**Dear colleagues, partners,
and friends!**

World trends and challenges of the environment necessitate changes. Nine years after the date of the establishment of the Presidential Library, it may safely be said that globalization has become an integral part of activities of the FSBI “Boris Yeltsin Presidential Library”.

In 2018, the Presidential Library worked in a number of directions. Formation of information resources and user service are a traditional and core directions. Within its framework, electronic holdings of the Presidential Library were supplemented on a basis of partnership with libraries, archives, higher education establishments, scientific foundations, historical and architectural museum-reserves, and other institutions and organizations. During the reporting year, formation of the holdings was performed mainly due to digitization of archive materials in connection with celebration of the 100th anniversary of the Archive Service of the Russian Federation. While digitizing materials of Russian archives, the Presidential Library not only increases the capacity of the documents survival for next generations, but also promotes them

through its basic gatherings and collections, making them readily available for all categories of readers.

As a tradition, the Presidential Library provides its registered readers with access to its resources on a direct basis – at the electronic reading room of the Library itself, through the network of regional centers and remote reading rooms, as well as on a remote basis – on the website. In 2008, more than 195,000 requests to the electronic reading room resources were recorded. The Presidential Library’s staff regularly conducts consulting seminars on the composition of the digital holdings, the order of access to it, and the fundamentals of working in an electronic reading room.

Today, the Presidential Library is not only a nationwide repository of digital documents, electronic fund that promotes the formation of a single space of knowledge on history, theory, and practice of the Russian statehood and the Russian language as an official language of the Russian Federation, but also a federal institution carrying out research, scientific-methodic, cultural and awareness-raising activity, as well as a platform for holding significant events in the scale of not only St. Petersburg, but also of the Russian Federation as a whole.

In 2018, excursions conducted by the Library were visited by more 11,000 people. These include various groups of visitors – from tourists and junior school pupils to journalists, bloggers, and researchers.

Among the important directions of the Presidential Library’s activity, it is worth underlying the development of its external relations. In 2018, 210 centers for remote access to the institution’s resources were created in libraries, 113 – in educational institutions, and 15 – in other organizations. Regional centers and remote reading rooms housed a large number of significant cultural and awareness-raising, educational, methodic and scientific-methodic events that received elicited response, including in social networks, where the Presidential Library was mentioned nearly 12,000 times. The Library’s projects in 2018 were widely covered by Russian and foreign mass media.

Indeed, all achievements of the Presidential Library were made possible by such direction as information and technology activity. Employees and partners support and develop the IT-infrastructure of the Library. The data processing center established in the Presidential Library is used not only to support operation of the Presidential Library’s information systems,

but also is a software and hardware base for processing and placement of backup copies of the digital content of regional libraries-participants of the National Digital Library project.

In 2018, as before, specialists of the scanning department of the Presidential Library performed digitization of various formats from a variety of source media, including rare documents, on sites of the Russian State Historical Archive, the Russian Geographical Society, the M. Gorky Scientific Library of the St. Petersburg State University, the Library of the Russian Academy of Science (LAS), the Department of Navigation and Oceanography of the Ministry of Defense of the Russian Federation, the Leningrad Region State Archive in the town of Vyborg, and other organizations.

The Presidential Library is justifiably proud of its multimedia technological complex, which ensures the creation of various content: films, thematic video clips, and presentations.

Scientific and educational activity has a high position in the structure of the Presidential Library's work. It is coordinated by the Academic Board, which includes 35 leading Russian institutions of science, culture, and education. It is pleasant to note that the Academic Board was supplemented by six new members in 2018. When talking about the scientific and methodical direction, achievements in relevant library activity are worth noting. The employees carried out developing in the sphere of formation of digital collections, prepared for publication methodic recommendations on cataloguing and indexing photo documents. Special attention was paid to development of methods for describing handwritten music documents, sports posters, digital and multimedia exhibitions. In 2018, specialists of the Presidential Library took part in creation of national standards in the field of information and library activity, translated into Russian and published the description of the Metadata Encoding and Transmission Standard (METS). Information about the Presidential Library's activity in the field is available on the website of the Library of Congress of the USA.

Results of scientific, methodic, and awareness-raising activity of the Presidential Library's employees were presented at various forums and research-to-practice conferences.

Arrangement and holding events is one of the essential activities of the institution. 2018 was a record year in terms of the number of realized exhibition projects of various types,

including the creation of virtual tours both in the Presidential Library and in other libraries, museums, and individual expositions.

Collection, analysis, moderation, and systematization of opinions and suggestions of Russian and foreign citizens on topical issues of social life, political events, social and economic problems, consolidation of the information became one of primary information and analytic activities of the Presidential Library in 2018.

Activity of the publishing and printing complex should be specially noted. The modern technological base being at the disposal of the production division allows for publishing a variety of high-grade printing products. Employees of the editorial department prepare for publication collections of research articles introducing new archival materials into a wide scientific and public circulation, highlighting current problems of modern humanities, the functioning of libraries in the electronic space.

In 2018, the Presidential Library continued its work as a member of the field-specific international organizations: the Conference of Directors of National Libraries of the World (CDNL), the Conference of European National Librarians (CENL), the International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions (IFLA).

You are holding in your hands the ninth report on the Presidential Library's activity. In 2019, the institution is to celebrate its 10th anniversary. I want to thank all our partners for their cooperation and hope for its mutually beneficial continuation. And, of course, a special thanks to all the staff of the Presidential Library.

INTRODUCTION

In 2018, the Presidential Library, while continuing to conduct its activity under the strategy of development and the statutory goals assigned, as well as the tasks set by the Department of Affairs of the President of the Russian Federation, achieved substantial success in terms of various parameters, this way laying the ground for reaching new, higher indicators of development and performance criteria. Main results achieved by the institution in 2018 in all its activities have been disclosed in the annual report. It consists of sections describing achievements of the FSBI “Boris Yeltsin Presidential Library” in the field of formation of information resources, work with users, creation of a regional network, information technologies, scientific and educational, exhibition and publishing and printing activity, organization and holding of events, international cooperation, and public relations. The appendices present additional information that chronologically reveals the activities

of the Presidential Library and reflects its main relations in the external environment.

Information about selection, digitization of materials from various sources, the process and the results of formation of the electronic holdings of the Presidential Library is comprehensively reflected in the publication. Special attention is paid to principal characteristics and results of work with materials of thematic collections, which are traditionally formed in four essential directions: Russian People, Territory of Russia, Russian Language, and State Authority. Moreover, the Presidential Library’s specialists create a large number of thematic digital collections dedicated to commemorative dates in history of Russia, historical figures or modern public characters, as well as to significant moments of the modern stage of our country development. A professional team of historians, sociologists, culture experts, linguists, and, especially, librarians work on making the collections.

Certain sections of the annual report for 2018 represent the results of works aimed at creation and obtaining electronic multimedia documents, implementation of projects on making them widely available, introduction into public and (or) scientific circulation, as well as the use of the documents in holding various events, in which the Presidential Library acted as an organizer, co-organizer or a public and social platform.

A special place in the annual report is traditionally given to description and assessment of the results of information and technological activity, as well as to the development of information systems and modernization of software and hardware complexes. It is necessary to note, that the IT-infrastructure of the Presidential Library is a basis for its activity. A top-ranked team of engineers, technologists, programmers, technicians, and other specialists works on maintenance and development of this basis. Some of the engineering and hardware-software complexes are served by external organizations – partners of the Presidential Library.

Considerable attention was paid in 2018 to the issues of operation of a branching network for access to the Presidential Library’s resources in Russia and abroad, establishment of remote electronic reading rooms and servicing users in the stationary electronic reading room. Structural subdivisions responsible for external relations of the Library not only

promote the electronic holdings, but also organize a variety of events in regions of the Russian Federation and in foreign states.

Scientific and awareness-raising activity is of tremendous value for the Presidential Library. Within these areas, methodical and methodological works are created, the topics of video lectures, excursions, and multimedia lessons are expanding. More and more schoolchildren take part in the Presidential Library's Olympiad "Russia in the Electronic World" in St. Petersburg and regions of the Russian Federation via centers for remote access and with the assistance of partner organizations.

The multimedia complex of the Presidential Library works at a steady pace: films and video clips are being shot and edited, articles about the activities of the Library and its staff are being published in the press. The contest "Foreign View" is picking up momentum, new participants are joining the photo contest "Caucasus.doc", and new media projects are being launched.

The section dedicated to the expository activity of the Presidential Library describes the high results achieved by the exhibition department specialists in 2018. Throughout the year, more than 30 exhibition projects were implemented, including 6 temporary exhibitions, 12 digital and 2 tablet exhibitions prepared, 7 virtual tours created for temporary exhibitions of the Presidential Library, as well as 4 tours through museum expositions.

Talking of the results of 2018, one of the top-performing subdivisions of the institution – the publishing and printing complex – should not go unspoken. Publications released by the Presidential Library are annually presented at international exhibitions, provided as gifts at events dedicated to various spheres of science and social activity. A highly professional team of employees of the publishing and printing complex of the Presidential Library is capable of implementation of the most diverse projects – from business cards and pocket calendars to full-scale gift-books, scientific works, and illustrated encyclopedias.

The Presidential Library's charter provides holding scientific, research-to-practice, cultural and awareness-raising and educational events (conferences, seminars, forums), including with participation of top public officials. As of today, it is one of the key activities of the institution. In addition to the traditional Day of Arctic, Day of Cadet, and Cosmonautics Day, the Presidential Library housed the meetings of the Supreme

Eurasian Economic Council, the Mixed Russian-Austrian Commission for Trade and Economic Development, the meeting of the President of the Russian Federation V. V. Putin with the winner of the competition "Teacher of the Year", the meeting of the Holy Synod of the Russian Orthodox Church chaired by His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia. Holding the General Assembly of the International Automobile Association, which united representatives of more than 190 countries of the world, is worth special noting. In 2018, the Presidential Library also hosted the St. Petersburg International Educational Forum, the International Financial Congress, the St. Petersburg International Cultural Forum, and a number of other events of all-Russian and international scale joined by thousands of guests and participants and widely covered by the press, and became the standard-bearer in the use of advanced technologies in holding events.

The Presidential Library is to continue the formation of a digital space of knowledge oriented towards the widest possible audience to master it.

Developing Electronic Holdings

In 2018, electronic holdings of the Presidential Library were supplemented on the basis of partnership relations with 112 institutions, including 37 libraries, 7 archives, universities, scientific foundations, historical and architectural reserve museums. During the reporting year, developing the electronic holdings was mainly aimed at digitization of archive materials in connection with the celebration of the 100th anniversary of the Archive Service of the Russian Federation. While digitizing Russian archives, the Presidential Library not only preserves documents, but also promotes them through its basic gatherings and collections making them more accessible both for ordinary readers and researchers.

Within the framework of cooperation with the Russian State Historical Archive (RSHA), more than 18 holdings were digitized in 2018, including 8 holdings of private origin. 9 holdings of the State Archive of the Russian Federation (SA RF), including 2 private ones, were digitized as well.

The basic collection “State Authority”, as well as a number of regional collections, were supplemented due to the holdings of the SA RF digitized in 2018: Council of People’s Commissars of the RSFSR – Council of Ministers of the RSFSR; Central Executive Committee of the USSR and Subordinate Authorities; Council of Ministers of the USSR. The digitized holding of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Russian Government in Omsk is of special value, as it illustrates the operation of alternative authorities in the territory of Russia against the background of the Civil War. Materials of the holding were used in formation of the collection “1918” dedicated to history of the Civil War.



➤ Materials from the digital collection “1918”

The collection “Russian People” and regional collections included materials on scientific institutions, secondary and higher education establishments from the holdings of the Department of Public Education (1800–1917) of the RSHA digitized throughout many years. The materials disclose the activity of the St. Petersburg Technological Institute, the Moscow Lazarev Institute of Oriental Languages, and others.

