the development of science and education through its projects, the most popular of which are the Knowledge Day and the annual conferences on information legislation and resource integration in digital space. In 2013, a new type of activities – the Lesson of the Constitution – was added to the Presidential Library's scientific and educational events. Apart from the audience that gathered in the Presidential Library building, the audience from 9 regions of Russia joined the others via video conference. Moreover, a large and diverse Internet audience also took part in the event.

In the framework of supporting the activities of external companies in the reporting year, the Library ran several events, the most significant of which was the National social studies teachers' convention "Constitutional and Legislative Values in Forming of a Pupil's Personality", dedicated to the 20th anniversary of the Constitution of the Russian Federation, the IV Saint Petersburg Educational Forum plenary meeting on the topic "Modernization of Education as a Cultural Phenomenon", the grand opening ceremony of the 10th All-Russian competition of the professional skills of teachers of extended education, "I Give My Heart to Children", dedicated the 95th anniversary of the state system of extended (beyond the classroom) education in Russia. Moreover, the Library provided organizational support for running the meeting of the Working Party on the preparation of the opening of the Russian Historical Society branch in Saint Petersburg, the International research-to-practice conference "Russian Constitutional Model: Conception, Realization, Perspectives", the International scientific conference "Russian Statehood: Government and Society in the 20th Century", the grand opening of the innovative educational project "All-Russian School of Philology", the grand closing ceremony of the Baltic media school

for the youth, the mass media conference "Digital Historical Investigations", and others.

The specific feature of these events is the involvement of remote participants with the help of video conference and Internet broadcasting. In 2013, video conferences were used mostly for communication with the citizens of Arkhangelsk, Moscow, Omsk, Tula, and Tyumen.

Cultural Events

Traditionally, the Presidential Library acted as the site for running significant cultural events. In 2013, the public was greatly interested in the concerts “Musical Evenings in the Presidential Library” and “Seasons”, which were conducted in the framework of an annual concert cycle, the gala concert “Vivat, Russia!”, held under the 21st International festival of classical music “Palaces of Saint Petersburg” (in commemoration of Agustín de Betancourt), and the gala concert “Vivat, Elena!”, dedicated to the 50th anniversary of the creative activities of E. V. Obratzova, the People’s artist of the USSR.

In the reporting year, the Library regularly held presentations of publishing and exhibition projects. The solemn presentation of “The House of Romanov. 400 Years. Album-Catalogue of Printed Music” collection attracted public attention.

The creation of this collection was carried out in the frameworks of a joined project of the Presidential Library and the National Library of Russia. Researchers of the history of the House, representatives of cultural and educational institutions, music schools, and creative teams took part in the event. Some of these musical works were performed publicly for the first time.

In November, the Presidential Library held the final meeting of the 2nd Saint Petersburg Cultural Forum Organizing Committee, in which the officials of the Russian Federation Government and the heads of different cultural institutions participated.

Most of the events were held with the use of the video recording and the Internet broadcast technologies.

» In the reporting year, the Library held 97 events, which were participated by at least 13 thousand people. This index is 30% greater than that of 2012.

» In 2013, the Presidential Library organized 24 TV live broadcasts and 50 Internet broadcasts of the events.

Academic Board Activities

The Library Academic Board contributes to the development of the Library, it studies conceptual and strategic issues. The methodological character of the Academic Board activities is governed by the integration of efforts of the leading universities, libraries, archives, and museums of Russia, representatives of which are the members of the Academic Board. The members of the Academic Board gave their assessment and comments to the concept project of the institution development in the period to 2020. Furthermore, the practice of the involvement of organizations, whose representatives are the members of the Academic Board, into the discussion and the realization of separate projects has expanded. The Library regularly informs all members of the Academic Board about the plans of its activities. In the reporting year, presidents of the Immanuel Kant Baltic Federal University and the North Caucasus Federal University became the new members of the Board.

In 2013, the Academic Board held two public on-line meetings. During the April meeting, the Board discussed the issues of providing access

to modern electronic scientific and educational resources. At the October meeting, the Board considered the educational legislative provisions, covering the issues of providing the educational process with electronic information resources. Such high level officials as the representatives of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation, the employees of the Institute of Russian History of the Russian Academy of Sciences, the St. Petersburg Branch of the Institute of Russian History of the Russian Academy of Sciences, and the representatives of the electronic educational resources producers took part in the meeting. The topicality of the discussions was connected to the coming into effect of the Federal law of the Russian Federation on Education. Special emphasis was made on the creation of new interaction perspectives in the relations between educational organizations and libraries, great attention was paid to the issues of historical and cultural standards due to the use of digital resources and the development of information culture of those involved into the process of education.

In 2013, the Presidential Library preserved its collaborative relations with different organizations of the Russian Federation.

During the reporting year, the Presidential Library electronic holdings were extended thanks to ready regional sources, namely by digital copies of rare and valuable books, cartographic and periodical issues. Four regional universal libraries and two national republican libraries offered their holdings for the planned digitalizing, carried out to extend the Presidential Library's holdings. Digital copies of the issues, preserved in the holdings of federal special libraries (the Socio-Political State Library, the State Public Historical Library of Russia, and the Saint Petersburg State Theater Library) were included in thematic collections of the Presidential Library.

In the framework of realization the digitalizing project, covering the archived documents, the key focus was set on the digitalizing of the materials of the major federal archives of the country – the Russian State Historical Archive and the State Archive of the Russian Federation. In order to create “The Constitution of the Russian Federation. Year 1993” digital collection the Library used digital copies of the documents received from the Archive of the President of the Russian Federation. The State Archives of the Krasnoyarsk Krai, the Tyumen and the Penza regions acted as the participants of several joined projects.

The Library developed collaboration in the field of digital collections formation with scientific libraries of the universities, namely the Herzen State Pedagogical University of Russia, the Saint Petersburg State University, the Saint Petersburg State University of Culture and Arts, the FINEC. Digital copies of periodic editions received from university holdings became the part of “The Russian Periodicals in the Presidential Library's Holdings” collection. This collection united legal, social, political, geographical,

literature, regional, and other magazines, as well as basic and thematic collections.

In 2013, the institution continued its work at authors' abstracts acquisition in the framework of the profile activities of the Library. In accordance with official agreements, the electronic holdings of the Presidential Library included authors' abstracts of the theses on history, law, and philology, posted on 12 sites of educational and scientific establishments of Russia, among which are the following: the V. V. Vinogradov Russian Language Institute of the Russian Academy of Sciences, the Russian Academy of Justice, Russian State University for the Humanities, as well as the Kazan Federal University and the Siberian Federal University, the State Universities of Vladimir, Volgograd, Irkutsk, Kemerovo, Tomsk, and Yaroslavl. All in all, 724 authors' abstracts (or 19,500 of pages) were downloaded in the information system of the Presidential Library in the reporting year.

In the reporting year, the Library signed an agreement with the Immanuel Kant Baltic Federal University, the Kazan Federal University, the North Caucasus Federal University, the N. G. Kuznetsov Naval Academy, the Birobidzhan State University in the Name of Sholem Aleichem.

In order to conduct the formation of digital collections and create multimedia products of scientific and educational purpose, the Presidential Library collaborated with a range of Russian museums: the Russian Museum, the State Hermitage Museum, the Russian Museum of Ethnography, the Military-Historical Museum of Artillery, Engineer and Signal Corps, the State Museum-Reserve of Alexander Pushkin “Mikhailovskoye”, the Museum of the Archeology of Old Ladoga, the Tobolsk State Historical and Architectural Museum-Reserve, the Tula State Arms Museum. The Library continued digitalizing the pre-revolutionary and Soviet

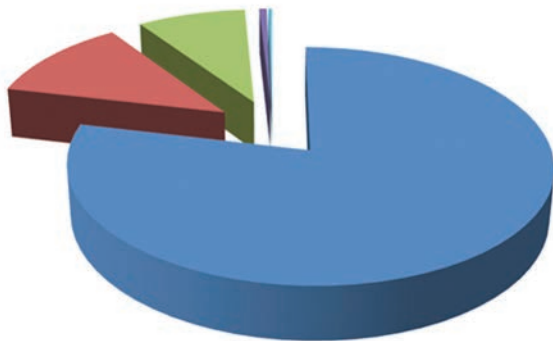
collection of postcards (the Children’s Postcard Museum).

The collaboration with the Russian Orthodox Church establishments, for instance, with the library of Saint Alexander Nevsky Lavra of the Saint Petersburg diocese of the Russian Orthodox Church, Alexander-Svirsky Monastery, and others, developed even further.