Digitization of private holdings of chairmen of the governments, ministers of internal affairs, justice, public education, and others continued. In 2018, materials on the life and deeds of the Minister of Internal Affairs S. S. Lansky (1787–1862), the ministers of justice D. N. Zamyatnin (1805–1881) and N. V. Muravyov (1811–1869), ministers of public education

A. S. Shishkov (1754–1841), I. D. Delyanov (1817–1897), G. E. Zenger (1853–1919) and A. N. Schwartz (1848–1915) were digitized in the RSHA. Private holdings of the first head of the Provisional Government (1917) Prince G. E. Lvov (1861–1925) and the Minister of Internal Affairs, then – the Chairman of the Russian Government in Omsk (1919–1920) V. N. Pepelyaev (1885–1920) from the collections of the SA RF were also digitized.

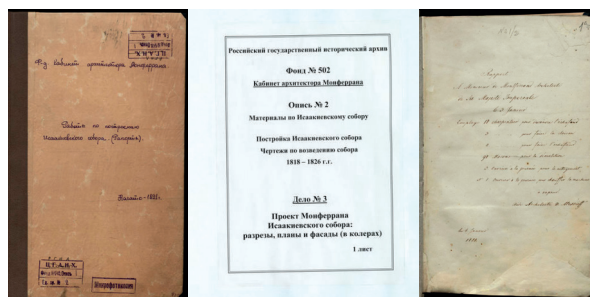
In 2018, files from the holdings of the SA RF, including materials on drafting the USSR Constitution in 1962–1978, were digitized for the “Constitution – Basic Law” collection.

For the purpose of replenishment of regional collections, materials of the holdings of the Main Administration of Allotments of the Ministry of the Imperial Court (1892–1917) of the RSHA were digitized, mainly plans of allotment estates, forest estates, labor-rent articles, villages in various specific districts, including the Petrogradskiy. These documents are destined for the collection on the Leningrad Region, just as materials of the Plan Archive – maps and plans of public and private lands and forests of the St. Petersburg Guberniya for 1774–1877.

Digitization of the holdings of the Directorate of the Imperial Theatres of the RSHA, that contain documents on history of theatre, issues of plays’ inspection by the censorial committee, staging

of performances, the drama school, construction and repairs of theatre buildings and much more, continued.

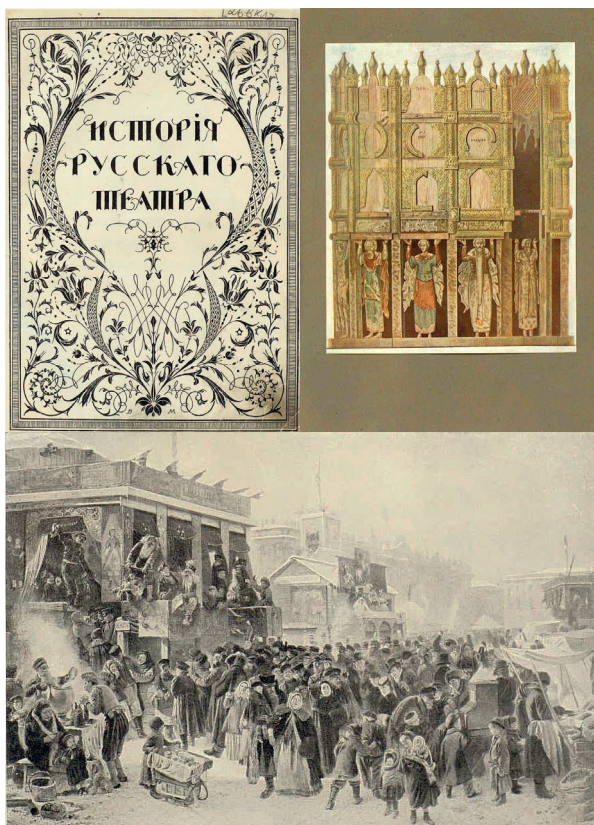
The documents collection “Cabinet of Architect Montferrand” of the RSHA deserves special mentioning. In June 2019, it will be the 200th anniversary of the laying of the foundation stone of the St. Isaac’s Cathedral. Materials of the holdings contain detailed information on its erection and may lay the grounds for creation of a separate collection of the Presidential Library.

In the reporting period, work with depository units continued, more specifically, 143 books from the Scientific Library of the SA RF were digitized, that were published in 1920–1930 in Berlin, Paris, Harbin, Tientsin, Prague, Constantinople (now – Istanbul) and Helsingfors (now – Helsinki) and reflect an expatriate view of the Revolution and the White movement. These are the memoirs of the Russians that left Russia after the 1917 Revolution. The socio-politic, historical and legal topics are also covered by 729 publications from the holdings of the Library of the Administration of the President of the Russian Federation, which were also digitized.

Special attention is paid to replenishment of audiovisual documents. In 2018, the electronic collections of the Presidential Library were supplemented with 265 new audiovisual documents, including films, newsreels, audio and video recordings, multimedia resources. The holdings also included nearly 3,500 photo documents. The general capacity of the holdings is now approximately 1,700 audiovisual documents, of which video is more than 1,000 depository units, audio is about 670. Amount of digital photo materials exceeds 11,800 depository units – these are individual photographs, collections of photographic documents, and photo albums.



Digital Collections

In the reporting year, work continued on systematization of resources and their grouping into digital collections. Thus, 33 new collections were prepared, of which 13 were dedicated to commemorative dates connected with historical figures, 14 – to historical and modern events and topics, 6 – to history of mutual relations between Russia and countries of the former Soviet Union and other foreign countries.

Total amount of documents included into the collections is more than 4,700 depository units. The principal collections of 2018 were large arrays of documents on the following topics – “The Year of Volunteers in Russia” (400 depository units), “Sport in Russia” (904 depository units), the collection dedicated to the history of the Civil War “1918”

(408 depository units). The thematic collection “Rossica” appears to be quite interesting, as it has favorable development prospects, although it amounts just a little bit more than 100 depository units.

In 2018, an academic and practical guide “Formation of Digital Collections” was prepared based on theoretical researches and practical activities of the Presidential Library. The publication summarizes the experience of creation and management of such collections, proposes the definition of digital collections, describes their functions, main principles of formation and maintenance, and their types. Special attention was paid to metadata formation. Reviews for certain collections and examples of original technological solutions of the Presidential Library are provided.



Bibliographic Processing and Indexing of Digital Resources

In order to facilitate users' access to the electronic holdings of the Presidential Library, in 2018, all the digital resources received by the Library underwent bibliographic processing in accordance with the national cataloguing regulations and standards, indexing techniques, as well as the thematic focus of each collection.

Special attention in the reporting year was paid to formation of bibliographic records and

indexing electronic resources for the main thematic collections of 2018, including, in addition to the ones that have been mentioned earlier, the collections "History of the Moscow Kremlin", "The Komsomol in the National History", "The Russian Far East – World Economic Outpost", the jubilee collection "Russian Voyages around the World in the First Half of 19th Century" confined to the 215th anniversary of the first Russian sailing round the globe, and others.

Multimedia Website

Development and enhancement of the Presidential Library's website being a primary tool of access to the digital holdings and an official page of the Library on the Internet continued in the reporting year.

The collections "Territory of Russia" (alongside with a set of regional collections) and "Russian Language" were the most coveted digital collections. The sections, that disclose the contents of the holdings in the form of informative articles and reviews, play a significant role in promotion of the website. The historical calendar "On this Day", which has been formed by the Library's specialists since 2009, attracted more than 40% of all users, who have switched to the portal from search engines.

In 2018, an access was provided on the website to the complete catalogue of the Presidential Library's electronic holdings, which contains bibliographical information amounting to more than 680,000 depository units.

The search engine of the website is used actively. Throughout the year, more than 32,000 search requests for library materials and about 4,000 for archival documents were performed. More than 1.7 million views of full texts of documents from the Library's holdings were recorded.

The Presidential Library's website is also aimed at foreign users. Thus, an English version of the website, for which more than

3,000 articles were translated, was visited by more than 300,000 users from 190 countries and state formations. In order to ensure more comfortable work for English-speaking users, an automated translation system was introduced onto the website for translation of bibliographic information about documents from the electronic holdings. Moreover, major international events are broadcasted on the website with simultaneous translation.

The Presidential Library is expanding the accessibility for visually impaired people: a special high-contrast version of the website was prepared for this category of users, where you can increase the font and adjust the comfortable display of text and control elements.

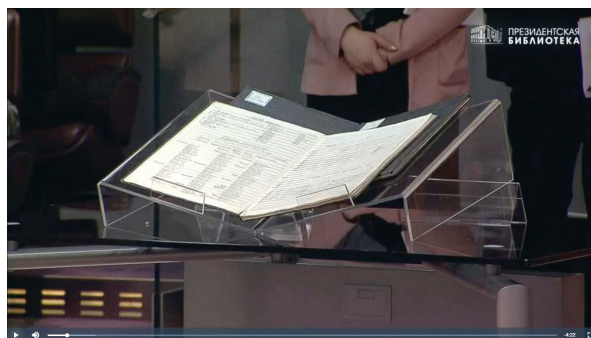
Multimedia Resources

In 2018, the Presidential Library continued the creation of multimedia products – documentaries and video tours dedicated to a variety of topics, including “Frontier Area”, “Saved Frescoes of the Christ Transfiguration Cathedral of Mirozhsky Monastery”, “Saved Frescoes of the Cathedral of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary of the Antoniev Monastery of Novgorod”, “Archive of the President of the Russian Federation”, “Painting Teacher. The History of One Journal”, “The Game Enslaving Hearts”, “Protecting Nature Means Protecting the Native Land”.

The website broadcasted daily feature and documentaries and educational programs. Throughout the year, the broadcasts were watched by 30,000 remote users of the website.

In order to cover day-to-day operations of the Library and socially important events, 9 news video clips were released: “Festival of Films about History and Art of Velikiy Novgorod”, “Prospects of Development of Children and Youth’s Mass Media Discussed at the Presidential Library”, “The Presidential Library to Digitize the Symphony No. 7 (“Leningrad”) of D. D. Shostakovich”, “Winners of the Multimedia Contest ‘Foreign View 2017’ awarded at the Presidential Library”, and others. For informational and promotional purposes, videos were also prepared that reveal the content of regularly updated digital collections “Russian People”, “Constitution – Basic Law”, “Open Space”, “Memory of the Great Victory”, etc.

Cooperation with OJSC “RZHD”, PJSC “Aeroflot”, and airports of the country continued to

promote the video materials and to disclose the Presidential Library’s holdings. During 2018, video clips and films by the Presidential Library dedicated to the history and culture of Russia were shown at airports, airplanes, and passenger trains.

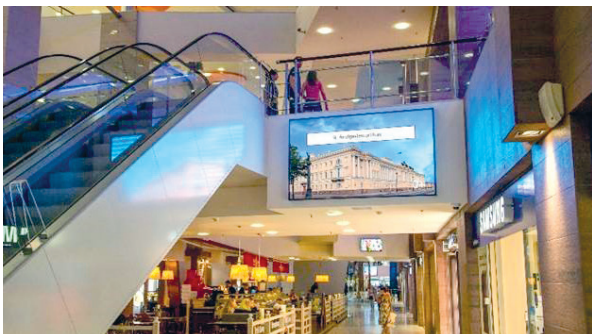

to national holidays, high-profile events and commemorative dates, are displayed in Moscow and St. Petersburg at city screens and in public transport as social advertising.