One of the examples of the multilateral partnership is the creation of “Saint Petersburg

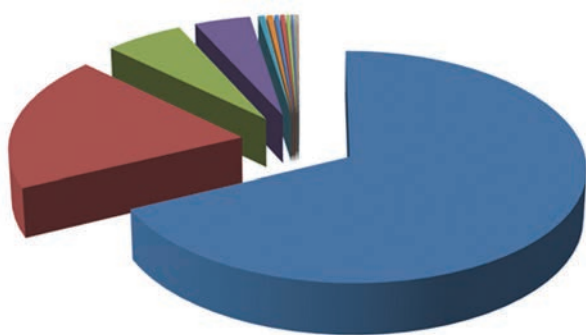
and Russian Avant-Garde Art” digital collection, dedicated to the G20 summit. The collection was composed of the Russian Museum materials, Presidential Library’s holdings and the materials received from the Saint Petersburg State Theater Library, the Herzen State Pedagogical University of Russia, the Russian State Documentary Film and Photo Archive, and some private collections.

Regional Relations

In the end of 2013, the number of constituent territories of the Russian Federation, the administration of which signed agreements on the Presidential Library branches creation, reached 33; moreover, seven of these territories started conducting the negotiations on these agreements in the reporting year. The Presidential Library performs its activities under the directions of general organization and methodology, formed by the regional network, so, in order to prepare specialists, the Library provided training for its employees. As a result, more than 200 employees of regional centers received skills and knowledge on formation and storage of digital content and providing access to it.

The work at the involvement of regional centers into their remote participation in seminars, conferences, and other events, conducted in the Presidential Library, was continued. In the reporting year, the Presidential Library organized a number of video conferences in liaison with regions of the Russian Federation: for instance, “Battle of Stalingrad: Sources and Historiography” (the Gorky Regional

Universal Scientific Library of Volgograd), the International conference-webinar “Arctic Day in the Presidential Library” (the Lomonosov Northern (Arctic) Federal University), “Day of Naval Knowledge” (the Maritime State University).

In December 2013, the Presidential Library joined its efforts with the Tyumen branch of the Library and conducted working sessions for the Presidential Library regional centers via the video conference on the matter of the use of the Library holdings in educational process, using the example of the Secondary General Education School № 2 of the Zavodoukovsky urban district of the Tyumen Region. More than 16 regions of Russia participated in the event.

In October 2013, the heads of the Library regional centers ran a working session on the issues of accessibility of the holdings, summarized the results of the activities in the reporting year, and charted a course for the future development of the regional network for 2014–2016.

International Relations

In the reporting year, the Presidential Library continued its activities in international organizations, to which it belongs: the Conference of Directors of National Libraries (CDNL), the Conference of European National Librarians (CENL), the International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions (IFLA).

The Presidential Library was represented on many international forums. Director General of the Presidential Library A. P. Vershinin headed the working group “Culture and Art” of the 3rd “Russia – Republic of Korea Dialogue” Forum, which ran in Seoul. The Library worked in a subgroup “Culture” in the frameworks of the high-level Russian-German forum “Petersburg Dialogue”.

The Presidential Library delegations took part in international conferences, seminars, exhibitions, and round-table meetings in 10 countries of the world, including Germany, Singapore, Ukraine, the United States, Azerbaijan, and others.

For the purpose of arranging bilateral cooperation, the Presidential Library signed an agreement with National Historical Library of Ukraine and with the Dnepropetrovsk Regional

Universal Scientific Library, and a memorandum of understanding and cooperation with the Azerbaijan National Library in 2013. The Library carried out consultations and negotiations on future collaboration with international libraries, archives, and cultural centers of Austria, Norway, Uzbekistan, Finland, France, and Japan.

The Library strengthened its professional engagement and interaction with the Russian-American group on library cooperation: intermediate meetings of the “Joint Digital Projects” and the “Technologies and Best Practices” subgroups were held in Washington. In November 2013, the administration of the Presidential Library visited the National Constitution Center and the John F. Kennedy Presidential Library, where it participated in the discussion on questions of perspective cooperation, particularly: running of a joint conference on the issues of constitutionalism and statehood in Russia and the United States, and the creation of educational content for the younger generation.

In the framework of Russian-American bilateral dialogue, the demonstration of

the “Russian Fleet at the Shores of America” documentary was presented at the Russian Embassy in the United States at the event, dedicated to the 150th anniversary of the expedition of the Russian fleet of warships sent to the coasts of North America.

In the reporting year, the Presidential Library and the Museum of Ethnography in Hamburg realized a joint project – “The Circassians: from the Caucasus to the World” exhibition.

In June 2013, the delegation of the Presidential Library shared its experience on electronic libraries functioning during its working trip to the Berlin State Library, the Library of the Kiel University, the Carl von Ossietzky State and University Library in Hamburg, and other establishments.

The Presidential Library specialists conducted a range of educational events for employees of the National Libraries of Kazakhstan and Ukraine at the premises of the Presidential Library, as well as a training seminar on the topic of forming and cataloguing of digital resources of electronic libraries at the premises of the “Nazarbayev Center” in Astana. In October 2013, the Presidential Library employees were trained at the Library of Congress under the joint project with the World Digital Library.

The institution specialists organized the “Integrated Digital Resources in Modern Information Sphere” round-table meeting at the “Crimea-2013” International conference.

In the reporting period, the work on opening remote electronic reading rooms of the Presidential Library abroad continued with the support of the Rossotrudnichestvo. The Library interaction with centers, which had been opened in the period from 2010 to 2013, developed. In order to provide information support of the events in the Rossotrudnichestvo representative offices all around the world, the Library on a regular basis provided them with audiovisual materials, as well as with specialized collections, dedicated to the key dates in the history of Russia. Foreign remote reading rooms used video conference technologies to join the events, which were held at the premises of the Library.

In July 2013, the “Modern Digital Libraries in the Information Environment of Russia and China” International conference was organized at the premises of the Presidential Library as a part of the collaboration events with the Library Society of China and the National Library of China.

» In 2013, the Presidential Library cooperated with 9 museums, 6 archives, 20 libraries of the Russian Federation.

» 5 universities took part in projects on holdings digitalizing in the frameworks of the State contract, 10 universities provided official permissions on using authors’ abstracts.

» The administrations of the constituent territories of Russia provided support in creation of a network of 23 regional centers and 68 electronic reading rooms with an access to information resources of the Presidential Library, 10 regional centers and 45 electronic reading rooms of which were opened in 2013 only.

» The Presidential Library signed 50 cooperation agreements with 7 constituent territories of the Russian Federation, 21 libraries, 15 universities, 2 archives, and other organizations.

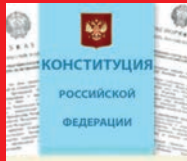
» Attendees from 170 institutions of Russia, Ukraine, Kazakhstan, and Uzbekistan took part in research-to-practice seminars.

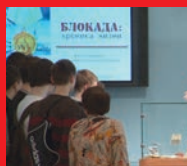

Projects of the Year



20th Anniversary of the Constitution of the Russian Federation.

In the framework of the celebration of the 20th anniversary of the Constitution of the Russian Federation, the Library prepared “The Constitution of the Russian Federation. Year 1993” thematic digital collection. The Library also supported the creation of the Electronic Museum of the Constitutional History of Russia on the Internet. Moreover, the visitors were able to visit a temporary exhibition, dedicated to the history of constitutional ideas, and a renovated version of a permanent exhibition, devoted to the current Constitution. Scientific society got an opportunity to participate in a round-table meeting “Russian Constitution in the Context of Historical and Legal Researches (on the 20th Anniversary of the Constitution of the Russian Federation)”, as for students, they could take part in the first Senate readings for young lawyers on the following topic: “The Constitution of the Russian Federation: the Unknown Known”. The youth could participate in the video lectures, devoted to the principal law of the country, and take part in the presentation of the book authored by S. M. Shakhrai “About Constitution”. Among the schoolchildren-oriented events are the online broadcasted



demo constitutional lesson and the cycle of excursions for senior students “The Multimedia lesson of the Constitution”, which started December 12. Apart from that, the Presidential Library took part in assessment of the works, presented at the competition of school projects, dedicated to the 20th anniversary of the Constitution of the Russian Federation, and offered prizes to the winners on the eve of the jubilee.



400th Anniversary of the House of Romanov.

The events of the Presidential Library marking the date of the accession to the throne of Mikhail Fedorovich, the founder of the dynasty, started from the running of a video lecture and posting “The House of Romanov. 400th



Anniversary of the Zemsky Sobor of 1613” digital collection on the multimedia website of the Library. On the jubilee of the House of Romanov the Library prepared the opening of the exhibition “For the Sake of the Whole Country ...” Imperial Societies and Institutions of Russia in XVIII–XX Centuries (on the 400th anniversary of the House of Romanov). A range of publishing and multimedia projects was prepared by the Presidential Library in cooperation with other organizations, including a video excursion the “Books from the House of Romanov Libraries

in the Holdings of the Russian State Library” a two-volume album-catalogue “The House of Romanov. 400 Years”, created in conjunction with the National Library of Russia. In order to present the album, a concert was held at the premises of the Presidential Library. The musicians played pieces of music, composed by the members of the royal family. Shots of this event were included into the film, dedicated to the album-catalogue. On the anniversary of the House of Romanov the Library also prepared a video excursion “Tula Gun Smithing Under the House of Romanov”. The “Historical Lotto” film was dedicated to the educational and pedagogic traditions of the royal family. The film was prepared with the participation of “The M-Art” children’s multimedia studio. The film tells about board and educative games, which allowed the children of the royal family to study the history of their dynasty while playing.