Readers in the Library

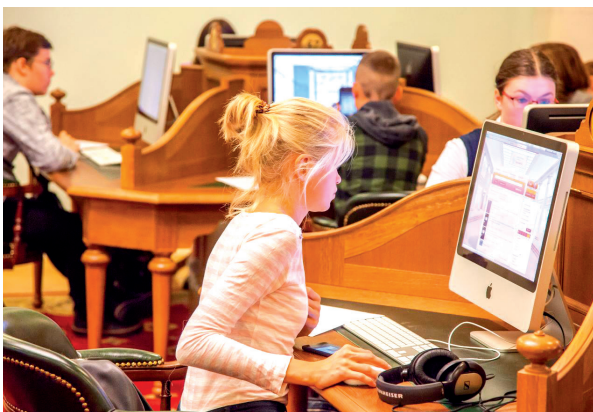
In 2018, 195,284 queries were made to the resources of the electronic reading room (ERR), which exceeds the previous year's figures by more than a third.

Within the framework of information support of readers and visitors to the Presidential Library, 400 thematic and overview-introductory presentations were prepared and held throughout the reporting year for 5,000 users with due regard to special features of target groups. Approximately 1,500 people got individually consulted on the composition of the electronic holdings and basics of working with the ERR: search capabilities, working at personal account, viewing formats, etc.

Nearly 500 responses to information requests received from users via various communication channels were prepared.

Holding interactive lessons on working with the ERR resources became a regular fixture. In 2018, 27 such lessons took place, including for young children, schoolchildren, students and tutors, as well as for participants of various events housed by the Presidential Library.

In 2018, more than 30 journalist shooting teams worked at the ERR to prepare pieces on the basis of historical materials of the electronic holdings of the Presidential Library.

Excursion Activities

In 2018, the Library was visited by 11,000 excursionists. Career-guidance excursions were held for upper-formers to get them acquainted with specialities required for operation of a modern digital library. Thus, participants of the career-guidance intermuseum-university festival “To Museum – Today, to Science – Tomorrow!” learned about research-methodical and scientific-educational work of libraries. Professionally oriented tours were also held for students studying librarianship at the St. Petersburg Institute of Culture and the St. Petersburg Technical College of Library and Information Technology.

One more important activity was the joint project with the Information Administration – Press Service of the Administration of the Governor of St. Petersburg on holding tours

for students majoring in “Advertising and Public Relations”.

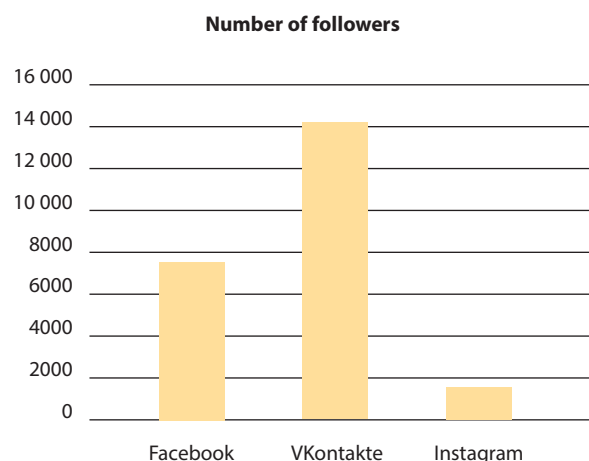
In 2018, individual visitors to the Presidential Library had the opportunity to register for excursions on the website. Through electronic registration, 27 groups (302 people) were formed.

Seminars on excursion work in exhibition halls of the Library were arranged for freelance guides. In order to attract the public at large, site tours were conducted through the historical building of the Synod, including for journalist and bloggers. In 2018, the institution was visited by heads and representatives of editorial offices of “Rossiyskaya Gazeta”, “Kirishskiy Fakel”, etc. An exclusive tour was held for the Association of St. Peterburg Bloggers through the Presidential Library in November.

Presidential Library in Social Networks

In 2018, the Presidential Library used actively the opportunities provided by social networks for its positioning, disclosing the contents of the electronic holdings and promotion of the Library’s services. The target audience got informed operatively about digital collections being formed, exhibitions being organized, cultural and awareness-raising events and latest publications on the Library’s website and social networks. As of December 2018, the number of followers of the Presidential Library’s page on the VKontakte social network was 14,160, on the social networking site Facebook – 7,361 people, and in the photo and video sharing app with elements of social network the Instagram – 1,528 people.

The Presidential Library was mentioned in social networks 11,805 times throughout the year.

Remote Access to Information Resources

In 2018, formation of a network of centers for remote access to the Presidential Library's resources continued in order to cover all the constituent territories of the Russian Federation. Access centers were created on the basis of federal and local authorities, central and leading libraries of constituent territories of the Russian Federation, universities, archives, museums, and other cultural, scientific, educational and awareness-raising organizations. Regional centers of the Presidential Library cooperated actively with municipal libraries of regions.

Abroad, access to the Presidential Library's resources was implemented through reading rooms located both at Russian Centers

of Science and Culture of the Rossotrudnichestvo, and at libraries and other organizations.

Practice of the Presidential Library's interaction with remote access centers continued in the form of information and methodology webinars, during which the participants got acquainted with the contents and structure of the Presidential Library's electronic holdings. Special attention was paid to socially important contents of the resources and opportunities of their use in organization of educational, cultural, and awareness-raising events for various categories of users. Special booklets were prepared as an additional material for the webinars.

Regional Relations

In 2018, the regional network gained its momentum due to signing cooperation agreements and opening new reading rooms in dozens of libraries, organizations, and institutions of various authorities in all the regions of Russia. The Republic of Bashkortostan, the Tyumen, Moscow and Sverdlovsk Regions took the most active part in expanding the network, including at the municipal level. The increase in number of connections in the Chelyabinsk Region is induced by the implementation of a regional project of the Chelyabinsk regional universal scientific library "The Presidential Library at the Southern Urals".

The work on methodological enhancement of the regional network activity included events held in the videoconferencing mode, more specifically meetings with regional partners of the Presidential Library.

Employees of the Tyumen Branch of the Presidential Library took part in the exhibition "INFOTECH 2018" carried out as a part of the XI All-Russian Forum "Electronic Government as a Modern Regional Management Mechanism" in Tyumen. The joint stand of the Presidential

Library and the Zavodoukovskiy Town District presented information on the resources, capacities and activity of the Presidential Library and its Tyumen Branch, access to the website and electronic reading room was provided.

Centers for remote access to the Presidential Library's resources were opened via videoconferencing at four schools of the Tyumen Region.

In the reporting year, the Presidential Library, together with the M. Gorky Volgograd Regional Universal Scientific Library and the Samara Regional Universal Scientific Library held a scientific and practical videoconference "Match on Ruins", dedicated to the 75th anniversary of the defeat of the German fascist invaders in the Battle of Stalingrad by the Soviet troops. 8 regions of Russia joined the event in the videoconferencing mode, and over 30 regions watched the broadcasting on the Presidential Library website.

In Crimea, the I All-Russian Research and Practice Conference "Problems of Preservation of Historical Memory in the Digital Environment" was held, organized by the Presidential Library

with the assistance of the public foundation “Palaces of Crimea – Palaces of St. Petersburg”, the Presidential Grants Foundation and the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Crimea. The event was carried out as a part of the Music-Educational Interregional Project “Palaces of Crimea – Palaces of St. Petersburg”.

In 2018, the interregional project “A Wooden Fairy Tale of Russia: from the Irtysh to the Ob” initiated by employees of the Pushkin Tomsk Regional Library in partnership with colleagues from the Kemerovo, Omsk, Novosibirsk, Tyumen Regions, and the Altai Territory with the support of the Presidential Library, was presented. The purpose of the project is to promote the information about the wooden architectural heritage of Russia and to create an interregional information and educational Internet resource.

Throughout the year, 25 research and methodical webinars took place, that were joined by nearly 9,000 specialists and attendees from more than 1,200 organizations representing all regions of Russia and a number of foreign countries. In the reporting year, the number of participants increased 3.5 times compared with the previous year.

An interregional webinar “State and Religious Figures in the Paradigm of Historical Perception”, bringing together more than 30 virtual platforms across Russia, was held in the videoconferencing mode.

Information Technology Basis of Activities

The Presidential Library, being a multimedia multifunctional (cultural and awareness-raising, scientific-educational and information-analytical) center, bases its work on application of modern information technologies. In 2018, the institution continued technological development in order to solve the tasks of administrating the institution's activity, formation and maintenance of the library holdings, as well as the multimedia content, servicing readers and participants of events, provision of access to various types of documents, including through the network of centers for remote access to the Library's information resources.

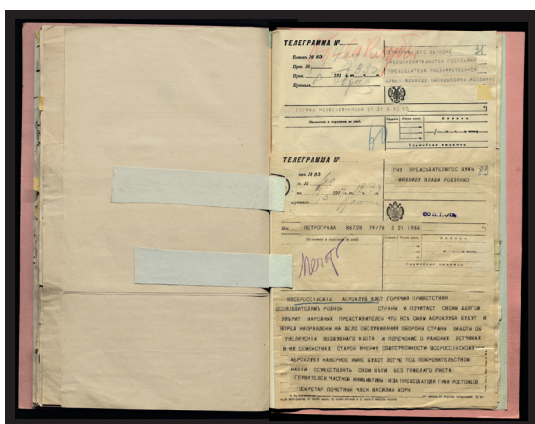
The data processing center (DPC) is used not only to support operation of the Presidential Library's information systems, but also is a software and hardware base for processing and uploading backup copies of the digital content of regional libraries-participants of the National Digital Library project (NDL) to the cloud drive powered by a modern technological platform. Data storage systems (DSS), modernized in 2018, ensure technological processes of creation of digital content, formation of the electronic holdings, processing and storing large arrays of digital data, including storage on high-density tape medium and on a cloud drive.

The digital content preparation system equipped with a range of specialized scanners ensures scanning of documents in various

formats from microfilms to large-size maps and atlases (including A1+ and A0+) obtained from a variety of source media. In 2018, mobile scanning kits continued to be used to implement digitization of rare documents at the site of the Russian Geographical Society (RGS), the State Russian Museum (SRM), the Military Historical Museum of Artillery, Engineers, and Signal Corps (MHMAESC), and the M. Gorky Scientific Library of the SPSU. Implementation of a joint project with the Library of the Russian Academy of Science (LAS) continued in order to digitize unique documents of the Holy Trinity Alexander-Svirsky Monastery.

In 2018, digitization of documents from the holdings of the Department of Navigation and Oceanography of the Ministry of Defense of the Russian Federation, the Leningrad Region State Archive in the town of Vyborg, and others, was also carried out.

The modernized multimedia technological complex (MMTC) allows for generation of multimedia content, including filming, processing, and editing video materials in 4K format, as well as for storing and online transmission of video content for live broadcasts in the open and closed modes using standards of high-definition television (HD TV). The modernized videoconferencing complex ensures gathering multiple remote participants of forums, conferences, webinars, seminars, cinema clubs, and meetings in one session.

The MMTC, conference halls, and meeting halls are equipped with the system of image projection, the interactive conference system with a televoting facility, system of simultaneous interpreting, live broadcasting, wired conference-system, and dispose of wide

capabilities of the modernized complex of video conferencing. All of these ensure holding a variety of high-profile events (official meetings of top figures of states, banking, economic, legal, cultural forums, etc.).

Development of Information Systems, Modernization of Hardware-Software Complex

In the reporting year, a new data storage system Storwize V7000 was placed into operation, which allowed for complete replacement of out-of-date and obsolete previous generation DSS and increasing disk capacities.

In 2018, the tape library was significantly increased in volume with the use of new

generation cartridges LTO-7, which enables increasing the capacity of tape libraries in the principal storage and the Reserve Center by 1,400 TB (1.4 Petabyte) each. Program of introduction of Russian software for operational systems upgrading started.

Academic Board Activities

At the end of 2018, the Academic Board represented 35 leading Russian institutions of science, culture, and education: 3 federal libraries (including 2 national ones), federal museums, 5 archives, 3 scientific institutions, and 21 universities.