Russian Language. In 2013, the Library launched a new thematic year of the Presidential Library, dedicated to the Russian language. The Knowledge Day in the Library offered the visitors a digital collection “The Russian Language”. Moreover, the Library organized a live broadcast of the scientific and educational conference “Society, Government, and Official



Language in Russia”. At the conference the Library in cooperation with the Pushkin Apartment Museum demonstrated the “...My Home Address: at River Moika, not far from the Konyushenny Bridge...” video excursion. The beginning of the thematic year was marked by an opening of the exhibition “To Spread Sound and Patriotic Thoughts. Projects of Sociopolitical Issues in Russia in the Second Quarter of the XIX Century”. For the first time the tasks on the Russian language were included in the program of the regular student Olympiad “Russia in the Electronic

World”. On request of the Rossotrudnichestvo the Library prepared questions for the student Olympiad, conducted in Belarus and dedicated the 1150th anniversary of the creation of the Slavonic writing. One of the video lectures, “Knowledge about Russia”, was dedicated to the problems of the history of the Russian literary language – from its old Slavonic roots to its current form.



G20 Summit. In order to provide information support for the summit, the Presidential Library posted two collections of documents on its multimedia website – “Russia in the Foreign Trade: the Past and the Present” and “Saint Petersburg and Russian Avant-Garde Art”. The last one was also posted on the official site of the Russian presidency in G20 in Russian and English. Three multimedia exhibitions were prepared for the press center. Two of them were dedicated to the history of Russian external economic relations (“The Russian Pavilions at the World Exhibitions” and “Russia in the Foreign Trade”), and the third, (“Saint Petersburg and Russian Avant-Garde Art”), as well as one of the collections, put emphasis on the graphic style of the G20 logo, designed under the influence of the Russian avant-garde school. “The Chairmen of the Space”, a documentary, which was also dedicated to the Russian avant-garde school and created in cooperation with the Russian Museum, became a part of the multimedia maintenance of the G20 summit.



Collections



Russian Language. On September 1, 2013, the Presidential Library released “The Russian Language” thematic collection, dedicated to the Russian language as the official language of the Russian Federation. The materials

of the collection reflect the main historic stages of the development of the Russian language (from its origin to our time), the researches on the Russian language, the methodology of learning the language in educational institutions and without professional assistance, the government policy in the field of the Russian language. The collection included manuscripts and published issues of the masterpieces of Russian literature, archived files, scientific works (including theses and authors’ abstracts), dictionaries and reference books, different teaching guides, aimed at people with different language proficiency. In order to form the collections, the Library used the materials from the holdings of more than 30 institutions. The starting volume of the materials made up 500 documents.



House of Romanov. 400th Anniversary of the Zemsky Sobor of 1613. In 2013, Russia celebrated the 400th anniversary of the accession to the throne of Mikhail Fedorovich Romanov, the founder of a new royal dynasty.

The 1613 Zemsky sobor and the representatives of the House of Romanov became the key figures of the collection, including 900 units of storage. The life and the activity of the royal family members was shown by different types of materials: official documents, historic researches, memoirs, diaries, official and personal letters, newsreel fragments, photographs, pieces of art, radio recordings, and scientific documentaries.



Russian Naval Expedition to the Shores of North America (1863–1864).

In 1860s two Russian cruiser squadrons, commanded by rear admirals S. S. Lesovsky and A. A. Popov, went on an expedition to the shores of North

America. The fact that the Americans rapturously greeted an unexpected Russian fleet had a great political effect and contributed to the Russian-American rapprochement. The collection, dedicated to this political fact included articles and reviews, published in the Russian press in the period from the time of the expedition to the time being, the “Russian Fleet at the Shores of America” documentary, and the essay, released by US Naval Historical Foundation.



Constitution of the Russian Federation. Year 1993.

On December 12, 1993, a new Constitution of the Russian Federation was adopted according to the results of the nation-wide vote. The materials of

the collection, which coincided with 20th anniversary of the event, reflect the direct participation of the President of the Russian Federation in the work at the project, the activity of the Constituent Assembly of Russia, which opened in the Kremlin June 5, 1993. The documents, which are included in the collection (some of them belong to the private owners, who personally participated in creating a new draft of the Constitution), help to recreate the atmosphere of that time, in which the work on creating the principal law of the country was done. The issues of the development of constitutional ideas in Russia, the meaning of the Constitution in the live of the state, the realization of constitutional rights are

reflected into the cycle of public lectures, delivered at the State Duma and devoted to the 20th anniversary of the Constitution, the history of the Russian constitutionalism, and the structuring of the state.



Russia in the Foreign Trade: the Past and the Present.

On December 1, 2012 the Russian Federation for the first time in its history became the presiding country of the G20 – the leading forum of the international cooperation on the most important aspects of international economic and finance agenda. On September 5–6, 2013, the G20 summit was held in Saint Petersburg. In order to commemorate this date, the Presidential Library prepared a special digital collection, which included issues and archival documents covering the problems of the development of trading bonds of Russia with European and Asian countries in the period from 17th to the beginning of 21st century. The collection, which consists of 272 units of storage, includes the materials of the legal nature (international commercial treaties and agreements, customs legislation, etc.), statistical reviews, monographs and authors' abstracts. The main emphasis is made on the history of the development and realization of the government customs policy as one of the major forms of governmental regulation concerning the external trade.



Saint Petersburg and Russian Avant-Garde.

The Russian Museum and the Presidential Library prepared a joint digital collection “Saint Petersburg and Russian Avant-Gard” for the G20 summit, held in Saint Petersburg. This collection included general researches on the history of the Russian avant-garde school, albums and catalogues of the exhibitions, dedicated to this art division, works of several abstractionists. Much interest was paid to the materials, reflecting the atmosphere of the epoch. Among these materials are a newsreel, showing Petrograd of the first quarter of XX century, rare postcards with examples of the avant-garde design for

decorating festivals, the V. V. Kandinsky autobiography first published in 1918.



Kostroma in Postcards and Photographs: to Commemorate the 800th Anniversary of the First Mention in Chronicles.

The first annalistic mentioning of Kostroma dates back to 1213. This collection, marking the 800th anniversary of the event, included about 150 postcards and photographs of 20th – to the beginning of 21st century. They represent various sights of Kostroma, such as the Ipatiev Monastery, ancient buildings, city squares and streets, monuments. The pictures were taken by S. M. Prokudin-Gorsky, a distinguished photographer of the 20th century, and they show the relics of the Romanov and the Godunov families, stored in the sacristy of the Ipatiev Monastery.



Smolensk in Illustrations and Audio Records.

In 2013, Smolensk celebrated its 1150th anniversary. This city is one of the most ancient cities of Russia. It is a large administrative, industrial and cultural center of the Smolensk Oblast. This collection, prepared for this jubilee, include 10 audio records, telling the listeners the story of Smolensk from ancient times to the present day, as well as 140 postcards, photos, drafts, and plans of the end of 18th to the 20th century. They represent different sights of the Cathedral Church of the Assumption, the Smolensk Kremlin, various monuments, the city squares and streets.



Republic of Buryatia: Pages of History.

The collection includes statistic and cartographic materials, archival documents, researches and reviews dating back to the middle of 19th to the middle of 20th century. This collection familiarize the audience with demographic, ethnographic, sociopolitical and economic aspects of the history of the Republic of Buryatia.



Republic of Komi: Pages of History.

The selection includes researches, essays, archival documents, photographs, and phono-materials reflecting administrative, socio-economic and ethnographic situation of the areas, which are now part of the Republic of Komi.



Ryazan Oblast: Pages of History.

The collection includes studies, essays, archival documents, statistics, photographs, and sound recordings, which reflect the administrative, socio-economic, socio-political and cultural development of the Ryazan Oblast during the 14th – 20th centuries.



Saint Petersburg: Pages of History.

The compilation includes guides to memorable places and attractions, reference materials, statistics, graphic materials, descriptions and art-historical surveys of the city from its inception to the early 20th century. Besides, there are two city charters – a historical one, of the era of Paul I (1798) and the modern, currently in force (1998).



Tver Oblast: Pages of History.

The selection includes archival documents, essays, studies, statistics, and photographs of the 19th and early 20th centuries, covering different aspects of the history of the Tver Oblast.



Ulyanovsk Oblast: Pages of History.

The administrative, socio-economical, socio-political, and demographic situation of the territory of the Ulyanovsk Oblast is reflected by researches, essays,

statistic materials, and archival documents from the end of 18th to the early 20th century, which are included in the selection.



Khanty-Mansi Autonomous Okrug – Ugra: Pages of History.

The collection includes research, essays, statistic materials of the second half of the 19th to the early 20th century disclosing administrative, socio-economic, demographic and ethnographic situation of the Surgut and Berezov districts of the Tobolsk Province, whose territory makes part of the today’s Khanty-Mansi Autonomous Okrug – Ugra.



Chelyabinsk Oblast: Pages of History.

Different aspects of the history of the Southern Urals, mainly of the first third of the 20th century, are reflected in studies, archival documents, statistic materials, photographs, and sound records.



Yamal-Nenets Autonomous Okrug: Pages of History.

The collection includes researches, statistics, and archival documents of the second half of the 19th to the first half of the 20th century, which describe the administrative, social, economic, demographic and ethnographic position of the territories of the modern Yamal-Nenets Autonomous Okrug.



Russia – Hungary: From the History of Relations.

The collection features some legislative acts, official documents and other materials that characterize the administrative state and economic

structure of Hungary (including the period when it was part of the Austro-Hungarian Empire), as well as some aspects of its relations with Russia.

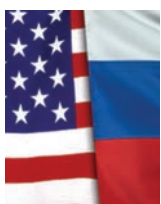


Russia – Kazakhstan: from the History of Relations. The featured statistical materials, studies, essays, archival documents, photographs and newsreels reveal the geography, ethnography, economics, cultural development, and administrative-territorial division of Kazakhstan in the 15th – early 20th centuries.



Russia – Korea: Bridges of Friendship. The following thematic collection covers researches, archival materials, reviews, photo materials, reflecting some aspects of bilateral relationships in different historical periods.

The collection specially emphasizes the topic of the Koreans migration to the Far East of the Russian Empire in the second half of the 19th to the beginning of the 20th century.



Russia – USA: from the History of Relations. The presented archival documents, researches, reference materials from the 18th to the middle of 20th century, as well as multimedia issues reveal different aspects of Russian-

American relations, which arose at the time of the formation of American statehood, and were based on close economic and political partnership.



Russia – Uzbekistan: from the History of Relations. The selected research works, essays, archival documents and photo materials disclose the geography, history of administrative structure, cultural and economic development of certain cities and regions

of the Republic of Uzbekistan, mostly during the time they were part of the Russian Empire.



Russia – Ukraine: from the History of Relations. The presented studies, essays, chronicles, archival documents and graphic materials reveal the administrative, socio-economic, socio-political, and cultural development of Ukraine, starting from the time of Kievan Rus' and ending with a period of annexation of Ukrainian provinces to the Russian Empire.



Information and Law: Actual Studies. Dissertation abstracts featured by the selection cover the period from 2006 to 2011, which reveal some aspects of the given topic: the right of citizens to information, regulation to information, information security, etc.

of access to information, information security, etc.



Textbooks on Geography. The selection is a significantly augmented and changed division of the “Territory of Russia” collection. The revised version of the collection of textbooks on geography includes 164 units of materials, divided into three main sections: educational publications issued before 1917, the year, when the Russian Revolution happened, after 1917, and teaching aids on geography.



Domestic Periodicals in the Collections of the Presidential Library. The collection of periodicals consists of 55 magazine items and 163 newspaper items, provided with the relevant annotations. The periodicals are of the following nature: legal, sociopolitical, literary, geographical, regional, front-line, etc. Most of the issues are accessible in a full-text form.

Scientific and Educational Events

Conferences

Videoconference “Battle of Stalingrad: Sources and Historiography” (January 31).

More than 40 scientists, professors, veterans, government officials and public figures took part in a breakout session of the “Battle of Stalingrad in People’s Destinies” research-to-practice conference, organized by the Presidential Library and the Volgograd Regional Universal Scientific Library n. a. A. M. Gorky. The participants read 19 reports, and after that, the discussion on the current state and perspectives of scientific, research and educational work began.

Research-to-Practice Conference “Technology and Practice of Creation High Quality Digital Resources” (February 27).

In close cooperation with the “ELAR” corporation the Presidential Library organized the conference, in which 120 specialists of the leading libraries of Russia, digital resources producers, domestic and foreign experts in the sphere of standardization participated. They discussed a wide range of questions, concerning the formation of high quality digital resources, created by digitalization of the originals. The specialists reviewed factors, which influence the quality of digital copies, the criteria of its assessment, the methods of scanning control, the issues of developing standards and requirements for the creation of digital copies and scanning equipment.

International Research-to-Practice Conference “Receiving, Storage, and Use of Information in the Electronic Environment: Public and Private Legal Regulation” (April 11–12). In this annual event, dedicated to the questions of the legal regulations of information, intellectual property, libraries activities, and formation of state informational resources and

systems, 33 reports were presented. More than 150 people took part in the conference. The video recordings of the selected reports, the reviews of the speeches, and the collection of the conference materials, published in the series “Electronic Legislation”, are presented on the multimedia website of the Library.

International Scientific Conference “Russian Statehood: Government and Society in the 21st Century” (May 30–31).

The event attracted over 70 researchers from Russia, The United States, Canada, Australia, Argentina, Germany, Italy, Israel, Turkey, The Czech Republic. The Presidential Library, the Saint Petersburg State University, and the Northwest Institute of Printing of the Saint Petersburg State University of Technology and Design became co-organizers of the conference, with the assistance of the Saint Petersburg Committee on external relations. The discussions were held on the topics of the impact of wars and revolutions in the development of Russian statehood, on the features of national and state development, and on the relations between the government and the civil society.

International Scientific Conference “Modern Digital Libraries in the Information Environment”



of Russia and China” (July 19). The event, which was attended by 39 Chinese and Russian specialists, was run in accordance with the memorandum on cooperation between the Department of Affairs of the President of the Russian Federation and the Administrative Department of the State Council of the People's Republic of China. 10 reports were presented at the conference; they were dedicated to the experience of digital collections and libraries creation.

Interregional Research-to-Practice Conference “Problems of Regional Encyclopedias Development” (October 14–15). Regional ethnographers, historians, and encyclopedist from 20 regions of Russia attended this event, run by the National Library of Russia, the Presidential Library, and the Likhachov Fund. They shared their experience in creating regional encyclopedias and discussed the current state and the development perspectives of regional encyclopedias in Russia.

IV All-Russian Research-to-Practice Conference “Cultural Legacy: Integration of the Resources in the Digital Space” (October 21–24). 124 specialists participated in this annual conference hosted by the Presidential Library. The 2-days panel discussion “Information Environment of Libraries, Archives, and Museums: Promising Areas of Development” was accompanied by presentations of 19 reports, dedicated to the solving of practical tasks, facing cultural and educational institutions. In the frameworks of the conference, the Library also run the International research-to-practice seminar “Methodology and Practice of the Presidential Library Digital Content Formation” and the working session of the participants in the regional network of the Presidential Library, which consists of 66 representatives from different regions of Russia.

Round-Table Meetings

2nd International Research-to-Practice Round-Table Meeting “Formation of Media Information Competency of Schoolchildren: Modern Programs, Technologies, and Innovations of the 21st Century” (May 28). The event was run in cooperation with the Russian school library association. 39 specialists took part in the meeting, including the representatives of

the University of North Texas. They discussed the issues of the creation of information and educative environment in school libraries, the means of children’s protection from undesirable information, the development of media competence of students, the retraining of library employees, and the innovational methods and sphered of work of school libraries.

“Integrated Digital Resources in the Modern Information Sphere” (Sudak, Ukraine, June 8–16).

The roving, problem-oriented seminar and the round-table meeting, held by the specialists of the Presidential Library, was attended by more than 50 participants of the 20th Jubilee International conference “Crimea-2013” – “Libraries and Information Resources in the Modern World of Science, Culture, Education, and Business”. The specialists reviewed the technological aspects of formation, development and maintenance of digital collections, the issues of improving the efficiency of information search on the basis of enhancement of linguistic support and organization of remote access to resources.

“Russian Constitution in the Context of Historical and Legal Research” (November 21).

This round-table meeting united legal specialists and historians from 11 institutions of academic science and universities of Saint Petersburg, Moscow, Yekaterinburg, Tver, Tyumen via video conference. 14 reports were discussed at the meeting. They looked at the constitutional history of Russia from the methodological point of view. Much attention was paid to the scientific interpretation of legal documents as historical evidences of evolution of constitutional and legal ideas, norms and institutions.



Several other round-table meetings were held in the framework of preparations and summarizing the results of scientific and educational events of the Presidential Library.