In the reporting year, 6 new members were included into the Academic Board. Moreover, the Regulations on Academic Board of the FSBI “Boris Yeltsin Presidential Library” no. 102 adopted on October 8, 2012, were amended. The new wording of clause 4 of the Regulations provides for the possibility of including honorary members in the Board.

In 2018, the Academic Board’s activity was focused on discussion of issues mainly connected with enhancement of regulatory framework of information and librarian work and development of the Presidential Library’s electronic holdings. Decisions of the Academic Board are recommendatory for the Presidential Library and institutions, whose heads are members of the Board.

Two meetings of the Academic Board took place in the reporting year.

The April meeting was dedicated to topical issues of systematization of legislation on formation of a single Russian space of knowledge. The Plan of the Presidential Library’s Actions related to the formation of the electronic knowledge space was adopted, and partner organizations were invited to join its implementation in forms acceptable to them. Thus, the plan is implemented with the assistance of national libraries and leading universities of Russia.

During the October meeting, issues of preservation and use of internet resources dedicated to the theory, history, and practice of the Russian statehood, the Russian language as an official language, were brought up. In addition, special attention was paid to the experience of the State Hermitage in presentation of museum collections in the digital space, as well as the experience and prospects of mobile scanning of cultural heritage objects kept in the custody of the Library of the Russian Academic of Science. Issues of interaction between the Presidential Library and educational institutions of higher professional education and the implementation of the tripartite agreement of national libraries of Russia were considered.

As a result of the Academic Board’s meetings in the reporting year, the order of transfer of digital copies of documents from the Presidential Library’s holdings to other organizations was discussed; the application of national standards for information and librarian activity was considered; the round table “Issues of Application of International Standards for Description and Transfer of Objects / Digital Collections in the Modern Digital Environment” took place, as well as the cycle of thematic work sessions: “Plan of Switch to Release of the Presidential Library’s Collections in the Form of Electronic Publications”, “Issues of Licensing of Educational Programs with the Use of Distance Technologies”, “Methods for Archiving and Use of Web-Resources”, “Access to Objects of the Presidential Library at the State Information System ‘National Digital Library’”.

Information and Research Activities

In 2018, information and research activities of the Presidential Library were aimed at work with information resources of the Government and the Prime Minister, collection, analysis, moderation, and systematization of opinions and suggestions of Russian and foreign citizens on topical issues of social life, political events, social and economic problems, summarization of the information revealed. 310 reviews and digests were prepared in total by the Library's employees.

For blogs and websites of the Government and the Prime Minister of Russia Dmitry Medvedev, the Presidential Library's employees prepared and posted photo-, video- and

text materials, moderated comments and developed analytic reports. Users were daily informed about activities of the Government of the Russian Federation via the following platforms: the official blog of Dmitry Medvedev, the blog of Dmitry Medvedev on LiveJournal, personal pages of the Prime Minister in social networks Facebook and VKontakte, the website of the Government of the Russian Federation in VKontakte, Dmitry Medvedev's Twitter account and the Twitter account of the Government of the Russian Federation (Russian and English versions), the pages of Dmitry Medvedev and the Government of the Russian Federation in Instagram.

Scientific and Methodic Activities

Scientific and methodic work of the Presidential Library is aimed at support of its primary statutory activities.

In order to establish a methodic base, developments in the field of formation of digital collections continued, methodic recommendations were prepared for cataloguing and indexing photo documents – photographs, digital copies of photographs, as well as collections (sets, albums) of such materials. Special attention was paid to development of methods for describing handwritten music documents, sports posters, digital and multimedia exhibitions.

In 2018, specialists of the Presidential Library translated into Russian and published the description of the METS – “METS: Metadata Encoding and Transmission Standard”. The publication contains translation of recent versions of documents included into the METS: “Brief Summary and User Manual”, “Welcome Guide and Quick Reference Book”, “METS Scheme” with comments in Russian. The standard was developed for encoding metadata required for processing digital objects

in storages (digital collections) and exchange of such objects.

Under the developed methods of metadata formation for digital collections, formation of bibliographic records in the RUSMARC standard started in relation to regional collections for the Presidential Library's digital catalogue.

Along with that, specialists of the Presidential Library participated in development of national standards in the sphere of information and library activity. Thus, the standard GOST P 7.0.87–2018 “SSILP. Book Monuments: General Requirements” was developed, and then came into force on January 01, 2019. In the reporting year, the Library's specialists were also included into the working groups to create two national standards – GOST “Bibliographic Resources. Terms and Definitions” and GOST “SSILP. Collection of Documents. Bibliography Cataloging. Terms and Definitions”.

Throughout the entire year, joint work with the publishing house “Russkoe Slovo” continued for preparation of digital forms of course books in “History of Russia” and “Literature”.

Forums and scientific and practical conferences were held at the Presidential Library during 2018 within the framework of scientific activity.

The annual scientific and practical conference “Cultural Heritage: Resource Integration in the Digital Environment” had issues of uniting digital resources of federal and regional levels within the scope of national projects, web-archiving as a prospective direction of preservation of electronic resources, issues of integration of contents of libraries, archives, museums for the purpose of support of science and education, implementation of cultural and awareness-raising projects, retraining of personnel for work in modern libraries, as its agenda.

Within the framework of the conference, the training seminar “Formation of Digital Collections” was held to consider issues related to selection of information resources, scanning, cataloguing, access to digital collections. The Presidential Library became a platform for participation of 96 attendees from 21 organizations, 420 views of the seminar broadcasting on the Internet were recorded as well.

The III Legal Forum of the Presidential Library took place in April. The Forum started with the round table “Unified Electronic Information and Educational Environment of the University: an Innovative Approach and Prospects for Development” held in Moscow in cooperation with the Kutafin Moscow State Law University. The round table was included into the program of the expert discussion platform of the same name, which, in turn, was an integral part of the Moscow Legal Forum, the largest in Russia. Due to the use of videoconferencing, the round table united Moscow, St. Petersburg, and Sochi. In total, about 60 specialists took part in the event at the teleconference sites in these cities.

One more joint event was the round table “Public Centers of Legal Information: A Look into the Future” dedicated to the problems of functioning of public centers of legal information. It was held in cooperation with the V. V. Mayakovskiy Library within the scope of the All-Russian Scientific and Practice Conference “The Library of the 21st Century and the Formation of the Legal Culture of the Citizens of Russia”.

At the All-Russian Scientific Conference “The Era of Great Reforms: History and Documentary Heritage (to the 200th Birth

Anniversary of Alexander II)”, more than 60 scientists from various regions of Russia gave their reports: 30 Philosophy Doctors and 28 Candidates of Science, specialists from a variety of scientific and educational organizations, cultural institutions. During the meetings, issues related to the figure of Emperor Alexander II and his milieu, aspects of foreign and domestic policy, culture and social structure were discussed. Special attention was paid to the meaning of the Great Reforms, their affect on development of the country during the second half of the 19th century. The round table “Personal Libraries of Emperors of Russia: Issues of Preservation in the Digital Environment” took place.

In advance of the conference of the Russian Library Association, a scientific and practical seminar for municipal libraries of the Vladimir Region was held with the assistance of the Director of the M. Gorky Vladimir Regional Universal Scientific Library, where the Presidential Library’s employees gave their reports. The Presidential Library presented its regional collection dedicated to the Vladimir Region during the course of the seminar.

Educational Activities

In the reporting year, the educational activities of the Presidential Library were carried out both to support Russian education and culture and to disclose the electronic holdings and to teach new users to work with information resources of the Library.

In 2018, access was arranged to a new information and educational resource “Gosudarica” destined to get schoolchildren acquainted with important materials on the theory, history, and practice of the Russian statehood and issues of the Russian language.

Events for students

The Presidential Library marked the beginning of an academic year with the Forum of Knowledge. A number of events timed to the 100th anniversary of the 1918 Constitution of the RSFSR and the 25th anniversary of the 1993 Constitution of the Russian Federation, as well as the Day of Naval Knowledge were held within the scope of the Forum.

Since 2010, the Presidential Library has hosted the annual Olympiad for schoolchildren “Russia in the Electronic World” organized by the Herzen State Pedagogical University of Russia. In 2018, the Olympiad included

tests in three subjects: Russian history, social studies, and the Russian language.

The first round of the Olympiad 2017/2018 was entered into by 6,080 schoolchildren from 79 regions of the Russian Federation and 7 foreign countries: Belorussia, Kazakhstan, Kirgizia, Moldova, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, and Ukraine. 2,220 schoolchildren tried their hand in the competition in social studies, 1,830 – in history, 1,963 – in Russian. The Tyumen Region (2,989), the Khanty-Mansijsk Autonomous District, the Tambov, Chelyabinsk, and the Novosibirsk Regions were leaders

in the number of participants. The second elimination round of the Olympiad in history was entered by 722 schoolchildren, in social studies – by 875, and in Russian – 799.

The third (on-site) round of the Olympiad was held on 13 sites located in St. Petersburg, Tyumen, Pushkino (the Moscow Region), Yekaterinburg, Rostov-on-Don, Barnaul, Khanty-Mansiysk, Kazan, Tambov, Novosibirsk, Penza, and Voronezh.

152 schoolchildren from 39 regions of Russia took part in the final round of the competition. 42 participants became the winners and awardees.

In 2018, the topic of multimedia lessons for schoolchildren expanded. Thus, two new cycles of classes were developed: “History of the Moscow Kremlin” and “Lesson of Constitution: to the 25th Anniversary of the Basic Law of Russia”. For the information support of multimedia lessons two electronic exhibitions of the same name were prepared.

“Lesson of Constitution” became the most attended lesson for students of 5–9 grades. September through December 2018, the lessons was visited by 829 schoolchildren from 39 educational institutions of St. Petersburg and the Leningrad Region.

One more project for upper-formers is an educational tour through the collection “Russian Language”. It is aimed at deepening knowledge on history of the Russian language obtained while mastering school curricula. In 2018, this educational tour was taken by 867 people from 47 educational institutions of the city and the region.

Video lectures

Another traditional project continued its development in the reporting year – the video lectures cycle “The Knowledge about Russia”. The video lectures are conducted with informational support of the Russian Historical Society (RHS). Themes of the lectures were timed to anniversaries in the Russian history: the 200th anniversary of the monument to Minin and Pozharsky on Red Square (“The Reflection of Events of the Time of Troubles in Russian Culture”), the 100th anniversary of the Archive Service of Russia (“The History of the State Archive Service of Russia”), the 100th anniversary of the higher historical education on the Far East (“University Traditions of Higher Historical

Education in St. Petersburg and on the Far East”); jubilees of outstanding public figures and distinguished writers: the 200th birth anniversary of Russian Emperor Alexander II, the 200th birth anniversary of the Russian writer I. S. Turgenev, the 150th birth anniversary of the Russian writer A. M. Gorky, the 110th birth anniversary of the Minister of Defense of the USSR Marshal D. F. Ustinov, the 100th birth anniversary of the veteran writer, honorary citizen of St. Petersburg D. A. Granin, the 80th birth anniversary of one of the founders of librarianship in Russia General Director of the Russian National Library V. N. Zaytsev, the 80th birth anniversary of the honored trainer of the Russian Federation and Vice-President of the Judo Federation A. S. Rakhlin.

Cinema Club

The Presidential Library’s cinema club is an educational and awareness-raising project, which reveals historical knowledge about Russia through screenings of non-fiction films.

The cinema club activity in 2018 was traditionally carried out in cooperation with leading non-fiction film studios, the Guild of Nonfiction Cinema and Television of Russia, regional film studios, the St. Petersburg State University of Film and Television, the Russian Institute of History of Arts, the Youth Center of St. Petersburg Union of Cinematographers, children’s multimedia studios of St. Petersburg, and other partners.