Seminars

In 2013, nine scientific and research-to-practice seminars were held for specialists of libraries, archives, museums, and universities, including the seminars organized under the annual research-to-practice conference of the Presidential Library “Cultural Legacy: Integration of the Resources in the Digital Space” on the topic of “Cataloging of Different Types of Resources” (October 21–23) and the 11th research-to-practice conference “Participants and Users of the National Information and Librarian Center LIBNET” “LIBNET-2012” on the topic of “Cataloging of Digital Resources and Maintenance of the Authority File” (November 19–20, Zvenigorod). Six events in Volgograd, Petrozavodsk, Saint Petersburg, Tambov, Khabarovsk, and Cheboksary, were devoted to the methodology and the practice of formation of the Presidential Library digital content. Two of them, including the seminar held at the premises of the “Nazarbayev Center” “Digital Libraries: Formation and Cataloging of Digital Resources” (March 12–15, Astana, Kazakhstan), were international. All in all, 520 attendees from 170 different institutions in Kazakhstan, Russian, Uzbekistan, and Ukraine took part in these seminars.

Scientific and Educational Events

International Conference-Webinar “Arctic Day in the Presidential Library” (February 28).

The Presidential Library and the Lomonosov Northern (Arctic) Federal University organized the conference, in which specialists from 12 national and foreign organizations, involved in studying and development of northern territories, participated. The participants presented 11 reports on ecological issues, scientific researches, education, improving the quality of life, and national security in the Arctic region, acknowledgement of the Arctic as the zone of peaceful interaction and cooperation. The conference attracted 189 participants, most of whom were students and professors of Russian federal and specialized universities.



Day of Knowledge (September 2).

In 2013, in the framework of the Day of Knowledge, the Library held the scientific and educational conference “Society, Government, and Official Language in Russia”. The leading scientists and philologists of academic and educational institutions of Saint Petersburg and Moscow presented their reports on scientific problems of current importance to the audience of the faculties of philology and philological departments of higher education institutes and specialized secondary schools. The event attracted about 450 students and professors from 10 universities of Saint Petersburg and the Leningrad Region, as well as 90 attendees from Novosibirsk, Omsk, Tyumen, and Bishkek (Kyrgyzstan) via video conference.

Day of Naval Knowledge (September 3).

The event united 410 participants from seven regions of Russia (Vladivostok, Kostroma, Moscow, Severodvinsk, Tyumen, Cheboksary), who presented their reports on the history of the formation and the development of the Russian marine forces. Moreover, the leading professors and heads of naval universities of the country, archive and museum specialists, representatives of the Church made their speeches at the event.

Senate Readings for Young Lawyers: on the 20th Anniversary of the Constitution of the Russian Federation (October 17).

This new joint event of the Presidential Library and the Constitutional Court of the Russian Federation attracted 339 students of the senior year, masters, post-graduates, doctoral candidates, and young professors of the departments of law of the universities of Saint Petersburg, the Arkhangelsk and Moscow Regions, Kirov, and Kostroma. The Readings were dedicated to the history of creation the current Constitution, the issues of explaining its provisions to the citizens of Russia, and the application of the Constitution.

Exhibitions



“The Siege: Chronicle of Life” (On the 70th Anniversary of the Breaking of the Siege and the 69th Anniversary of the Complete Raising of the Leningrad Siege). January 23 – May 10, 2013.

The exhibition told us about the changes in the lives of the citizens of Leningrad during the siege. Each of four blocks of the exhibition was dedicated to one of the key months in the tragic history of the city. September, 1941 – the beginning and the first month of the siege. January, 1942 – the most difficult days of the siege, the “deadly time”. January, 1943 – the breaking of the Nazi siege. January, 1944 – the complete raising of the siege. The diaries of the citizens reproduce the atmosphere of the period; they reflect the feelings of a single person in the city under siege. Such official materials as newspapers, leaflets, posters, photo reports of the Leningrad branch of the Telegraph Agency of Soviet Union, and the newsreel cover the events from the governmental, military and political point of view. News articles of that period describe the most important events and historical figures. The newsreels of the Telegraph Agency of Soviet Union documentarily show the audience the episodes of the sieged days; the shots of the newsreels reflect the atmosphere of the life in Leningrad. All of the exhibits, presented on the exhibition, – book issues, photo reports and newsreels, posters and numismatic items, citizens’ diaries – were created and came into existence in the sieged Leningrad.



“For the Sake of the Whole Country...” Imperial Societies and Institutions of Russia in the 18th to 20th Century (on the 400th Anniversary of the House of Romanov). May 27 – August 23, 2013.

The practice of granting of the “imperial” title appeared in Russia in 1747, when Elizaveta Petrovna, the Empress of Russia, adopted the “Order of the Academy of Sciences and Arts in Saint Petersburg”. In 1765, the Free Economic Society for the Encouragement of Agriculture and Husbandry became the first civil society organization, or simply the society, which achieved the right to be the “imperial”. The title “imperial” was granted to the institution by the emperor himself and practically meant the acknowledgement of beneficial and useful activity of an institution or an establishment on the highest administrative level. Furthermore, formally the connection between the “imperial” title of an institution and granted privileges, financing or any other types of support was not legally fixed. The archival documents of the 18th through early 20th century, published issues, various graphic, photo and video materials, presented at the exhibition told visitors the story of creation and activity of several the most important “imperial” societies and institutions, which existed in Russia in the period from the 18th century to 1917.



“To Spread Sound and Patriotic Thoughts. Projects of Sociopolitical Issues in Russia in the Second Quarter of the 19th Century”. September 2 – November 15, 2013.

The exhibition was created as a project of sociopolitical magazines and newspapers, authored by prominent representatives of Russian culture and science from the first half of the 19th century. Among them were the following figures: A. S. Pushkin, P. A. Vyazemsky, V. A. Zhukovsky, L. N. Tolstoy, M. P. Pogodin, and several others. These projects, though rather dissimilar in their formats and content, were united in order to achieve one goal – to form the nationally oriented public

opinion in Russia, loyal to the government, and to create a positive image of Russia abroad. Many of the projects of editions, for the first time presented in the framework of one exhibit, were not brought into life. Still undoubtedly, they made an impact on the evolution of the supreme power position of the Russian Empire, which gradually changed from the practice of the restriction of the distribution of political information in the society to the active formation of public opinion, the explanations and the popularization of the activities of the government.



“From the History of Constitutionalism in Russia: Projects and Constitutions of 18th through the 20th Century” (on the 20th Anniversary of the Constitution of the Russian Federation). December 12, 2013 – April 11, 2014.

The project united the temporary exhibition and the permanent exposition “From the History of Creation and Adoption of the Constitution of the Russian Federation”. Being logical continuations of each other, they reflect the development of domestic constitutionalism: from projects and ideas of the 18th century to the end of the Soviet epoch, from setting a task to creation the current Constitution. Philosophical and political ideas of the European Enlightenment, refracted by the realities of Russian political life and the specificity of the Russian statehood, could be found in the constitutional projects of the 18th to the 19th century. The next step of the constitutional development of Russia was the adoption of the “Framework Laws” in 1906. These laws could be considered as acts close to a Constitution. The revolution of 1917 commenced a new era in a centuries-old Russia. In 1918, a completely new act created in accordance with all standards for the document of this type – the Constitution of the Russian Soviet Federative Socialist Republic appeared. Due to the unformedness of the mechanisms of the realization and the one-party system, many provisions of which responded to the highest democratic standards, in practice were not fully enforced. In 1991, a new state appeared on the map of the world – the Russian Federation. On December 12, 1993, the first Constitution of the Russian Federation was adopted. It was based on completely different principles and paths for the future gradual social development

of Russia without those shocks, which happened in its history more than once.

Multimedia Exhibitions

Multimedia expositions-presentations are created on the basis of digital content only. Some of them are made to accompany the events, held in the Presidential Library, such as scientific conferences, working sessions, etc. Others are assigned to provide information support of external events. In 2013, multimedia exhibitions “The Russian Pavilions at the World Exhibitions”, “Saint Petersburg and Russian Avant-Garde Art”, “Russia in the Foreign Trade” were demonstrated at the G20 press center during the running of the summit.

Joint Exhibition Projects



“Buryatia – Territory of Peace and Conciliation”. May 15–22, 2013.

The joint exhibition of the Presidential Library and cultural institutions of the Republic of Buryatia, dedicated on the 90th anniversary of the republic, displayed books, archival documents, manuscripts, cult decorative and applied art items, film and photo materials, which belonged to the National Library, the National Museum and the State Archive of the Republic of Buryatia, to the Saint Petersburg pagoda “Datsan Gunzechoinei”, and to private collectors.



“Caucasian-Mountain Squadron of His Imperial Majesty's Own Convoy (1828–1881)” – a Thematic Unit of the Presidential Library at the Exhibition “The Circassians: from the Caucasus to the World” (The Ethnographic Museum of Hamburg, Germany). November 23, 2013 – May, 2014.

At the exhibition, dedicated to the culture, history, and contemporary life of the Circassian people (the Adyghe), the Presidential Library told the visitors about the Caucasian-Mountain squadron, which consisted of the representatives of mountain aristocrats, and about the huge role it played as a transmitter of peaceful ideas among the Caucasian people.