Within the scope of the project “History of the Russian Statehood through History of Its Regions”, 4 films were screened, that tell

about history and people of the Bryansk and Pskov territories, Yugra and the Kurils. The Presidential Library's cinema club also referred to historical commemorative dates of Russia. Thus, it held meetings dedicated to the 200th birth anniversary of Emperor Alexander II (1818–1881); the 105th birth anniversary and 55th death anniversary of the commander of the legendary submarine C-13 Alexander Ivanovich Marinesko; the 85th anniversary of the establishment of the Main Directorate of the Northern Sea Route. One of the meetings was joined by 5 members of the expedition, which had followed the footsteps of the Northern Convoys, who shared their memories of this unprecedented sea journey.

One of activities of the cinema club is screening films dedicated to protection of wild nature and ecology. This year, films of the founder of the "New Zoological Museum" project, author of the video blog "Two of Every Kind", Candidate of Biological Sciences, Pavel Glazkov, about the animal world of the Leningrad Region were screened.

Children's multimedia works in the reporting year were represented by the best creations of the International Children's Crafts Festival "It All Starts with Childhood" in the "Multimedia" nomination, as well as with movies by young creators, prize winners of the IX All-Russian Children's Film Festival "Cinema Island". Young cinema-makers presented their films within the framework of the XXIII International Environmental Film Festival "Green View". Moreover, in 2018, the Presidential Library housed screenings of two movies by directors from the Youth Center of St. Petersburg Union of Cinematographers.

VIRTUAL TOURS: PRESERVATION AND POPULARIZATION
OF CULTURAL AND HISTORICAL HERITAGE OF RUSSIA

Exhibition Activities

One of the essential activities of the Presidential Library is arrangement and holding of exhibitions. 2018 became the record year in terms of the number of implemented various exhibition projects.

In the reporting year, 6 temporary thematic exhibitions were prepared and displayed in exhibition halls in commemoration of significant jubilee dates in history of the Russian statehood: the 1030th anniversary of the Christianization of Rus', the 215th anniversary of the first Russian round-the-world trip by I. F. Kruzenshtern, the 100th anniversary of the relocation of the Soviet government from Petrograd to Moscow, the 75th anniversary of the Tehran conference. One of the exhibitions created in cooperation with the St. Petersburg State University was dedicated to the history of women's secular education in Russia and timed to the 140th anniversary of the Higher Women's (Bestuzhev) Courses. A special project dedicated to the global-scale sport event – the FIFA World Cup 2018 – was implemented.

Moreover, 12 digital exhibitions were prepared in the reporting year. These include several biographical ones, based on materials from family archives of our outstanding contemporaries: the sportsman, teacher, and public figure Mikhail Bobrov, the Director of the Russian National Library Vladimir Zaitsev, the writer Daniil Granin.

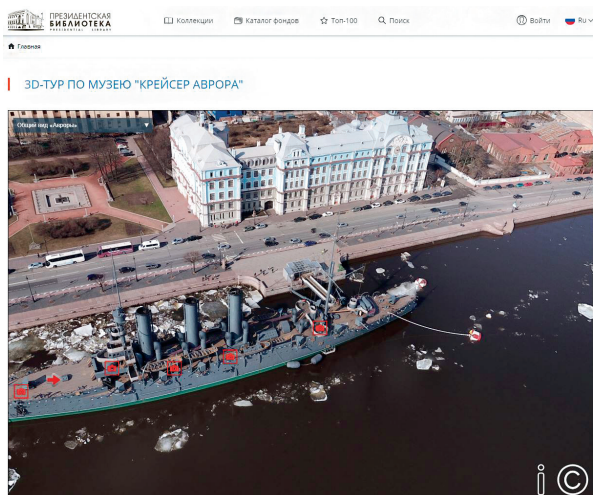
2 tablet exhibitions were prepared. One of them is dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the All-Russian Extraordinary Commission and is currently displayed at the memorial house of Julian Semenov in the settlement of Oliva (the Republic of Crimea). Its further exhibiting is planned to be implemented in other cities using the resources of the memorial house. The second one, created under the order of the Administration of the Federal Service for State Registration, Cadastre and Cartography for the Leningrad Region, discloses the history of cadastre and cartography in Russia from the most ancient time up to the present days. The materials collected upon its preparation became the basis for a limited-edition illustrated album.

Virtual Tours: Preservation and Popularization of Cultural and Historical Heritage of Russia

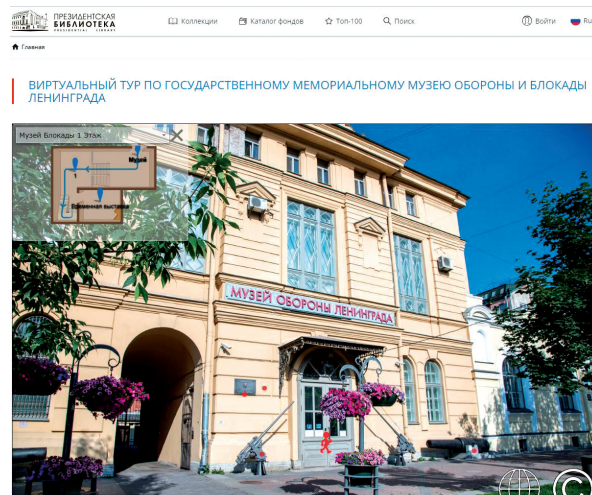
Since 2017, a new direction has developed actively at the Presidential Library – creation of virtual tours for in-house temporary exhibitions and permanent expositions of Russian museums. As of today, the format of a virtual tour is one of the most high-end means to record and represent expositions, which became available for an unlimited number of users after being posted on the Internet. The new form of virtual interconnection available on the Library's website made it possible to represent not only the interiors of the Library and its temporary exhibitions, but also exhibitions of third-party museums.

Documents from the Presidential Library's holdings, unique materials provided by partners, original exposition and design solutions used in the exhibitions, are now accessible from any place in the world on a permanent basis, as opposed to being available within a limited term of the exhibition work.

At once, there was work on creation of virtual tours both for worldwide renowned and little-known to the public museums of Russia. 4 virtual tours were prepared during the reporting period. "Kobona: the Road of Life" is a small museum located at the shore of Ladoga Lake and has an exposition dedicated to the Siege

of Leningrad. The museum was opened again after the fire and major reconstruction in 2018, and the created virtual tour makes such significant exposition accessible, which is especially important given the conditions of geographical remoteness of the museum. Another tour gives the opportunity of a virtual walk along the legendary cruiser "Aurora" – one of the best known touristic symbols of St. Petersburg. The virtual tour shows much more than is available for an ordinary visitor to the museum: for instance, in virtual space, you can see in detail the ship hospital and the church, the boiler and engine rooms.

One more tour recorded no longer existing exposition of the State Memorial Museum of the Defense and Siege of Leningrad. In 2018, the museum was closed for reconstruction immediately after the shooting finished, and now anyone is able to get acquainted with its exposition, but in electronic format. Finally, the Memorial House of Julian Semenov

in Crimea is also available in the virtual space. The 3D-tour makes it possible to take a full tour and learn interesting facts about the life and work of the famous writer, the "father" of Stirlitz.

PUBLISHING PROJECTS

Activities of Publishing and Printing Complex

In 2018, the publishing and printing complex of the Presidential Library (PPC) continued preparation of scientific collections of the institution. New installments of the publications “Digital Archive”, “Digital Library”, “Electronic Legislation” dedicated to issues of law in the electronic environment, work of digital and traditional libraries, as well as to history of our country, reflect the scientific work of the Presidential Library within its essential activities. The published articles introduce new archival documents into wide scientific and public circulation, cover topical problems of modern humanities, issues of operation of libraries in digital space. A number of the articles are based on reports of contributors at scientific conferences organized by the Presidential Library in 2017–2018.

Moreover, translation of documents included into “METS: Metadata Encoding and Transmission Standard” was performed by specialists of the Presidential Library and published in the reporting year. The publication also includes the scheme of the METS accompanied with comments in Russian. One more work of the institution’s specialists – “Formation of Digital Collections” – was also released in 2018.

In the reporting year, preparation of reference materials for webinars held for employees and users of remote electronic reading rooms started. Thus, thematic booklets “Scientific Periodicals” and “Legal Information” contributed to revealing the Presidential Library’s holdings, helped to feel confident about them, pointed up the most significant documents.

New leaflets were prepared for distribution of information about educational and awareness-raising projects of the Presidential Library in educational institutions. The booklet “Olympiad ‘Russia in the Electronic World’” is instrumental in increasing the number of participants of the all-Russian interactive educational project. The booklet “Multimedia Lessons” tells about the contents of the complex of lessons arranged by the Library. In the first place, it will be helpful for teachers, who can include the lessons into their curriculum as support and addition to

their pedagogical work in order to increase their students’ knowledge in history of the Russian statehood, constitutionalism, and the Russian language, the modern electoral system and ecology of Russia.

The new type of presentation products was the leaflet “Constitution Hall” created as an additional descriptive material for the virtual tour through the permanent

exhibition in the Presidential Library’s building. The leaflet describes principal display units, including the exact copy of the inaugural Constitution of the Russian Federation.

All exhibition activity of the Presidential Library in the reporting year was supported by release of vivid information leaflets and creation of posters.

The Presidential Library’s rich collection of electronic documents allows for publication of unique and attracting heightened attention editions. In 2018, reprints of “Table of Ranks”, “King’s Regulations”, “Novgorod the Great” by D. S. Likhachev, and others were prepared and released. They were made available at the Presidential Library’s stand at book exhibitions. Moreover, reprint editions of rare issues of the “Murzilka” journal for 1937 and 1940 were given to winners of trivia games for kids and their parents carried out at the XXXI Moscow International Book Fair and the First St. Petersburg New Year’s Book Fair.

In addition, in 2018 the PPC released presentation products for external events held at various levels, where the Library acted as a participant or provided information and analytical support. These include, particularly, the XXII St. Petersburg International Economic Forum, the 84th World Library and Information Congress of the International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions

of Knowledge, were also accompanied with a variety of print media materials.

The Presidential Library participated in the 70th Book Fair in Frankfurt “Frankfurter Buchmesse” and presented the joint project of the Presidential Library and the Carl Bulla Foundation of Historical Photography – the exhibition “Creative Heritage of Carl Bulla and His Sons”, for which a multimedia exhibition and promotional materials were prepared in Russian and German.

The Library’s cooperation with organizations and individuals was successful and efficient. Collaboration with the A. S. Popov Central Museum of Communications continued and resulted in release of a collection of articles and methodic materials of participants of the IX Scientific and Practical Seminar on History of Postal Service and Philately – “Postage Stamp and Postcard: Creators, Publishers, Collectors”.

Under the request of the oldest studio of Russian documentary “Lendoc”, a catalogue of films for 2004–2018 was published and its digital version was prepared.

Abecedaries, workbooks were published in Enets and Nganasan for schoolchildren of the Far North, as well as a Russian-Nganasan phrasebook and other teaching aids.

Cooperation with the Administration of the Federal Service for State Registration, Cadastre, and Cartography for the Leningrad Region (Rosreestr) within the framework of preparation of the electronic exhibition “From the History of Land Management and Cadastre in Russia” was a new large-scale project. Based on the materials provided by the Rosreestr, the Leningrad Region State Archive in the town of Vyborg, the Russian National Library, the Presidential Library’s staff prepared an album-catalogue dedicated to the history of land management and the modern stage of work of the Rosreestr.

Within the scope of partnership with the International Foundation “Palaces of

St. Petersburg”, at the expense of the grant of the President of the Russian Federation for civil society development provided by the Presidential Grants Foundation, presentation materials were prepared for the I All-Russian Conference “Problems of Preservation of Historical Memory in the Digital Environment” (Yalta, Crimea).

Publications of the Presidential Library were displayed throughout the year at various exhibition sites: the XIII St. Petersburg Book Fair, the XXXI Moscow International Book Fair, the Book Festival “Red Square”, the XI International Military Music Festival “Spasskaya Tower”, the First St. Petersburg New Year’s Book Fair. Specialists of the institution introduced the visitors to printing products of the Library and told about its digital holdings, collections, educational and scientific events.