Educational Projects

Video Lecture “Knowledge about Russia”

In 2013, in the framework of the video lecture “Knowledge about Russia” lectures mostly on historical and legal topics were delivered, however, part of the lectures were devoted to the problems of the Russian language, as well as to some cultural and art issues, adjoining to the governmental topic. In comparison to 2012, the number of lecturers, delivering with the help of video conference technologies, increased by one third (from 14 to 21), the number of remote auditoriums increased four times (from 6 to 25), the number of organizations, the representatives of which were directly presented at the lectures increased two times (from 9 to 17). For the first time the Library invited foreign lecturers: the employees of the Sevastopol institutions participated in the video lecture, conducted to commemorate the 160th anniversary of the Battle of Sinop, via the video conference. Moreover, also for the first time, the Library run the video lecture – “The Russian Language as the Official Language of the Russian Federation”, which was initiated by the partner organization – the Tolstoy State Pedagogical University of Tula. Among all of the conducted video lecturers the most representative one became the lecture, dedicated to the 20th anniversary of the Constitution of the Russian Federation: the audience in Saint Petersburg was represented by students and professors of six major educational centers of the city, including the Saint Petersburg State University, the FINEC, the Pushkin Leningrad State University. Eight universities and legal academies of Russia joined the event via video conference. The lecturers were the leading specialists in the sphere of constitutional law: Ph. D. in law, professor, honored lawyer of the Russian Federation, honored scientists of the Russian Federation S. A. Avakyan and Ph. D. in law, professor, honored lawyer of the Russian

Federation, honored scientist of the Russian Federation, judge of the Constitutional Court N. S. Bondar. All of the lectures were broadcasted on the multimedia website of the Library, and the recordings of them, after the relevant technical processing, were added to the holdings of the institution.

Presidential Library Film Club

In order to achieve the goal of formation the complex electronic holdings, the Library pays much attention to audiovisual materials, primarily to newsreels and documentaries as the most important sources of information about the Russian statehood. The Presidential Library film club is created to attract attention to non-fictional films and to be the site for discussion of films and events, dedicated to these films. One of the areas of work of the film club in 2013 became the demonstration of films of prominent directors of documentaries: A. Sokurov, N. Obukhovich, S. Debizhev, Zh. Romanova, and many others. The directors, who took part in discussions, presented part of the films. In the frameworks of the film club the Library ran the meeting with V. I. Kuzin, who had been the head of the Saint Petersburg documentary studio for 25 years.

Another area of work of the film club activity is the presentation of the films,

commemorating memorable dates in the history of Russia. On the 69th anniversary of the complete raising of the Leningrad siege the Library demonstrated the film of S. Loznitsa "Siege", on the 300th anniversary of Saint Alexander Nevsky Lavra – the film of A. Alekseev "Saint Alexander Nevsky Lavra – 300 Years: Past and Present"; the Library also conducted the demonstration of the film of T. Dyakonova "Soviet Union. Last Chapter", created on the 20th anniversary of the collapse of the USSR. One of the summer meetings of the Presidential Library film club was devoted to multimedia works of young directors. All in all, 11 meetings were held in 2013, they attracted over 600 participants.

Student Olympiad "Russia in the Electronic World"

In 2013, the Library conducted the third student Olympiad, the participants of which challenged in history of Russia and in social studies. 340 students went into the second round of the history competition, 412 students – of the social studies competition, 151 and 206 students competed in the third round of the history and the social studies competition correspondingly. Subsequent to the results of the on-site third round held in Saint Petersburg in Tyumen the organizers chose 18 champions and prizewinners of the history competition and 27 ones of the social studies competition. One of the champions was D. V. Bogdan, a citizen of Belarus, a student from Minsk. The fourth student Olympiad began in autumn of 2013, the participants challenged in history, social studies and Russian. Citizens of 82 regions of Russia wanted to participate in the first round of the competition. The Tyumen region became the leader in the number of participants. 72 regions went into the second round of the student contest: 221 students challenged in history, 286 students – in social studies, and 253 students in Russian.

The student Olympiad held by the Presidential Library is accessible via Internet for the senior students of Russia and the former Soviet Union. In 2013, the Library presented a special version of the multimedia website for those students who prefer mobile gadgets – <http://olympiada.prlib.ru/mobile>. The opportunity to perform the tasks using the resources of the Library provides the incentive for young users to address to the electronic holdings of the Library.

The Presidential Library holds the student Olympiad in close collaboration with schools,

as well as through its regional branches, with universities, primarily with those, the administration of which are the members of the Academic Board, and with the institutions, providing training seminars for teachers.

Photo Contest

The Library conducted the reception of works for the IV Annual International Photo Contest "Foreign View" from June 18 to October 10, 2013. The observers could be aware of the latest news of the contest with the help of the information posted on the following site: <http://foreignview.prlib.ru/>. At the day of the beginning of the contest A. O. Filaretov, a photographer and an artist, a professor of the department of cinema and photo art of the Saint Petersburg State University of Culture and Arts, ran a master class on the representative photography. Moreover, the Library held the round-table meeting, in which professional photographers of Saint Petersburg participated. 647 contestants took part in the contest, they sent approximately 4 thousand photos. All of the photo works were divided into eight nominations. The photos of professional photographers were distinguished into a separate nomination for the first time. This year the special nomination, which became a tradition, was called "Holland through the Eyes of Russians". This nomination uncovers the relations between Russia and a foreign state. This year nomination was dedicated to the year of the Netherlands in Russia. 300 works were demonstrated in this nomination. Jennes de Mol, Consul General of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, took part in the closing ceremony of the "Foreign View" photo contest.

Virtual Museum of Constitution of the Russian Federation

In 2013, the Russian Historical Society, the Academic RAS-MSU center, and the Presidential Library began the realization of the "Virtual Museum of Constitution of the Russian Federation" internet project. Part of the materials, needed for the museum, were provided by the Presidential Library, which also offered methodological assistance and technical support for the site. The project is meant to form and develop the complex resource of the history of creation, adoption and functioning of the current Constitution of the Russian Federation.

Publishing Projects



Collections of the Presidential Library. Series "Digital Library". Issue 4. Scientific, Organizational and Technological Fundamentals of Digital Information Resources Integration.

The collection includes articles dedicated to scientific, organizational and technological issues of formation of integrated information resources in libraries of different types and departmental subordination. Much attention was paid to the opportunities of the usage of semantic technologies for providing open data of library indexes, to the peculiarities of digital content organization in educational institutions, as well as to range of digital projects in Russia and the Commonwealth of Independent States. The issue is designated for the specialists of cultural institutions – librarians, museum employees, students, post-graduates, and professors of profile educational institutions, as well as to those who are interested in issues of electronic libraries.



Collections of the Presidential Library. Series "Electronic Legislation". Issue 3. Receiving, Storage, and Use of Information in the Electronic Environment: Public and Private Legal Regulation.

The collection covers the materials of the International research-to-practice conference "Receiving, Storage, and Use of Information in the Electronic Environment: Public and Private Legal Regulation", held in the Presidential Library April 11–12, 2013. The issue is dedicated to the topics of theoretical and practical problems of information legislation, including the access to the activities of governmental bodies, legal information, and law

regulations of the libraries, and connected with these regulations intellectual rights.



Collections of the Presidential Library. 1612 and 1812 as the Key Stages of Forming the National Historical Consciousness: Collection of Research Papers of the All-Russian Round-Table Meeting, November 21, 2012.

The collection includes the materials of the All-Russian round-table meeting "1612 and 1812 as the Key Stages of Forming the National Historical Consciousness", held November 21, 2012, by the Presidential Library and the department of the history of culture of Russia and Western Europe of the Saint Petersburg State University. The book is addressed to specialists in history of culture and art, philologists, sociologists, students of the department of humanities and to those, who are interested in the problems of national history and culture.



Principles and Approaches to Combination of Representation and Providing Access to Bibliographic, Archival, and Museum Resources: Collection of Scientific and Methodological Materials of the Working Group of the Presidential Library.

This issue is the collection of scientific and methodological materials, prepared by the members of the interdepartmental working group of the Presidential Library aimed at the distinction of principles and approaches to the combination of representation and providing access to bibliographic, archived, and museum resources

in accordance with modern international standards. This collection covers the documents created in 2010–2012. These documents include schemes, articles, presentations, and methodological recommendations of providing archival materials in the RUSMARC format, recommendations of display demonstrations of archival materials and of formations of access points in the Library integrated electronic catalogues. The book is addressed to specialists in librarian and archival work, as well as to developers of software for maintenance of libraries and archives.



“Foreign View”: Language in a Changing World. Photo Album. The album is released in accordance with the results of the IV Annual

International photo contest. The album includes photo works of the winners and the participants of the contest, held under the motto “Language in a Changing World”. The “Archive” direction represents photo materials of the winners of the two previous photo contests.