The publication covers topical issues of enhancement of legislation on information legal relations and contains drafts of regulatory acts on robotechnics and artificial intellect; chronicle of events reflecting the establishment and development of the system of Russian public centers of legal information; reviews for scientific publications, overlook of the International Scientific and Practical Conference on Promotion of Legal Information (Minsk, May 2018).



“Digital Archive” Series. Vol. 2. To the 200th Birth Anniversary of Emperor Alexander II. Archive Documents on Russian History Scientific Research and Publications

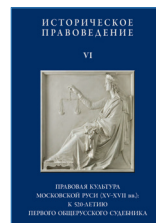
The collection released in commemoration of the 200th birth anniversary of Emperor Alexander II (1818–1881) is dedicated to key aspects of history of the Russian state in the 19th century (the sale of Alaska, the Great Reforms) and the Emperor’s personality reflected in memoirs and diaries of the court physician S. P. Botkin, Grand Duke Nikolai Pavlovich, publicist A. A. Kireev, and introduces new archival documents into the scientific circulation.



“Digital Library” Series. Vol. 8: Digital Projects in Modern Information Environment: Science and Practice

The collection includes articles dedicated to various aspects of formation of arrays of digital resources in the sphere of science,

culture, and education. Special attention is paid to implementation of research projects on study of historical sources using the information technology tools, formation of digital cartographic collections and their use in geolocation, creation of innovative virtual museum services. It represents publications on the practice of cataloguing digital copies of documents, formation of regional collections, as well as promotion of electronic resources on the Internet. The publication is destined not only for scientific community, but also for non-specialist readers involved into creation and use of digital content.



“Studia Historico-Juridica” Series. Vol. 5: Legal Culture of Moscow Rus’ (15th–17th Centuries): To the 520th Anniversary of the First All-Russian Law Code

The collection is dedicated to the jubilee of the most significant legal document in the history of the Russian state. It includes not only modern scientific interpretations of legal norms and institutes of Russian medieval law, but also new archive documents, that expand our concept of Russian law of the 15th–17th centuries. The publication is destined for scientific community and non-specialist readers, who study historical and cultural heritage of the country.

Study Guides



METS: Metadata Encoding and Transmission Standard

The standard was developed for encoding metadata required for processing digital objects in storages and exchange of such objects. The publication includes translations of recent versions of documents included into the METS: “Brief Summary and User Manual”, “Welcome Guide and Quick Reference Book”, “METS Scheme” from English. The edition is destined for librarianship professionals.



Formation of Digital Collections. Academic and Practical Guide

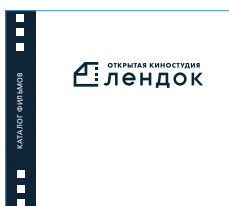
The publication covers theoretical research and practical activity of the Presidential Library in the field of formation of digital collections. The publication summarizes the experience of creation and management of such collections for the first time. The authors illustrated the text with a great number of examples from their own long-term work experience. The publication is destined for specialists of various libraries, students of universities, research officers of cultural institutions.

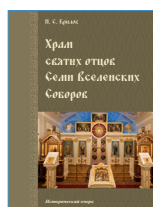

The section dedicated to philatelic diplomacy covers relations between Russian collectors of stamps and postcards and their foreign colleagues and philatelic organizations. Those, who everyday teach the youngsters and instill the love to this kind of gathering, tell about practical usefulness in education – preschool, school, professional.



Catalogue of Films of the Open Film Studio "Lendoc" and its Digital Version (2004–2018)

The catalogue represents more than a hundred films created at the studio 2004 through 2018. They were highly appraised by the audience and jury, awarded with prizes at many Russian and foreign film festivals. The digital version of the catalogue contains links to the films that are available for free viewing.



Church of Holy Fathers of Seven Ecumenical Councils

The publication prepared by the chief specialist of the RSHA N. S. Krylov is dedicated to commemorative stages of the life of the Church of Holy Fathers of Seven Ecumenical Councils. The church is located in a historical building of the Most Holy Governing Synod, where the RSHA worked for many years and now the Presidential Library is situated.



Series of Study Guides for Schools of the Far North

This series of books in the languages of the peoples of the Far North is addressed to teachers, students, and their parents. The study guides for schoolchildren of various ages narrate about the origin of the nations, their culture, folklore, fundamentals of the language, and writing. The publications promote preservation of the languages of the indigenous Arctic ethnic groups.



Illustrated Album-Catalogue "Rosreestr"

The album-catalogue dedicated to the history of land management in Russia was released in cooperation with the Administration of the Federal Service for State Registration, Cadastre, and Cartography for the Leningrad Region (Rosreestr), the Russian National Library, and the Leningrad Region State Archive in the town of Vyborg.

Annual report 2017

The publication presents the Presidential Library's activity in scientific, information, methodic, exhibition, international spheres, covers its work on expanding the Library holdings. It also provides data on the development of the network of interregional centers, cultural events, exhibitions, contests, conferences and other events the Presidential Library's staff took part in. The report is published separately in Russian and English languages.

the booklet "Regional Network of the Presidential Library in Moscow and the Moscow Region" reflect the development of the Library, expansion of the boundaries of its presence in regions, disclosure of opportunities of user access to the library holdings.

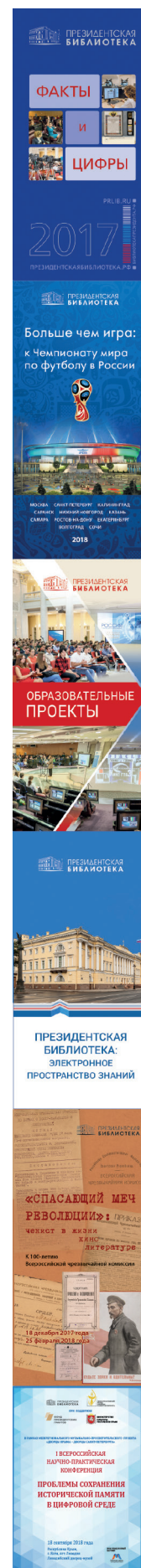
Any temporary exhibition organized by the Presidential Library was also accompanied with booklets and other printed products.

State and Socio-Political Events

In 2018, the Presidential Library housed 255 events.

The most significant ones for the institution were the events with participation of the leaders of Russia and foreign states, outstanding figures of culture, science, education, and arts. Thus, the meeting of the Supreme Eurasian

Economic Council and the informal summit of the leaders of the CIS countries attended by the heads of 11 states; the meeting of the Mixed Russian-Austrian Commission for Trade and Economic Development; the meeting of the President of the Russian Federation V. V. Putin with the finalists of the competition “Teacher of the Year in Russia 2018”; the meeting of the Holy Synod of the Russian Orthodox Church chaired by His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia, and others took place.

Holding the General Assembly of the International Automobile Association – an event that gathered together representatives of more than 190 world countries – at the Library was an important event.

The St. Petersburg International Educational Forum, the International Financial Congress, the St. Petersburg International Cultural Forum, the National Patriotic Cosmonautics and Aviation Forum “CosmoStart” were also carried out.

Cultural and Socially Important Events

In the reporting year, the Library continued the practice of organization of awareness-raising events in cooperation with partners from various authorities and regions of the country. Some events were arranged under the initiative of the partners – central libraries of regions.

Throughout 2018, the Presidential Library housed annual events dedicated to essential dates in Russian history, figures, and historical subjects.

A. S. Pushkin Memorial Day took place in the videoconference mode and united Pushkin specialists and librarians from Ufa, Irkutsk, Ulyanovsk, Grozny, Omsk, Barnaul, Kishinev (Moldova), and other cities.

Within the scope of the annual Day of Arctic, the unique museum project “Development of the North: Thousand Years of Success” initiated by the company “Norilsk Nickel” was presented at the Presidential Library. It narrates about the history of the Russian Polar Regions and promotes the popularization of unique collections from museum gatherings of 9 regions of the country. The event program also included a video lecture from the cycle “The Knowledge about Russia”: “The Arctic and the North: Resources, Economics, Science”, a multimedia lesson “Nuclear Icebreaking Fleet”, the Presidential Library cinema club meeting and screening of the film “The Main Directorate of the Northern Sea Route. Pages of History”, as well as a master class on watercolor “Northern

Landscape” with participation of the chairman of the board of the St. Petersburg Union of Artists, member of the Petrovsky Academy of Sciences and Arts Alexander Saikov.

The conference-webinar “The Day of Cadet at the Presidential Library”, timed in the reporting year to the 75th anniversary of establishment of first Suvorov and Nakhimov military schools, was held in cooperation with the Omsk Cadet Military Corps, the Tomsk Cadet Corps, the branch of the Nakhimov Naval School in Murmansk, and other organizations.

The conference “The Cosmonautics Day at the Presidential Library” united about 1,800 graduates from 42 regions of the Russian Federation, including those who joined the event through videoconferencing

and watched the live broadcast on the website. The conference was dedicated to the jubilee of the original publication of the book by K. E. Tsiolkovskiy “Study of Outer Space by Rocket Appliances” and a number of issues of history of the Russian cosmonautics.

Ahead of the FIFA World Cup, the Presidential Library hosted a round table, where cultural and awareness-raising projects dedicated to the history of Russian sport and football were presented. The teleconference bridge allowed for joining the event by partners from

cities-participants of the World Cup: Moscow, Volgograd, Saransk, Sochi, Samara, Yekaterinburg, Kaliningrad, as well as Vladimir, Grozny, Tyumen, Pushkino (the Moscow Region), Penza, Rostov-on-Don. The round table made it possible to exchange the experience of work on preparation to the largest event of the year, to show bright presentations, to agree on joint projects and cooperation.

At the end of 2018, the Presidential Library launched a project dedicated to preservation of historical memory about the siege of Leningrad in 1941–1944. In cooperation with “Radio of Russia” and the newspaper “Peterburgsky Dnevnik”, collection of historical materials – documents, letters, diaries, photos from personal archives of citizens of the sieged city – launched. The materials are to be digitized and included into the Presidential Library’s holdings in the following.

In 2018, the IX Annual International Multimedia Creative Contest “Foreign View 2018” held under the motto “Freedom to Support” was launched. 3,603 works from

20 countries of the world, 60 cities and settlements of Russia were submitted for the contest.

In the reporting year, children in hardship were addressed at the Presidential Library. Thus, a charity concert was held, to which kids from the SBEI “Center “Dynamics”, the St. Petersburg Public Organization of Invalids “Down-Center”, the Association of Public Unions “Big Dipper”, institutions within jurisdiction of the Custody and Trusteeship Department, as well as children cared for by the center “Anton is Here”, kids and teachers from the Siverskiy boarding school were invited. Young musicians – awardees and nominees of the Vladimir Spivakov International Charity Foundation participated in the charity concert.

In 2018, the Presidential Library housed concerts from the cycle “Music of the Russian Statehood”. The events portfolio was supplemented with sport competitions – the Presidential Library for the first time acted as a platform for holding the chess tournament “The Bronze Horseman”.



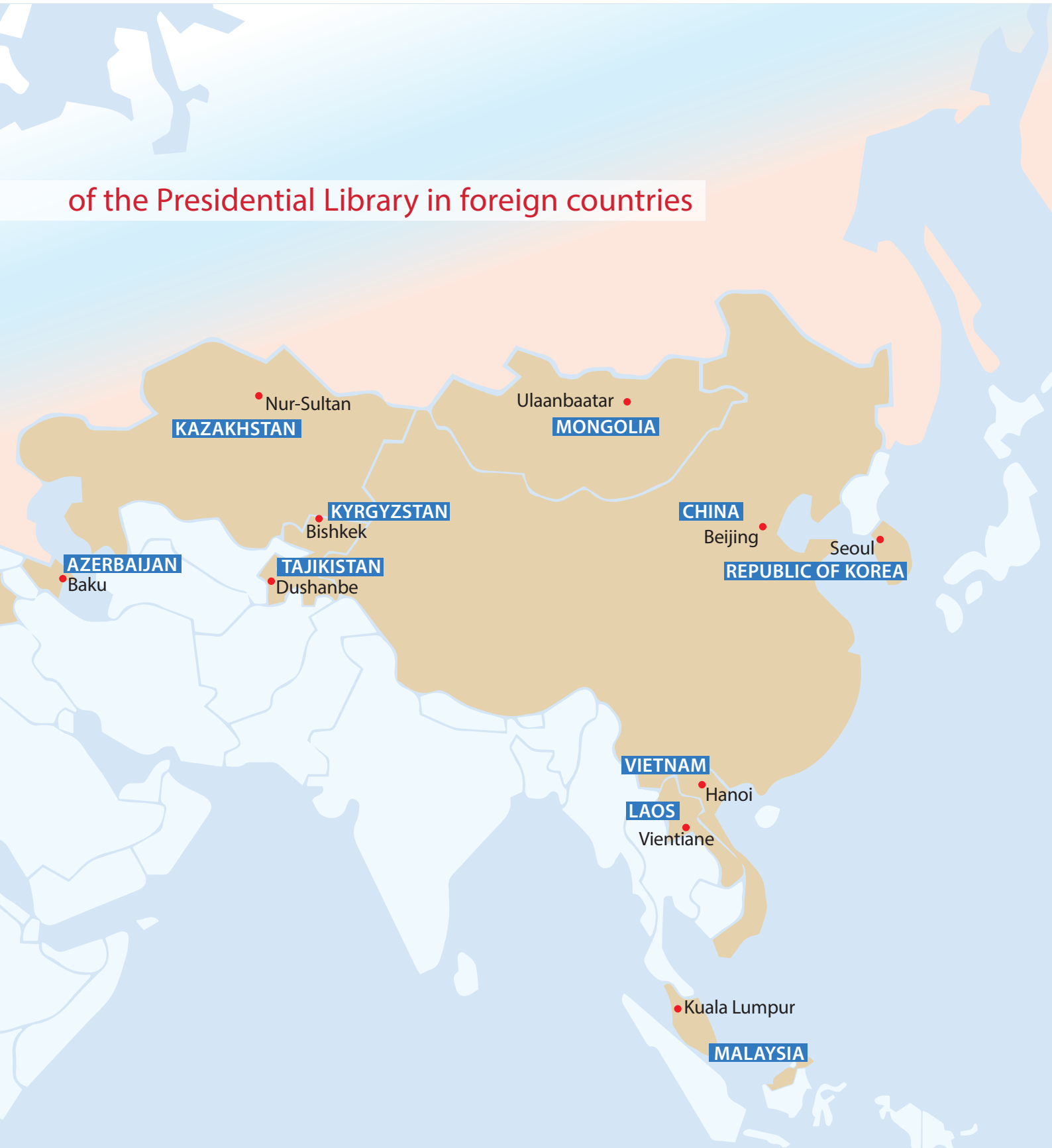

International Relations

In 2018, the Presidential Library continued to work actively in international organizations, of which it is a member – the Conference of Directors of National Libraries of the World (CDNL), the Conference of European National Librarians (CENL), the International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions (IFLA).

Within the scope of the IV Forum “Dialogue of Russia – Republic of Korea” held in Moscow, the Presidential Library headed the work group “Culture and Art”. The institution’s specialists took part in the forum “St. Petersburg Dialogue”, where an interactive stand with video presentation of resources revealing the history of relations between Russia and Germany was presented, as well as in many other joint events: exhibitions, round tables, creative contests carried out in centers for remote access to the Library’s electronic holdings, which are open in Germany. In order to promote the bilateral cooperation, in 2018, negotiations were held on a regular basis with international libraries, archives, and cultural centers in the USA, Germany, China, Kazakhstan, and Uzbekistan.

Professional engagement and interaction continued with the State Library of Berlin within the scope of the “Slavistik Portal” project, which resulted in replenishment of the eponymously-named website with rare documents from holdings of the Presidential Library.

In advance of the 70th Frankfurt Book Fair, the Presidential Library solemnly opened

the exhibition “The German Carl Bulla, the First Russian Photojournalist” in the form of a teleconference bridge with the German-Russian Institute of Culture in Dresden, which united participants from Dresden, Leipzig, and St. Petersburg. The exhibition was presented in the electronic form at the united Russian stand at the Frankfurt Book Fair.

In 2018, the Russia-USA bilateral cooperation continued. The Presidential Library presented the exposition “‘Eureka’ and ‘Ostrov’: Tehran-43 and Yalta-45. The Story of Landmark Decisions” in cooperation with Bard College and the Franklin D. Roosevelt Presidential Library for the 75th anniversary of the Tehran Conference.

Delegations of the Presidential Library, in 2018, participated in international conferences, seminars, exhibitions, and round tables in 11 countries of the world, including Germany, Iceland, the Republic of Srpska, Vietnam, Malaysia, Iran, Uzbekistan, etc.

Thus, in the course of a scientific and methodic trip to Germany, in June 2018, specialists of the Presidential Library could share the experience of creation and exchange of electronic resources with their colleagues from the museum complex and library of the Friedenstein castle and the Leibniz-Institute for East and Southeast European Studies in Regensburg. Moreover, visitors of the institute were provided with access to the Presidential Library’s resources.

Public Relations

In 2018, providing the public with information on the Presidential Library's activity continued. The institution's work was covered by materials of major federal and regional mass media, such as information agencies TASS, "Interfax", the International Information Agency "Russia Today"; television channels: First Channel, "Russia", Fifth Channel, 78, "St. Petersburg", NTV; periodicals: "Rossiyskaya Gazeta", "St. Petersburg Vedomosti", etc. The total number of the mass media the Presidential Library cooperates with exceeds 1,000. The Presidential Library is also presented in social networks VKontakte, Facebook, Instagram, Vimeo.

In 2018, joint events of the Presidential Library and the "Rossiyskaya Gazeta" took place: in May, the first council of experts in the sphere of touristic industry was held, and in November the Presidential Library donated books prepared by its own publishing and printing complex to the Dostoevsky Library in Staraya Russa, thus, supporting the "Book as a Gift for the City of Dostoevsky" campaign implemented by the "Rossiyskaya Gazeta". In cooperation with the editorial office

of the "Rossiyskaya Gazeta" the Presidential Library houses presentations of issues of the monthly historical popular science journal "Rodina".

In late November, at a press conference in the St. Petersburg TASS Regional Center, the Presidential Library reported on joining forces with the "St. Petersburg" TV channel for the campaign "Faces of Siege Leningrad". Photos and memoirs of those who survived the Siege are posted on the website of the TV channel and then are included into the Presidential Library's electronic holdings.

In December 2018, at a press conference at the Media Center of the Government of St. Petersburg, the creation of the United City Information Center to coordinate the work of all mass media, public organizations and institutions of culture on covering events timed to the 75th anniversary of liberation of Leningrad from the Nazi siege, was announced. The United City Information Center, co-organized by the Presidential Library, operates on the basis of the City Student's Press Center of St. Petersburg. Volunteers participate in the project to meet with the siege

survivors and record their memoirs for history. A united video, audio, and photo archive is to be formed this way. In addition, employees of the information center are to maintain a single base of events dedicated to the siege.

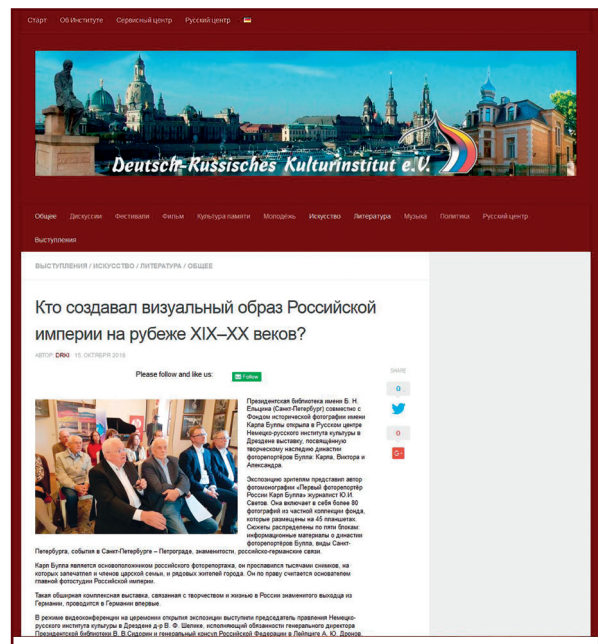
The Presidential Library's administration also participated in a press conference within the scope of the festival "Spasskaya Tower" at the International Information Agency "Russia Today" and a press conference in Crimea timed to opening of the I All-Russian Scientific and Practical Conference of the Presidential Library and opening of the I International Music Festival "Palaces of Crimea – Palaces of St. Petersburg". The press tour "The Presidential Library for the World Cup" was arranged.

Work with information and awareness-raising centers of the Presidential Library, which house presentations and discussions of social, research, cultural, and educational projects, continued. The Presidential Library hosted the presentation of the annual almanac "Poetry Day – XXI century. 2017" with the participation of the information and awareness-raising center in Tyumen and the Reserve Center of the Presidential Library in Moscow.

The third large-scale media contest "Caucasus.doc", which is implemented within the scope of the work plan for the first in the South Caucasus information and awareness-raising center of the Presidential Library, housed by the republican TV channel of Karachay-Cherkessia "Arkhyz 24", started in December. In 2018, a new rubric "Historical Facts from the Presidential Library" opened at "Radio of Russia".

Projects of the Presidential Library in 2018 were widely covered by foreign mass media, too. Together with the Carl Bulla Foundation of Historical Photography, a series of events dedicated to the creative heritage of the Bulla dynasty was held. Thus, within the framework of the XVII forum "St. Petersburg Dialogue" aimed at strengthening connections between Russia and Germany, fragments of exhibition of photographs by the Bulla family, which was prepared by the Presidential Library for being shown in Germany, were on display.

A lot of work in 2018 was carried out with a youth audience. Thus, in January, on the eve of the Day of Russian Press, the Presidential Library housed a round table dedicated to the prospects of development of children and youth mass media, and in October more than a hundred representatives of editorial

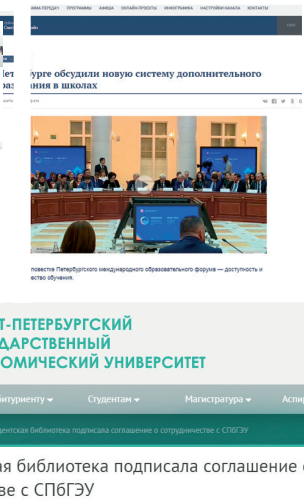
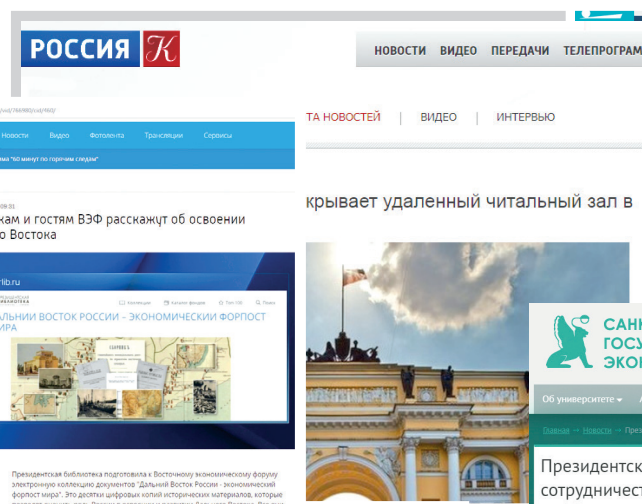

Exhibitions

Temporary Exhibitions in Exhibition Halls of the Presidential Library

“The Way Not Experienced by the Russians Before” (March 5 – August 20, 2018)

The exhibition is dedicated to the 215th anniversary of the first Russian round-the-world journey of I. F. Krusenstern and timed to the Year of Russia in Japan. The exposition was elaborated by the Presidential Library jointly with the Central Naval Library. It tells about the first world tour of I. F. Krusenstern and Yu. F. Lisiansky, as well as the history of development of interstate relations between Russia and Japan in the 18th –19th centuries. The exhibition was remarkable, as the visitors could see rare and unique books from personal library of I. F. Krusenstern kept in custody of the Central Naval Library.