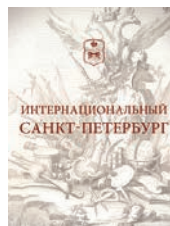
Annual Report – 2012. The report represents all the activities of the Presidential Library in 2012: the activities in the fields of information resources and technologies, services, scientific, cultural and educational, publishing,

organizational work, international relations, partners, cooperation with Russian and foreign libraries, archives and museums, the information about exhibitions, projects and events, conducted in 2012. The issue is published in two languages – in Russian and in English – and is designated to a wide range of Russian and foreign readers, who are interested in the activities of the Presidential Library.



The House of Romanov. 400 Years. Vol. 1: Printed Music from the Holding of the National Library of Russia. Vol. 2: Facsimile of Rare Printed Music from the Holdings of the National Library of Russia (Joined Project of the

Presidential Library and the National Library of Russia). The album-catalogue prepared by the National Library of Russia is a part of its holdings of printed music, connected to the House of Romanov. The two-volume collection includes the information about the printed music, composed by the members of the royal family, the compositions of Russian and foreign composers on the texts of Ekaterina the Great, grand duke Konstantin Konstantinovich, the musical compositions, devoted to the members of the House of Romanov and their historical deeds. The collection has the copies of illustrated front pages and bindings, gift books of rich designs. The second volume of the album-catalogue consists of facsimiles of rare and antique printed music, including the issues of the printed music composed by the members of the royal family.



Catalogue of “International Saint Petersburg” Exhibition (Joined Project of the Presidential Library and the Russian State Historical Archive). In June–

August of 2013, the exhibition halls of the federal state archives held the historical and documentary exhibition, confined by the Russian State Historical Archive to the 310th birthday of Saint Petersburg. The catalogue tells the story of the creation of the Northern Capital and the influence of different cultures on this process. The illustrated edition includes exhibited unique archival materials, reflecting the formation of multiethnic and

multireligious structure of Saint Petersburg. The catalogue is built in accordance with thematic and chronological principle and consists of little known archival, book, graphic and photo materials, as well as decorative and applicable art items.



Ippolitova G. A. "Italian Chapter about the Demidovs". The illustrated scientific issue, authored by a prominent historian, archivist, the chief specialist of the Russian State Historical Archive, a member of the English society of historians-archivists, an author of a range of books about the dynasty of minor magnates and charity providers – the Demidovs. The book is designated to those, who are interested in the history of Russian nobles and philanthropists.



"Outpatient Medicine of the 21st Century". The collection of reports of the research-to-practice conference, held by the Diagnostic center of the polyclinic of the Department of Affairs of the President of the Russian Federation September 27, 2013, in Saint Petersburg.



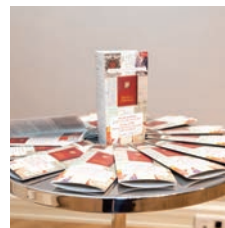

Historical Calendars. The Presidential Library calendar – the "First World War in Russian Printed Graphic Materials" – is dedicated to the jubilee celebrated in 2014. Furthermore, the Library prepared the "Russian Language" calendar. Both of the issues are decorated by illustrations of rare and valuable graphic materials. The "Presidential Library: Uniting the Past and the Future" calendar was issued on the 5th birthday of the Presidential Library.



Information Publications. Forums, conferences, seminars, exhibitions, opening of new branches of the institution, of remote reading rooms, and centers of access to the Presidential Library resources, publication of new

collections are accompanied by releases of brochures, leaflets, postcards, posters, invitations, etc. This production is designed to familiarize partners of the Library and its visitors with the activities of the institution and its collections. Annually, the Library publishes collections of postcards with the images of the halls of the Library and rare materials of its holdings.



Multimedia Projects

Films

“Chairmen of the Space”. The documentary, prepared in cooperation with the Russian Museum, is dedicated to creative quests of artists, who wanted to make the art a new engine for social progress. The film shows the ideas and works of K. Malevich, V. Kandinsky, P. Filonov, M. Larionov, P. Mansurov, and others. The film is accompanied with the comments of V. A. Gusev, the head of the Russian Museum, about the collection of avant-garde works, exhibited in the museum, about their influence on the following cultural development, as well as the position of A. P. Vershinin, the Director



General of the Presidential Library, concerning the significance of the avant-garde movement in the modern epoch. The film was demonstrated in September 2013 to the G20 summit participants.

“Daniil Granin”. The documentary from the cycle “Time to Recall” was created on the 95th birthday of D. A. Granin, a writer and a prominent public figure of Russia. The film is based on the video recording of the meeting of D. A. Granin with readers and specialists of the Presidential Library. The film covers the memories of the writer about the war and

his creative work, his thoughts about the value of time, the attitude of the society to science, about distinguished figures and real heroes of the present.

Album-catalogue “House of Romanov. 400 Years”. The film is prepared under the joint project of the National Library of Russia and the Presidential Library. The employees of the department of printed music and musical recordings of the National Library of Russia tell about the collection of printed music, connected to the dynasty of Romanov, as well as about the role of the House in development of domestic publishing and musical culture. The film includes

the fragments of the concert-presentation of the issue of the same name, which was held in the Presidential Library October 3, 2013.

Videos

“Russian Fleet at the American Shores”.

This video is dedicated to the 150th anniversary of the 1863–1864 expedition of the Russian fleet of warships to the coast of North America and includes the digital materials connected with this event. The materials belong to the



“Russian Naval Expedition to the Shores of North America” Presidential Library collection, to the holdings of the Russian State Archive of the Navy and the Central Navy Museum. S. V. Chernyavsky, the head of the Russian State Archive of the Navy, tells about the documents, reflecting several features of the preparation and the conduction of the expedition. A. P. Vershinin, the Director General of the Presidential Library, tells about the contribution of the Russian Navy in the development of international relations and protection of geopolitical interests of the country.

“Presidential Library – on the Great Victory Day”. The Presidential Library specialists and



the chief editor of the newspaper “On the Outlook of the Homeland” S. A. Martinkevich tell about the project of digitalization of editions, which started in the frameworks of preparations to the celebration of the 70th anniversary of the victory in the Great Patriotic War and the Second World War.

“Framework Law: Constitutional Court Judges about its Operation and Significance”.

On the jubilee of the Russian Constitution S. P. Mavrin, the deputy chairman of the Constitutional Court of the Russian Federation, and S. M. Kazantsev and A. N. Kokotov, the judges of the Constitutional Court, share their thoughts about the framework law of the country.

Video Excursions

In 2013, the Presidential Library prepared several video excursions based on its expositions, which are the following: “The Siege: Chronicle of Life”, “For the Sake of the Whole Country..”, “To Spread Sound and Patriotic Thoughts”. The video excursion “From the USSR to New Russia” was based on the exposition of the same name, which was run in the National Library of Russia on the jubilee of V. V. Putin. The film “Books from the Libraries of the House of Romanov in the Holdings of the National Library of Russia”, prepared in cooperation with the Book Museum of the National Library of Russia, shows the cultural background, determining the life and the activities of the ruling dynasty. Another video excursion – “Tula Arms of the Epoch of the House of Romanov” – was prepared to commemorate the jubilee of the House of Romanov, the 100th anniversary of the beginning of the First World War, and the 140th birthday of the Tula State Arms Museum, it reflects the contribution of the royal family in the development of the domestic defense complex and shows the collection of the Tsars’ guns. The Library in liaison with the Pushkin Apartment Museum made the video excursion

authors’ cycles of lectures in the format of video excursions: “The Russian Icon in the Collection of the Novgorod Museum-Reserve” (lector: leading research worker of the museum Y. B. Komarova); “The Golden Storeroom” (lector: chief museum curator N. V. Gormina), and “The Saved Frescos of the Church of the Assumption on Volotovo Field” (lector: head of Novgorod scientific restoration workshop “Fresco” T. I. Anisimova). The Library finished its work on the creation of a video recording of lectures on the 140th birthday of a distinguished Russian composer “Where S. V. Rachmaninoff Was Born”. The lectures were delivered in the National Library of Russia by V. V. Demidov, a professor at the Novgorod College of arts named after S. V. Rachmaninoff and a member of the London Rachmaninoff Society.

In the reporting year, the Library for the first time prepared a video lesson, subsequent to the results of the conducted lesson of the Constitution, in two versions (for posting on the multimedia website and for distribution on CD) and pioneered a genre of video reports

Video Recordings of Lectures, Lessons, and Performances

Subsequent to the results of the 2013 “Knowledge about Russia” video lectures the Library prepared video recordings of lectures, dedicated to the 400th anniversary of the House of Romanov, the 450th anniversary of the creation of the Book of Royal Degrees, 900 years from the beginning of the Vladimir Monomakh reign, 150th anniversary of the University charter, the 160th anniversary of the Battle of Sinop. Under the collaboration with the Novgorod State United Museum-Reserve the Library issued three

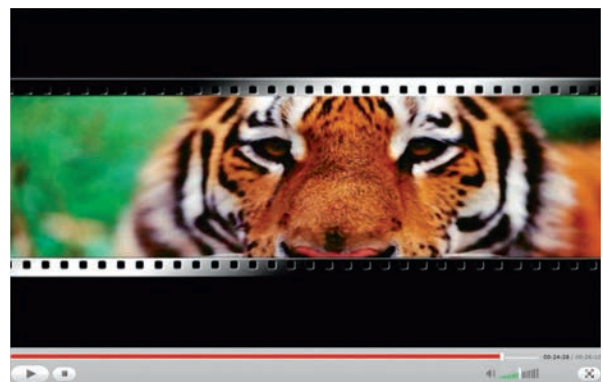
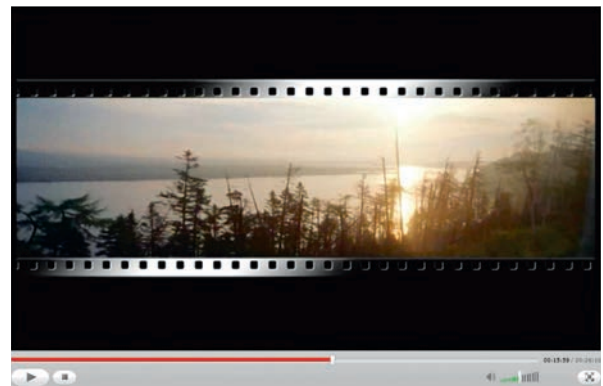
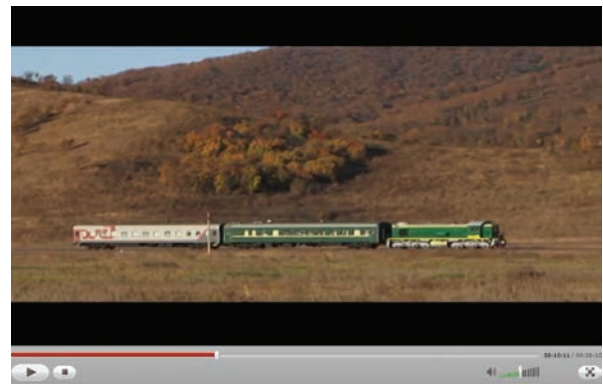
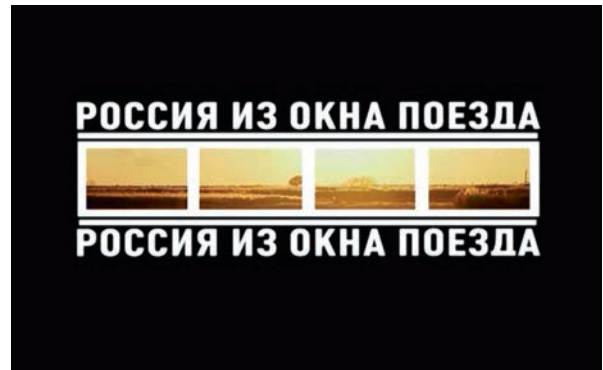


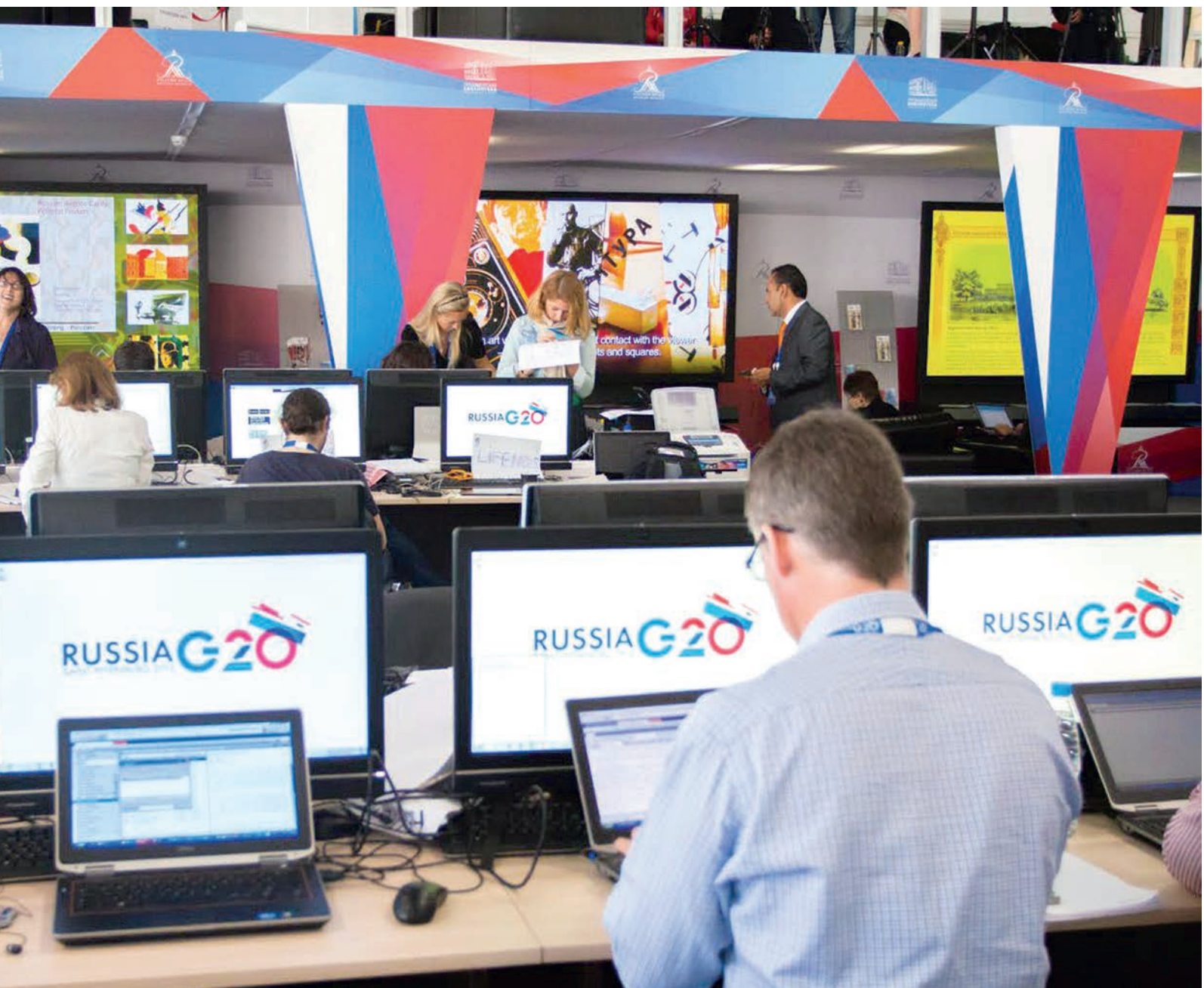

Furthermore, in 2013, eight video addresses of the Director General of the Presidential Library and four speeches of state officials, made on the occasion of the jubilee of the Constitution, were recorded for demonstration at different events.

After the events conducted at the premises of the Presidential Library video reports and recordings of speeches were prepared for posting on the multimedia website of the institution, including 13 video recordings of the conference “Right for Access to Information: Opportunities and Restrictions in Digital Environment” and the complete recording of the First Senate Readings for young lawyers.

Information Materials

In 2013, much attention was paid to the materials of advertisement and information nature, covering the activities of the library. The Library prepared three presentations about the institution and its projects, three information videos about the activities of the branch in the Tyumen region, two promo videos for the support of the “Foreign View” photo contest, one multimedia presentation of printed products of the Library for presentation at the Book Salon, four multimedia presentations of the Library collections (“Emancipation Reform of 1861”, “The House of Romanov. 400th Anniversary of the Zemsky Sobor of 1613”, “Developing of the Arctic and Discovery of the Northern Sea Route”, “Overcoming of the Time of Troubles in Russia”), which were demonstrated in high-speed trains of Russian Railways, as well as a multimedia New Year greeting card with the images of graphic materials from the holdings of the Library.

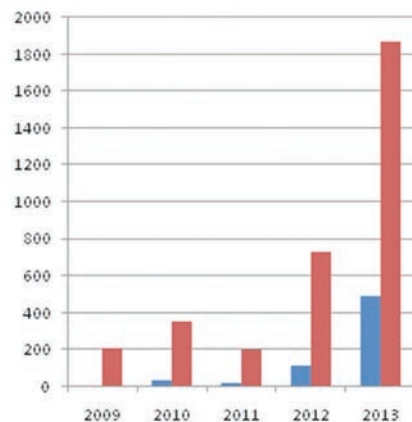

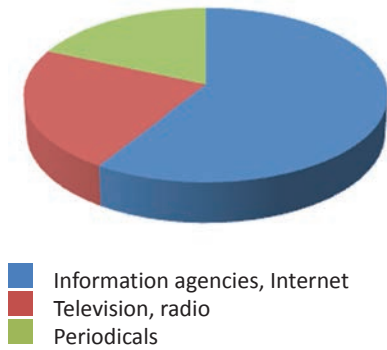