“Journey from Petrograd to Moscow. 1918: Marking the 100th Anniversary of the Relocation of the Soviet Government and the Capital to Moscow” (March 12 – May 12, 2018)

March 2018 marked the 100th anniversary of Moscow becoming the capital of Russia for the second time in its history. For such significant event, the Presidential Library prepared the exhibition “Journey from Petrograd to Moscow. 1918: Marking the 100th Anniversary of the Relocation of the Soviet Government and the Capital to Moscow”. Documents, photographs, memoirs, and household items of the first quarter of the 20th century allowed for telling about the key points of the transfer of the capital from Petrograd to Moscow, from the plans of evacuation of residents and the government from Petrograd, which first appeared in 1914 after the beginning of the First World War, and until the first half of 1920s when Moscow finally established itself as a new capital. Moreover, the exhibition covered the following themes: secret relocation of the head of the Soviet government, V. I. Lenin; arrangement of the government and administrative apparatus in Moscow and related difficulties; the plight of Petrograd, which lost its capital status; the formation of a new look of Moscow.

In arrangement of the exposition the Library partnered with Petersburg and Moscow archives, libraries, and museums.

“More than a Game: To the FIFA World Cup in Russia” (May 21 – September 26, 2018)

In the year of holding of the key sport event – FIFA World Cup – the Presidential Library arranged the exhibition telling about the history and modern state of the sport. The exposition covered the main milestones in history of Russian football, the birthplace of which can be considered St. Petersburg. Materials provided by participant cities and the Steering Committee of the FIFA World Cup 2018 told about how the country had prepared for the competition. Unique exhibit items included an architectural model of the stadium “St. Petersburg” executed in the smallest details, the ball with signatures of footballers of “Zenith”, with which they won the USSR Championship in 1984, the official ball of the FIFA World Cup 2018, etc.

“Keeping Orthodox Faith: The History of Church Museums. Marking the 1030th Anniversary of the Christianization of Rus” (July 27 – September 20, 2018)

2018 was marked with one more jubilee date: on July 28 – the memorial day of Saint Equal-to-the-Apostles Grand Prince Vladimir – the 1030th anniversary of Christianization of Rus’ was celebrated – an event that largely determined the historical path of development of the Russian state. The Holy Synod of the Russian Orthodox Church made the decision to establish a steering committee on the occasion of the celebration on May 14, 2018.

The Presidential Library housed the exhibition dedicated to the tradition of saving and revival of spiritual shrines of the Orthodoxy, namely creation and preservation of collections of church museums in the 19th–21st centuries.



Visitors were able to retrace the history of origin and development of interest in study and preservation of Christian antiquities. Special attention was drawn to authentic exhibit items of church archives – icons, details of bishops’ vestments, and church objects of the 18th–19th centuries provided by the Museum Archive of the Alexander Nevsky Lavra and the Resurrection of Christ the Savior Cathedral (Smolny Cathedral). The grand opening of the exhibition took place on July 27 on the eve of the feast.

“Bestuzhev Courses in the Mirror of the Library: Marking the 140th Anniversary of the Foundation of Women’s (Bestuzhev) Courses” (October 8 – November 14, 2018)

The exhibition was prepared jointly with the St. Petersburg State University as a part of the major project dedicated to the 140th anniversary of the foundation of the Higher Women’s (Bestuzhev) Courses. It told about the commencement of women’s university education in Russia, establishment of the Higher Women’s Courses in St. Petersburg and education of first Russian female scientists. Rare publications from the Bestuzhev Library became the basis of the exposition. Visitors were able to see unique books and to learn about fates of their owners closely connected with Higher Women’s (Bestuzhev) Courses.

“Eureka’ and ‘Ostrov’: Tehran-43 and Yalta-45. The Story of Landmark Decisions” (November 28, 2018 – January 11, 2019)

The exhibition timed to the 75th anniversary of the Tehran conference told about arrangement and holding two conferences, on the decisions made, as well as about the contemporary events on the fronts of the World War II. Documents provided by Bard College and the Franklin D. Roosevelt Presidential Library were some of the essential materials of the exposition and gave Russian audience the chance to see epistolary intercourse of Franklin D. Roosevelt and Stalin concerning the war issues and tripartite meetings of the leaders of the Big Three. The exposition also featured original photos from TASS chronicle and campaign posters from holdings of the Russian National Library, documents on arrangement of security of conferences from holdings of the Central Archive of the Federal Security Service, fragments from newsreels and films.

Tablet Exhibitions

“Shield and Sword of the Revolution: The Chekist in Life, Cinema, Literature” (September 11 – December 20, 2018) was a replica of a relevant thematic exhibition held at the exhibition hall of the Presidential Library (December 18, 2017 – February 25, 2018). Tablets were on display in the Memorial House of Julian Semenov in the settlement of Oliva in Crimea.

“From the History of Land Management and Cadastre in Russia: To the 10th Anniversary of the Rosreestr” (has been on display since October 2018 at various state institutions)

Rosreestr – the united federal service responsible for state registration of immovable property, cadastre and cartography – celebrated its 10th anniversary in 2018, but distribution, recording, and description of lands in Russia has been carried out since the most ancient time. This was the subject of the exhibition prepared by specialists of the Presidential Library commissioned by the Administration of the Rosreestr for the Leningrad Region. The exhibition displayed on tablets narrated about the essential stages in history of land management and cartography both in Russia in its entirety and in the Leningrad Region – starting from the Old-Russian state up to the present days. The exhibition was accompanied with rich illustrative and cartographic materials received from holdings of the Russian National Library, the Presidential library, and the Leningrad Region State Archive in the town of Vyborg. It featured examples of rare and little-known audit descriptions and maps of past ages, e.g. audit books for Vyborg lands in Swedish and Finnish; detailed maps of atlases of the Ordinance survey of Russian lands conducted for about one hundred years from the middle of the 18th century, etc.

Digital Exhibitions

“Northern Flowers” (July 18 – August 1, 2018)



The exhibition dedicated to the 65th anniversary of Norilsk, the largest city of the Arctic Circle, under the auspices of “Norilsk Nickel”. Thanks to works by Marina Peshkova, guests of the Presidential Library could visit the city and get acquainted with its residents. The exhibition featured photographs of different genres – from reportage to art.

“The Legendary Man: To the 95th Birth Anniversary of the Honorary Citizen of St. Petersburg M. M. Bobrov” (August 10 – August 31, 2018)

The exhibition was a part of a large-scale event timed to the 95th birth anniversary of the honorary citizen of St. Petersburg Mikhail Mikhailovich Bobrov – an outstanding sportsman, military mountain climber, who during the Great Patriotic War participated in the disguise of high-altitude dominants of the sieged city – the domes of St. Isaac’s and Peter and Paul Cathedrals, and then fought German climbers in the Caucasus mountains. The exhibition featured photographs from the family archive of the Bobrovs telling not only about his military and sport achievements, but also about the private and public life of the extraordinary man.

“The Feat of Faith and Service. Filosof Nikolayevich Ornatsky: Marking Centenary Anniversary of Repose” (October 26 – November 26, 2018)

The martyr Filosof Ornatsky (1860–1918) was an archpriest of the Russian Orthodox

Church, public and state figure, who was shot down together with his sons in 1918. The exhibition prepared in collaboration with the Convent of Saints Constantine and Helena of the St. Petersburg Diocese tells about his life journey, commemorative events timed to the 100th anniversary of the martyr’s death, activity of the Convent aimed at preservation of reminiscence of Filosof Ornatsky.

“Man in an Epoch. Marking the 80th Birth Anniversary of V. N. Zaitsev” (November 13 – November 20, 2018)



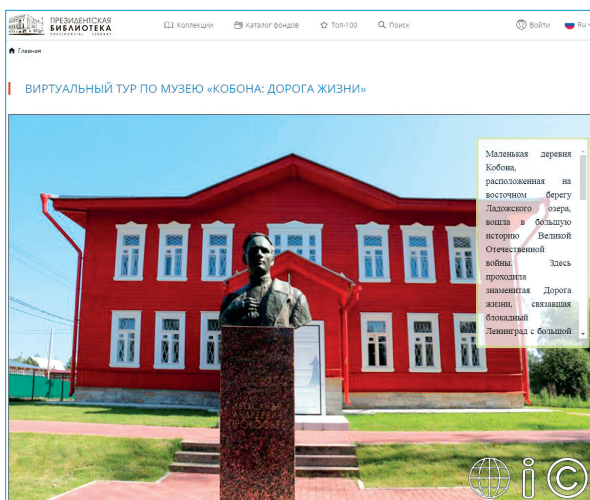
Opening of the exhibition and holding a video lecture “The Knowledge about Russia” made a complex event dedicated to the jubilee of V. N. Zaitsev (1938–2010), an outstanding person, honored worker of culture of the Russian Federation. Photos from the family archive presented at the exhibition narrated about his professional activity in the capacity of the director of the Russian National Library.

“Danil Granin and the Youth” (December 11, 2018)

The exhibition was prepared in cooperation with the Russian State University for the Humanities within the scope of a cycle of events timed to preparation of celebration of the 100th birth anniversary of the veteran writer, survivor of the siege, honorary citizen of St. Petersburg D. A. Granin. Topics of the photographs presented at the exhibition were students meeting, presentation of the writer’s books, meetings with figures of science, culture, art, etc.

Virtual Tours for Permanent Expositions of St. Petersburg Museums

Virtual Tour through the Museum “Kobona: The Road of Life”. With the help of the virtual tour, a visitor can observe all halls of the museum recently renovated after the fire, the exposition of which was created according to an original art project. Thematically, the exposition is divided into several blocks: The road of life, the history of the village of Kobona from its foundation to the present day. The total exhibition area of the museum is 215 sq. m.



Virtual Tour through the Museum “Cruiser ‘Aurora’”. The famous cruiser of the October Revolution is now available in virtual space. A visitor is able to see the bird’s eye panorama of the vessel, its upper and lower decks, the permanent exposition, that get the guests acquainted with history of the “Aurora” and its participation in revolution events of 1917, as well as the ship church and premises with expositions, that are not always available for “live” visits: the ship hospital, the boiler and engine rooms.

Virtual Tour through the State Memorial Museum of the Defense and Siege of Leningrad. Beforehand one of the essential events in the course of the Great Patriotic War – the 75th anniversary of the complete liberation of Leningrad – the Presidential Library commenced to implement a major project of an open memorial museum in virtual space. The first step was the creation and presentation of a tour through the exposition of the State Memorial Museum of the Defense and Siege of Leningrad. It is important that the tour captured the museum as it was before May 2018. Since June 2018, the museum exhibition halls have been on restoration, the exposition has been dismantled and will be replaced by a completely another one after completion of the works. The memory of the previous exposition is preserved only in the virtual tour. The tour is accompanied with a large number of photos of authentic military and siege items, as well as with extensive texts informing about all key events, that occurred both on the Leningrad front and in Leningrad itself during the Great Patriotic War.

Virtual Tours for Temporary Thematic Exhibitions of the Presidential Library

Virtual tour for the exhibition “More than a Game: To the FIFA World Cup in Russia”. The 3D-tour lets a visitor to get acquainted with photographs, documents, video materials and other information presented at the thematic exhibition dedicated to holding the World Cup in Russia.
